## Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Floral - Black (A), cut:
Runner
-(1) $101 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ strip from the length of fabric (LOF).
From the Monotone Floral - Black (B), cut:
Runner
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
Place Mats
-(4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
From the Folio - White on White (C), cut:
Runner
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
From the Birds/Bees - Blue (D), cut:

## Runner

- (4) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) $41 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (E): <br> Runner

- Fussy cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 70$ " LOF strips, each centered on a row of houses.
- Fussy cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 34$ " LOF strips, each centered on a row of houses.


## From the Dot - Black (F), cut:

## Runner

-(5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the runner binding.

## From the Dot - White/Multi (G), cut: <br> Place Mats

- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips.
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (8) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Monotone Floral - Green (H), cut: Place Mats

- (1) $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 2 " x $141 / 2$ " strips, (6) $2 " \times 131 / 2 "$ strips and (6) $2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the place mat bindings.

From the Panel - Multi (I):
Place Mats

- Fussy cut (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip, centered on a birdhouse.
- Fussy cut (3) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips, each centered on a beehive, flowers or watering can.

From the Geometric - Yellow (J), cut:
Runner

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $11 / 2 \times 481 / 2$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} / \times$ X WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Floral - Blue (Backing), cut:

## Runner

-(1) $38^{\prime \prime} \times 74$ " strip for the backing.
Place Mats

- (2) 24 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) 18 " x 24 " strips for the backs.


## Sewing Instructions

Runner Top

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric B strip and (1) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF Fabric C strip together lengthwise to make (1) BC strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second BC strip set.
2. Cut the BC strip sets into (32) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2$ " BC strips (Fig. 2).
3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the
$10^{1 / 2 "} \times 46^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric A strip. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the center block.

## Runner Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 4 while assembling.)
4. Sew (3) BC strips together end to end to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block.
5. Sew (13) BC strips together end to end to make (1) strip. Repeat to make second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the center block.
6. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block to make the runner top.
7. Center (1) $31 / 2 " \times 34 "$ Fabric E strip on one side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
8. Repeat Step 7 to sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 70^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 3).
9. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 3), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (5) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF Fabric F strips together, end
to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this
long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and

## Sewing Instructions

## Place Mat Tops

13. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 141 / 2$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 14^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric I strip. Trim the block to measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to make place mat center A (Fig. 5).

14. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ Fabric I strip. Sew (1) $2 " \times 131 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I strip. Trim the block to measure $121 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ to make place mat center B (Fig. 6). Repeat to make place mat centers C and D .

15. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strip to make (1) BGB strip set (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second BGB strip set.
16. Cut the BGB strip sets into (16) $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2$ " BGB strips (Fig. 8).
17. Sew (1) BGB strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to make (1) BB strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (8) BB strips total.

## Place Mat Top Assembly

18. Sew (1) BB strip to each side of place mat center A to make (1) place mat top (Fig. 10).

19. Sew (1) BB strip to each side of the place mat center B, C and D to make the other (3) place mat tops (Fig. 11).

20. Layer and quilt as desired.
21. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Divide the long strip into (4) even strips. Fold these strips in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
22. Bind as desired.
