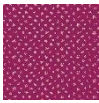

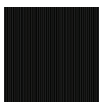

Skill Level: Beginner

All seams sewn using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance

Requirements & Cutting:

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Instructions (WOF = width of fabric)
Fabric A SP25615-99 (Main) 	2/3 yd (1 Panel)	Trim panel to 21 1/2" x 40 1/2", centering the design.
Fabric B SP25620-28 (Inner Border) 	1/4 yd	Cut 3 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips; trim two strips to 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" and from the third strip, cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 21 1/2" strips
Fabric C SP25617-99 (Outer Border) 	5/8 yd	Cut – 4 – 4 1/2" x WOF strips; trim two strips to 4 1/2" x 42 1/2" and two strips to 4 1/2" x 23 1/2"
Fabric D SS25624-99 (Cornerstones & Binding) 	5/8 yd	Cut 1 – 4 1/2" x WOF strip ➤ sub-cut 4 – 4 1/2" squares and 4 – 1 1/2" squares Cut 5 – 2 1/2" x WOF strips; set aside for Binding
Backing SP25621-99 	1 3/4 yds	No cutting required.

Instructions:

1. Sew a 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric B inner border strip to each side of the center panel.
2. Sew a 1 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of the 2 – 1 1/2" x 21 1/2" Fabric B inner border strips. Then sew these strips to the top & bottom of the center panel.
3. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 using the Fabric C outer border strips and the 4 1/2" Fabric D squares.
4. To prepare binding, join the Fabric D binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Fold in half, wrong sides together, along the length of the strip and press.
5. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
