

Sweet Lambies Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4. Press all seams open. Do not pre-wash the flannel precuts or yardage. Use the \square check boxes to mark each completed step.

Fabric Requirements



SQ-MASLILF One 42 piece 10" square of Little Lambies Woolies Flannel

ADDITIONAL FABRICS 1/2 yard Grey F21 for applique and binding Fat Quarter White F22 for applique optional: Fusible Web for appliqué

EMBROIDERY Black Perle Cotton - for eyes Pinkish Grey Perle Cotton - for noses

BACKING 1-1/4 yard of a flannel of your choice

Cutting

From Fabrics A, C, E, G, I, K, M, O, Q, and S: There are (2) 10" squares of each color listed. From 1 square of each color:

Cut (1) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. From the remaining square of each color: Cut (2) 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.

From Fabrics B, D, F, H, J, L, N, P, R, and T: There are (2) 10" squares of each color listed. From 1 square of each color:

Cut (4) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips
From the remaining square of each color:
Cut (2) 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.

From Fabric U

For Binding:

Cut (5) 2-1/2" \times WOF strips Use remaining to cut the Lambie faces and legs.

From Fabric V

For Appliqué:

Cut (10) Lambie bodies

WOF - Width of Fabric LOF - Length of Fabric RST - Right Sides Together HST - Half Square Triangle

Four Patch Blocks (p. 4)


Gather the 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.


- \square 1. Sew the rectangles into pairs. Press.
- ☐ 2. Sew the pairs together into the block. Press. Make one.
- ☐ 3. Repeat steps 1-2 to make the blocks illustrated below. Make one of each.

Lambie Appliqué Blocks (p.5)


Gather the 6-1/2" \times 8-1/2" rectangles and the 1-1/2" strips.


- \square 1. Sew a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the sides of a 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Press.
- \square 2. Sew a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the step 1 unit. Press. Make one.
- □ 3. Repeat steps 1-2 to make the blocks illustrated on p.5. Make one of each.
































Appliqué

Template on p. 8 (back page)


- □ 1. Cut out the appliqué pieces from designated colors. Bonnie reccommends using fusible web so the pattern pieces are the exact size needed. If you choose to do needle turn appliqué you will need to add seam allowance.
- □ 2. Fuse Little Lambies in the centers of the Framed Blocks. You'll notice that you can tilt the heads any direction you choose or have them all be the same up to you! Bonnie also made one of the hearts into a flower and embroidered the stem
- □ 3. Whip stitch around the edges of all the appliqué pieces. You can also do this step on the sewing machine if you prefer.
- ☐ 4. Use black perle cotton thread to make French Knot eyes on the Little Lambies.
- □ 5. Use a deep pinkish-gray perle cotton thread and a Satin Stitch to stitch a little nose for the lambies.

French Knot

Pull thread slightly tight around needle as you push needle through fabric to form a knot.



Satin Stitch
Use this stitch to fill in areas. Change
direction for variety!





Finishing

- ☐ 1. Lay the blocks out in rows as illustrated on p.7. Sew into rows. Press.
- ☐ 2. Sew row to row. Press.
- \Box 3. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
- □ 4. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
