## Cutting Directions:

WOF = width of fabric from selvage to selvage. Remove as little fabric as possible when squaring strip ends.

## 24213 J - Floral Tiles

- Fussy-cut 12 framed motifs, cutting $1 / 4$ " out from the teal frame all around (approximately $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ ").
- Fussy-cut (6) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares with a flower motif centered in each square.


## 24214 E - Cream Floral

- Cut (3) 4" x WOF strips; recut into (24) 4" squares.


## 24214 Q - Teal Floral

- Cut (3) 4" x WOF strips; recut into (24) 4" squares.


## 24215 Q - Teal Paisley

- Cut (7) $31 / 2$ x WOF strips for second border.


## 24215 T - Rust Paisley

- Cut (2) $311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips; recut into (17) $31 / 2$ " squares.


## 24216 E - Cream Medallions

- Cut (6) 4" x WOF strips; recut into (24) 4" squares and (34) $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
- Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips; recut into (68) 2" squares.


## 24218 A - Brown Print

- Cut (4) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips; recut into (48) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 96 triangles.
- Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips; recut into (48) 2" squares.


## 24218 E - Cream/Brown Print

- Cut (5) 2" x WOF strips; recut into (96) 2" squares.
- Cut (3) $33 / 4$ " x WOF strips; recut into (24) $33 / 4$ " squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 48 triangles.


## 24219 E - Cream Tonal

- Cut (10) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips; recut into (110) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 220 triangles.
- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip; recut into (20) $2^{2 \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (13) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips for first and third borders.


## 24219 Q - Teal Tonal

- Cut (8) 2 " x WOF strips; recut into (164) $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (3) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips; recut into (34) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 68 triangles.
- Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips; recut into (34) 3" x $31 / 2$ " rectangles.
- Cut (8) $2^{11 / 4} \mathrm{x}$ x WOF strips for binding.


## 24217 E - Cream Print (Backing Only)

- Cut (2) 87" x WOF pieces.


## 24217 J - Black Print

- Cut (3) 4" x WOF strips; recut into (24) 4" squares.

In Bloom Quilt

Block and Sashing Units<br>Note: Use a ${ }^{1 ⁄ 4}$ " seam allowance for all stitching.

1. Center and stitch a $33 / 4$ " cream/brown triangle to opposite sides of a floral tile framed square. Press seams toward the triangles. Repeat on the remaining sides of the square. Trim the pieced unit to $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2}$ " to complete 1 block center unit, keeping the framed square centered. Repeat to make 12 block center units.


Block Center Unit - Make 12
2. Sew $33 / 8^{"}$ teal tonal and brown print triangles to opposite sides of a 4 " teal floral square. Press seams toward the square. Repeat on the remaining sides of the square to complete (1) $5 \not 1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ D1 unit. Repeat to make 17 D1 units.


D1 Unit - Make 17
3. Repeat step 2 to make 17 L 1 units using cream floral 4 " squares. Repeat to make 7 each D2 and L2 units using cream tonal and brown print $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangles and teal or cream floral squares.

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 " teal tonal, cream tonal, brown print, cream medallions and cream/brown print squares.
5. Place a marked teal square right sides together on opposite corners of each 4" cream medallions square. Stitch on the drawn lines. Trim seam allowance $1 / 4 / 1$ from the stitching lines. Press the teal corners open. Repeat on the remaining corners of the squares to make 24 D3 centers. Repeat with marked cream/brown print squares and 4 " black print squares to make 24 L 3 centers.

6. Sew a $33 / 8$ " cream tonal triangle to opposite sides of each D3 center. Press seams toward the triangles. Repeat on the remaining sides to complete (24) $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ D3 units. Repeat with the L3 centers to make 24 L3 units.

7. Repeat step 5 with marked teal squares and the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rust paisley squares to make (17) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " sashing center units.


Sashing Center Unit - Make 17
8. Place a marked brown print square right sides together on 1 corner of (24) $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " cream medallions rectangles. Stitch on the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " from the stitching. Press the brown corner open. Repeat on the adjacent corner of each rectangle to complete (24) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} \times 4$ " S1 units.

9. Repeat step 8 with marked cream tonal squares and $31 / 2$ " x $4^{\prime \prime}$ cream medallions rectangles to make 10 S 2 units. Repeat with marked cream medallions squares and 3 " x $3^{11 / 2}$ " teal tonal rectangles to make 34 S3 units.

## Star Blocks

1. Dark Corner Star Blocks: Sew a block center unit between a D2 unit and a D1 unit to make the center row. Press seams away from the center unit. Stitch a D2 unit between 2 D3 units to make the top row. Press seams toward the D2 unit. Sew a D1 unit between 2 D3 units to make the bottom row. Press seams toward the D1 unit. Join the rows to complete (1) $151 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2}$ " Dark Corner Star block. Press seams toward the center row. Repeat to make a second block.


Dark Corner Star Block - Make 2
2. Dark Edge Star Blocks: Sew a block center unit between 2 D1 units to make the center row. Press seams away from the center unit. Stitch a D1 unit between 2 D3 units to make the top row. Press seams toward the D1 unit. Sew a D2 unit between 2 D3 units to make the bottom row. Press seams toward the D2 unit. Join the rows to complete (1) $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Dark Edge Star block.
Press seams toward the center row. Repeat to make 3 blocks.

3. Dark Center Star Block: Sew a block center unit between 2 D1 units to make the center row. Press seams away from the center unit. Stitch a D1 unit between 2 D3 units to make the top row. Press seams toward the D1 unit. Repeat to make the bottom row. Join the rows to complete the $15^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{1 / 2}$ " Dark Center Star block. Press seams toward the center row.


Dark Center Star Block - Make 1
4. Light Corner Star Blocks: Sew a block center unit between an L2 unit and an L1 unit to make the center row. Press seams away from the center unit. Stitch an L1 unit between 2 L3 units to make the top row. Press seams toward the L2 unit. Sew an L2 unit between 2 L3 units to make the bottom row. Press seams toward the L2 unit. Join the rows to complete (1) $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " Light Corner Star block. Press seams toward the center row. Repeat to make a second block.


Light Corner Star Block - Make 2
2. Stitch a sashing center unit between 2 S3 units. Press seams toward the S3 units. Add an S1 unit to 1 end and an S2 unit to the remaining end to complete (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge sashing strip. Press seams toward the S1 and S2 units. Repeat to make 10 edge sashing strips.

## Quilt Assembly <br> Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed throughout the following steps.

1. Sew 2 Dark Corner Star blocks and 1 Light Edge Star block together with 2 edge sashing strips to make the $151 / 2$ " $\times 511 / 2$ " block row 1 . Press seams toward the blocks. Repeat with 2 Light Corner Star blocks and 1 Dark Edge Star block to make block row 4.
2. Stitch 2 Light Edge Star blocks and the Dark Center Star block together with 2 center sashing strips to make block row 2. Press seams toward the blocks. Repeat with 2 Dark Edge Star blocks and the Light Center Star block to make block row 3 .
3. Sew 2 edge sashing strips and 1 center sashing strip together with (2) $3^{1 / 2}$ " floral tile flower squares to make a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 \frac{1}{2}$ " sashing row. Press seams toward the flower squares. Repeat to make 3 sashing rows.
4. Stitch the block rows alternately together with the sashing rows to complete the $51 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 691 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt center. Press seams to 1 side.
5. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF cream tonal strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) $69 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $5311^{\prime 2}$, (2) $77 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $61 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ lengths. Stitch the $691 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the $53^{1 / 2}$ " strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips. Set aside the $771 / 2$ " and $611 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the outer border.
6. Stitch the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF teal paisley strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) $71 \frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) $591 / 2$ " lengths. Sew the longer strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
7. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 771 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream tonal strips from step 4 to the long sides of the quilt center and the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $611 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. Press seams to 1 side.
8. Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim the side edges to make a 69" x 87" backing piece.
9. Layer the top with the backing and a 69 " $x 87$ " batting piece. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method and the teal tonal binding strips to complete the quilt.

## Cutting Directions:

$\mathbf{W O F}=$ width of fabric from selvage to selvage. Remove as little fabric as possible when squaring strip ends.

## 24214 Q - Teal Floral

- Cut (1) $61 / 2 "$ x WOF strip; recut into (2) $61 / 2$ " squares and (4) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from top left to lower right to make 2 triangles and (1) $61 / 2$ " square from top right to lower left to make 2 reversed triangles.


## 24216 J - Black Medallions

- Cut (1) $41 / 2$ " x WOF strip; recut into (6) $41 / 2$ " squares.
- Cut (2) $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime \prime} x$ WOF strips; recut into (28) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (4) $2 \frac{1}{1} 4^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips for binding.


## 24219 E-Cream Tonal

- Cut (3) $11 / 2$ x X WOF strips.
- Cut (1) $678^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip; recut into (2) $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (11) $21 / 2$ " squares. Cut the $67 / s^{\prime \prime}$ squares twice diagonally to make 8 triangles. Set aside 2 triangles for another project.
- Cut (1) $2^{112} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; recut into (13) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips; recut into (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ " strips and (4) 2 " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.


## 24219 Q - Teal Tonal

- Cut (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} x$ WOF strip.
- Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip; recut into (6) $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (3) $1 \frac{112 " x}{} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips; recut into (2) $34 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ lengths and (2) $191 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ lengths for border.


## 24219 S - Gold Tonal

-Cut (2) $11 / 2$ x X WOF strips.

## 24215 Q - Teal Paisley (Backing Only)

- Cut (1) 25 " x 42" backing piece.


## Blocks

Note: Use a ${ }^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " seam allowance for all stitching.

1. Sew a $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF gold tonal strip lengthwise together with a $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ X WOF cream tonal strip to make a strip set. Press seam toward the gold strip. Repeat to make a second strip set. Crosscut the strip sets into (40) $11 / 2$ " gold segments.

2. Repeat step 1 with the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF teal tonal and remaining cream tonal strip to make a strip set and crosscut into (16) $1^{11 / 2}$ " teal segments.
3. Join 2 gold segments to make a $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " gold unit. Press seam to 1 side. Repeat to make 20 gold units. Repeat with the teal segments to make 8 teal units.

4. Sew a $2^{112}$ " black medallions square to each gold and teal unit to make $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " rows. Press seams toward the black squares. Join 2 gold rows to make a $4 \frac{1}{2} / \mathrm{x}$ $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Gold Four-Patch block. Press seam to 1 side. Repeat to make 10 blocks. Repeat with the teal rows to make 4 Teal Four-Patch blocks.

5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ cream tonal square.

## Setting Triangles

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ teal tonal squares.
2. Place a marked square right sides together on the square corner of each cream tonal triangle. Stitch on the line. Trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " from the stitching. Press the teal triangles open to complete 6 edge triangles.

3. Sew a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2}$ " cream tonal strip to the left edge of each teal floral triangle and the right edge of each reversed teal floral triangle. Press seam toward each strip. Stitch the 2" x 10" cream strips to the bottom of each triangle. Press seam toward each strip. Trim the strip ends even with the diagonal edge of each triangle to complete 2 corner triangles and 2 reversed corner triangles.
4. Place a marked square right sides together on 1 corner of a $41 / 2$ " black medallions square. Stitch on the line. Trim seam allowance to $11 / 4$ from the stitching. Press the cream corner open. Repeat on each corner of the black square to complete (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Diagonal Square block. Repeat to make 6 blocks.

## Runner Assembly

Refer to the exploded runner center diagram as needed throughout the following steps.

1. Sew a Teal Four-Patch block between 2 Gold Four-Patch blocks and add an edge triangle to 1 end to make an A row. Press seams toward the edge triangle end of the row. Repeat to make a second A row.
2. Join 2 Diagonal Square blocks and add a Teal Four-Patch block to 1 end and a Gold Four-Patch block and then an edge triangle to the opposite end to make a B row. Press seams toward Teal Four-Patch block end of the row. Repeat to make a second B row.
3. Join 2 teal floral squares and add a Gold Four-Patch block and then an edge triangle to 1 end. Add a Diagonal Square block and then a Gold Four-Patch block to the opposite end to make a C row. Press seams toward the edge triangle end of the row. Repeat to make a second C row.
4. Join the rows. Press seams to 1 side. Center and stitch a corner triangle or reversed corner triangle to each angled edge to complete the $17 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 34 \frac{1}{2}$ " runner center. Press seams toward the corner triangles.
5. Referring to the cover runner, sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 34 \frac{1}{2}$ " teal tonal strips to the long sides of the runner center and the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 191 / 2$ " strips to the short ends to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.
6. Layer the top with the teal paisley backing and a $25^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $42^{\prime \prime}$ batting piece. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method and the black medallions binding strips to complete the runner.
