

Dot - White/Multi (G)	6494-86

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Floral - Black (A), cut: Runner

• (1) 10 ½" x 46 ½" strip from the length of fabric (LOF).

From the Monotone Floral - Black (B), cut: Runner

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

Place Mats

• (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Folio - White on White (C), cut: Runner

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Birds/Bees - Blue (D), cut: Runner

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 4 ½" x 16 ½" strips.

From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (E): Runner

- Fussy cut (2) 3 ½" x 70" LOF strips, each centered on a row of houses.
- Fussy cut (2) 3 ½" x 34" LOF strips, each centered on a row of houses.

From the Dot - Black (F), cut:

• (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the runner binding.

From the Dot - White/Multi (G), cut: Place Mats

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Monotone Floral - Green (H), cut: Place Mats

- (1) 14 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 2" x 14 ½" strips, (6) 2" x 13 ½" strips and (6) 2" x 12 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the place mat bindings.

From the Panel - Multi (I): Place Mats

- Fussy cut (1) 10 ½" x 14 ½" strip, centered on a birdhouse.
 Fussy cut (3) 10 ½" x 12 ½" strips, each centered on a beehive, flowers or watering can.

From the Geometric - Yellow (J), cut: Runner

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

From the Floral - Blue (Backing), cut: Runner

• (1) 38" x 74" strip for the backing.


Place Mats

• (2) 24" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) 18" x 24" strips for the backs.

Sewing Instructions

Runner Top

- 1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip and (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strip together lengthwise to make (1) BC strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second BC strip set.
- 2. Cut the BC strip sets into (32) 2 ½" x 4 ½" BC strips (Fig. 2).
- 3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the 10 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the center block.



Runner Top Assembly (Refer to Figure 4 while assembling.)

- 4. Sew (3) BC strips together end to end to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block.
- 5. Sew (13) BC strips together end to end to make (1) strip. Repeat to make second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the center block.
- 6. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block to make the runner top.

- 7. Center (1) 3 ½" x 34" Fabric E strip on one side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ½" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a ½" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 8. Repeat Step 7 to sew (1) 3 ½" x 70" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 3).

9. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 3), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

- 10. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 11. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 12. Bind as desired.



Sewing Instructions *Place Mat Tops*

13. Sew (1) 2" x 14 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the 10 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric I strip. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" x 14 ½" to make place mat center A (Fig. 5).





14. Sew (1) 2" x 12 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric I strip. Sew (1) 2" x 13 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I strip. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" x 14 ½" to make place mat center B (Fig. 6). Repeat to make place mat centers C and D.



15. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strip to make (1) BGB strip set (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second BGB strip set.


16. Cut the BGB strip sets into (16) 4 ½" x 6 ½" BGB strips (Fig. 8).

17. Sew (1) BGB strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip to make (1) BB strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (8) BB strips total.




Place Mat Top Assembly

18. Sew (1) BB strip to each side of place mat center A to make (1) place mat top (Fig. 10).



19. Sew (1) BB strip to each side of the place mat center B, C and D to make the other (3) place mat tops (Fig. 11).



20. Layer and quilt as desired.

21. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Divide the long strip into (4) even strips. Fold these strips in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

22. Bind as desired.
