Small Throw Quilt 50" x 66-1/2"

Wilmington Prints: A World of Possibilities

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 42-1/2" multi-stripe borders (1 with word stripe on bottom, 1 with word stripe on top)

Fabric C- Cut (2) 7-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 7-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 61" and (2) 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders

Fabric E - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (4) 4" x 14-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (1) 4-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 4-3/4" square (cut in half diagonally twice X for 4 triangles) and (4) 4" x 7-1/2" pieces Cut (4) 4" strips, subcut (36) 4" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (16) 4" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 4-3/8" strip, subcut (2) 4-3/8" square (cut 1 in half diagonally and cut the other in half diagonally in the opposite direction for 4 triangles) and (8) 4" squares

Fabric I - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 15" and (8) 2-1/2" x 12" strips


Fabric J - Cut (1) 7-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 4" x 7-1/2" tall, (2) 4-3/4" squares (cut in half diagonally twice of for 8 triangles), and (2) 4" tall x 7-1/2" pieces

Fabric K - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 59" and (2) 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders

NOTE: Not all Fabric J triangles are used.

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch Fabric I 2-1/2" x 12 strips to sides of a Fabric A 11-1/2" strip square panel. Trim ends even. Add 2-1/2" x 15" Fabric I strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 14-1/2" square (unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

Make a total of 4 Block 1.

Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 32 **Fabric F** 4" squares and all the Fabric G 4" squares.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

3. Arrange a marked **Fabric G** 4" square on an end of a **Fabric F** 4" x 7-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 4 Unit 2a (4" x 7-1/2" unfinished).

4. In the same manner, make 2 each Units 2b and 2c with fabrics indicated, noting orientation of stripe.

5. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric F** 4" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric C** 7-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 8 Unit 3 (7-1/2" square unfinished).











Unit 3 - Make 8


6. Arrange a **Fabric E** 4" x 14-1/2" strip, 2 Unit 3, 1 Unit 2a, and 2 Fabric H 4" squares in 3 vertical rows as shown. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together to complete Block 2a (14-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each Blocks 2b-2d with fabrics and units indicated. Note that in Blocks 2b and 2d the fabrics and units are arranged in horizontal rows.





- 7. Sew 1 each **Fabrics F** and **J** 4-3/4" triangles together along short edges. Note: Use only J triangles with stripe as shown. Add a Fabric H 4-3/8" triangle as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (4" square unfinished).
- 8. Arrange the 4 Unit 4 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Unit 5 (7-1/2" square unfinished).




Unit 4 Make 4

9. Arrange 2 Unit 2b, 2 Unit 2c, 1 Unit 5, and 4 Fabric F 4" squares in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Block 3 (14-1/2" square unfinished).




Block 3 - Make 1

- 10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 11. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing guilt center (42-1/2" square unfinished).
- 12. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 42-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 13. Sew **Fabric K** 1-1/2" x 59" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric K 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 14. Sew **Fabric D** 3-1/2"x 61" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric D 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 15. The quilt measures approximately 50-1/2" x 67" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric L) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric K) and enjoy!!
