Blushing Blooms

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (2) 5" squares

Fabric B - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares

Fabric C - Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" borders

Fabric E - Cut (6) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric F - Cut (5) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (12) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips, (14) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces, and (8) 2-3/4" squares Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders

Fabric G - Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (4) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabrics H and J - From each fabric: Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (12) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric I - Cut (10) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces and (48) 2-3/4" squares Cut (6) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" and (2) 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" borders

Fabric K - Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric L - Cut (7) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (12) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips, (22) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces, and (16) 2-3/4" squares Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric M - Cut (16) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (240) 2-3/4" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabrics C**, **I**, and **M** 2-3/4" squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics C** and **M** 2-3/4" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric E** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press the corners out. Make a total of 48 Unit 1a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).








3. In the same manner, make 48 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.



4. Sew 1 each Units 1a and 1b together lengthwise as shown. Make a total of 48 Unit 2 (5" square unfinished).



5. Arrange 4 Unit 2 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 12 **Block 1** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 12

6. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 2-3/4" square on an end of a **Fabric F** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 14 Unit 3a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).

7. In the same manner, make the number of Units 3b-3g listed with fabrics indicated.



Make 12 Stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.

8. Arrange 1 Fabric B 5" square, 1 Fabric F 2-3/4" square, 3 **Fabric L** 2-3/4" squares, 2 Unit 3a, and 2 Unit 3b in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 2a (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 Block 2b with fabrics and units indicated.









9. Arrange 1 each Units 3c-3f in a vertical row. Stitch units together. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 $(5'' \times 9-1/2'' \text{ unfinished}).$ In the same manner, make 8 Unit 5 with units indicated.







Make 8 10. Stitch a Unit 4 between 1 each Fabrics F and L 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips as shown. Make a total of 2 each **Blocks 3a** and **3b** (9-1/2" square unfinished).





Block 3b - Make 2

11. Stitch a Unit 5 between 1 each Fabrics F and L 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips as shown. Make a total of 4 each Blocks 4a and 4b (9-1/2" square unfinished).



- 12. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 13. Arrange blocks in 6 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (45-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished).
- 14. Sew **Fabric D** 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric D** 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 15. Sew **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric F 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 16. Sew **Fabric I** 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric I 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 17. The quilt measures approximately 59-1/2" x 68-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric N) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 18. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric L) and enjoy!!
