# Gnome-kin Patch By Susan Winget



WILMINGTON Frints

Throw Quilt: 53" x 66 1/2"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 51" multi-stripe borders (1 with sunflower stripe on top, 1 with sunflower stripe on bottom)

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 9-1/2" strips, subcut (6) 9-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 3-1/2" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (20) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares

**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares and (4) 2" squares Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (20) 2" squares

**Fabric H** - Cut (3) 5" strips, subcut (24) 5" squares

Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares and (16) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces
Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (76) 2" squares

**Fabric I** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (20) 2" squares

Cut (4) 1-3/4" strips, sew 2 strips together end to end and cut into (1) 1-3/4" x 43" and (1) 1-3/4" x 27" borders. Repeat for a total of 2 each length border.

**Fabric J** - Cut (9) 1-3/4" strips, sew strip together end to end and cut into

(2) 1-3/4" x 64-1/2", (2) 1-3/4" x 53-1/2", and

(2) 1-3/4" x 51" borders

Cut (3) 2" strips, subcut (4) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces and (48) 2" squares

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 28" strips

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabric H** 5" squares and all **Fabrics F**, **G**, **H**, **I**, and **J** 2" squares

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric H** 5" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric D** 9-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 6 Unit 1 (9-1/2" square unfinished).

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

3. Arrange 2 each marked Fabrics G and I 2" squares on the corners of a Unit 1 as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Make a total of 2 Block 1a (9-1/2" square unfinished).

4. In the same manner, make 2 **Block 1b**, 1 **Block 1c**, and 1 **Block 1d** with fabrics indicated and a Unit 1.

5. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric H** 2" squares on opposite corners of a Fabric I 3-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Make a total of 12 Unit 2a (3-1/2" square unfinished).

6. In the same manner, make 16 Unit 2b and 4 each Units 2c and 2d with fabrics indicated.

7. Arrange 1 each marked Fabrics G and H 2" squares on opposite corners of a Fabric E 3-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners with 1 each marked **Fabrics H** and **I** 2" squares. Make a total of 2 Unit 3a (3-1/2" square unfinished).

8. In the same manner, make 2 each Units 3b and 3c with fabrics indicated.

9. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 2" square on an end of a **Fabric H** 2" x 3-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 16 Unit 4a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished).

10. In the same manner, make 20 Unit 4b and 4 Unit 4c with fabrics indicated.

11. Stitch a Unit 4a to a Unit 4b as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 5a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 5b with units indicated.






12. Arrange 1 Fabric C 3-1/2" square, 2 Unit 2a, 2 Unit 2b, and 4 Unit 5a in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 **Block 2a** (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 Block 2b with fabric and units indicated.

13. Arrange 1 each Units 2a, 2b, and 3a in a vertical row. Stitch units together. Make a total of 2 Block 3a (3-1/2" x 9-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 each Blocks 3b, 3c, 4a, and 4b with units indicated.


- 14. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.
- 15. Stitch **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 28" **Fabric J** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43" (unfinished)*.
- 16. Sew **Fabric I** 1-3/4" x 43" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric I** 1-3/4" x 27" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.
- 17. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 1a, 1b, 1c, 2a, 2b, 3a, 3b, 3c, 4a,** and **4b** in 4 rows on left side of bordered panel. Stitch into rows. Sew rows into pieced left border (12-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to left side of bordered panel.
- 18. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 1a, 1b, 1d, 2a, 2b, 3a, 3b, 3c, 4a,** and **4b** in 4 rows on right side of bordered panel. Stitch into rows. Sew rows into pieced right border (12-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to right side of bordered panel. Quilt center measures 45-1/2" x 51" (unfinished).

- 19. Sew **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 51" borders above and below quilt center.
- 20. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 51" borders above and below quilt **J** borders.
- 21. Sew **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 64-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 53-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 22. The quilt measures approximately 53-1/2" tttt 67" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 23. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!


