Feather Your Nest

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Twin/Throw & Pillow:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.


Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square and 4 panels to approximately 8-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-1/2" x 92" and (2) 8-1/2" x 68" stripe borders


Fabric C - Cut (1) 9-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 3" x 9-1/2" and (4) 2-1/2" x 9" strips
Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (2) 3" x 8-1/2" and (1) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (3) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 69-1/2" and (2) 1-3/4" x 48" borders
Cut (6) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/2" x 12" and (8) 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips



Fabric E - Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 9-1/2" and (4) 3" x 8-1/2" strips
Cut (3) 1" strips, subcut (4) 1" x 12-1/2" and (4) 1" x 11-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles
Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" borders

Fabric G - Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (28) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" and (4) 2-1/2" x 9" strips
Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 10" and (4) 3" x 8-1/2" strips
Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8"  squares, then cut in half diagonally for 16 triangles
Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares and (4) 3" squares
Cut (3) 1" strips, subcut (4) 1" x 12-1/2" and (4) 1" x 11-1/2" strips

Fabric J - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-7/8" squares, then cut 2 in half diagonally   in one direction and 2 in half in the other direction for 8 triangles
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

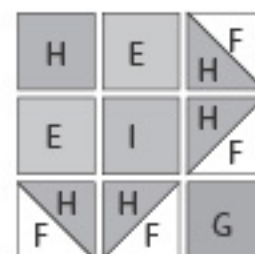
Fabric K - Cut (1) 15" strip, subcut (2) 15" x 20-1/2" pieces for pillow back

2. Piecing Order for Twin/Throw:

1. Sew **Fabric F** and **H** 4-7/8" triangles together along long edges. Make a total of 16 triangle units (4-1/2" square unfinished).



2. Arrange 4-1/2" squares and triangle units in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

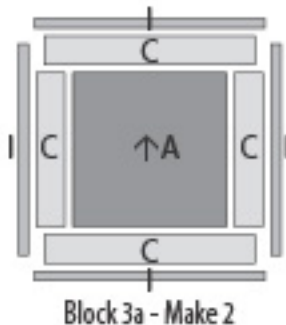
3. Arrange 4-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

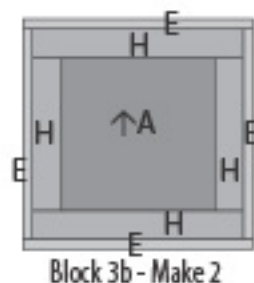
4. Stitch **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x 9" strips to right and left sides of a **Fabric A** 8-1/2" panel. Trim strip ends even. Add **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 11-1/2" square.**



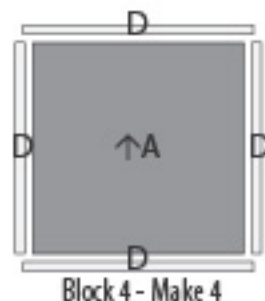
Stitch 1" x 11-1/2" **Fabric I** strips to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add 1" x 12-1/2" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom. Make a total of 2 **Block 3a** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

5. In the same manner, add **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 9" and 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips. **Trim bordered panel to 11-1/2" square.** Add **Fabric E** strips 1" x 11-1/2" and 1" x 12-1/2" strips. Make a total of 2 **Block 3b**. Set aside 1 for pillow top.



6. Stitch 1-1/2" x 12" **Fabric D** strips to right and left sides of a **Fabric A** 11-1/2" panel. Trim strip ends even. Add **Fabric D** 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square.** Make a total of 4 **Block 4** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

8. Arrange blocks in 5 rows of 3 blocks each. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete center of quilt (36-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished).

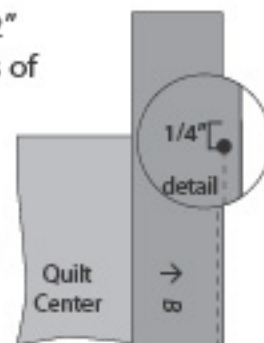
9. Stitch **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of center of quilt. Add **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" borders to top and bottom.

10. Arrange 2 **Fabric H** 3" x 10", 3 **Fabric C** 3" x 9-1/2", and 2 **Fabric E** 3" x 9-1/2" pieces in a vertical row on right side of quilt. Sew pieces into row (3" x 64-1/2" unfinished). Sew row to quilt. Repeat to make and add left border.

11. Arrange 2 **Fabric H** 3" x 8-1/2", 1 **Fabric C** 3" x 8-1/2", 2 **Fabric E** 3" x 8-1/2" pieces, and 2 **Fabric I** 3" squares in a horizontal row on top of quilt. Sew pieces into row (3" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Sew row to quilt. Repeat to make and add bottom border.

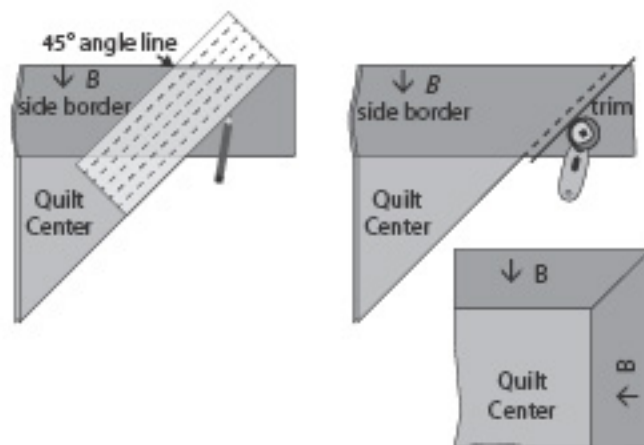
12. Stitch **Fabric D** 1-3/4" x 69-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric D** 1-3/4" x 48" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

13. Center **Fabric B** 8-1/2" x 92" borders on right and left sides of quilt center. Center **Fabric B** 8-1/2" x 68" borders on top and bottom of quilt center. Sew borders to quilt starting and stopping 1/4" from edges of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

14. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.

15. The quilt measures approximately 64" x 88" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

3. Piecing Order for Pillow:

1. Stitch a **Fabric D** 4-1/2" square between 2 **Fabric G** 4-1/2" squares. Make a total of 4 edge units (4-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



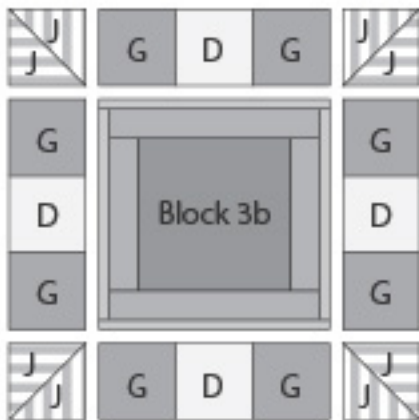
Edge Units - Make 4

2. Stitch 2 **Fabric J** 4-7/8" triangles together as shown. Make a total of 4 corner units (4-1/2" square unfinished).

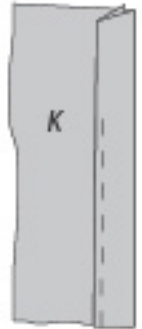
3. Arrange **Block 3b** (set aside when making the Twin/Throw quilt), 4 edge units, and 4 corner units in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to make pillow top (20-1/2" square unfinished).



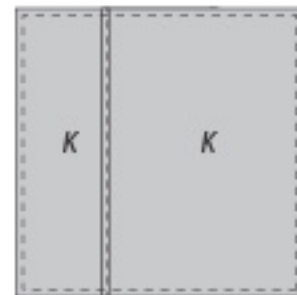
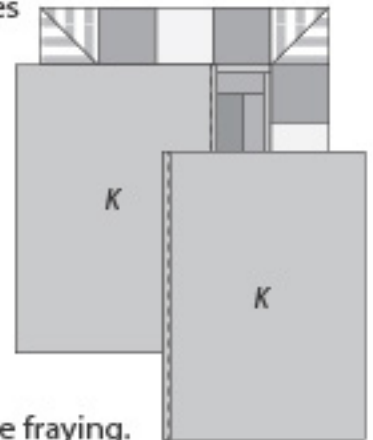
Pillow Layout

4. (Optional) Layer pillow top with 24" square quilt batting and an 24" square of lining fabric (not listed in materials list). Quilt as desired. Trim edges even with pillow top.

5. Fold a 20-1/2" edge of a **Fabric K** 15" x 20-1/2" piece to wrong side 1/2". Fold over to wrong side 1/2" again. Press flat and top stitch. Repeat on second **Fabric K** 15" x 20-1/2" piece.



6. Place **Fabric K** pieces right sides together on pillow top, with hemmed edges overlapping. Align raw edges on all sides and pin. Stitch around all corners with a 1/4" seam allowance. Stitch around edges with a zig zag stitch to reduce fraying.



7. Turn pillow cover right side out. Insert 20" pillow form and enjoy.

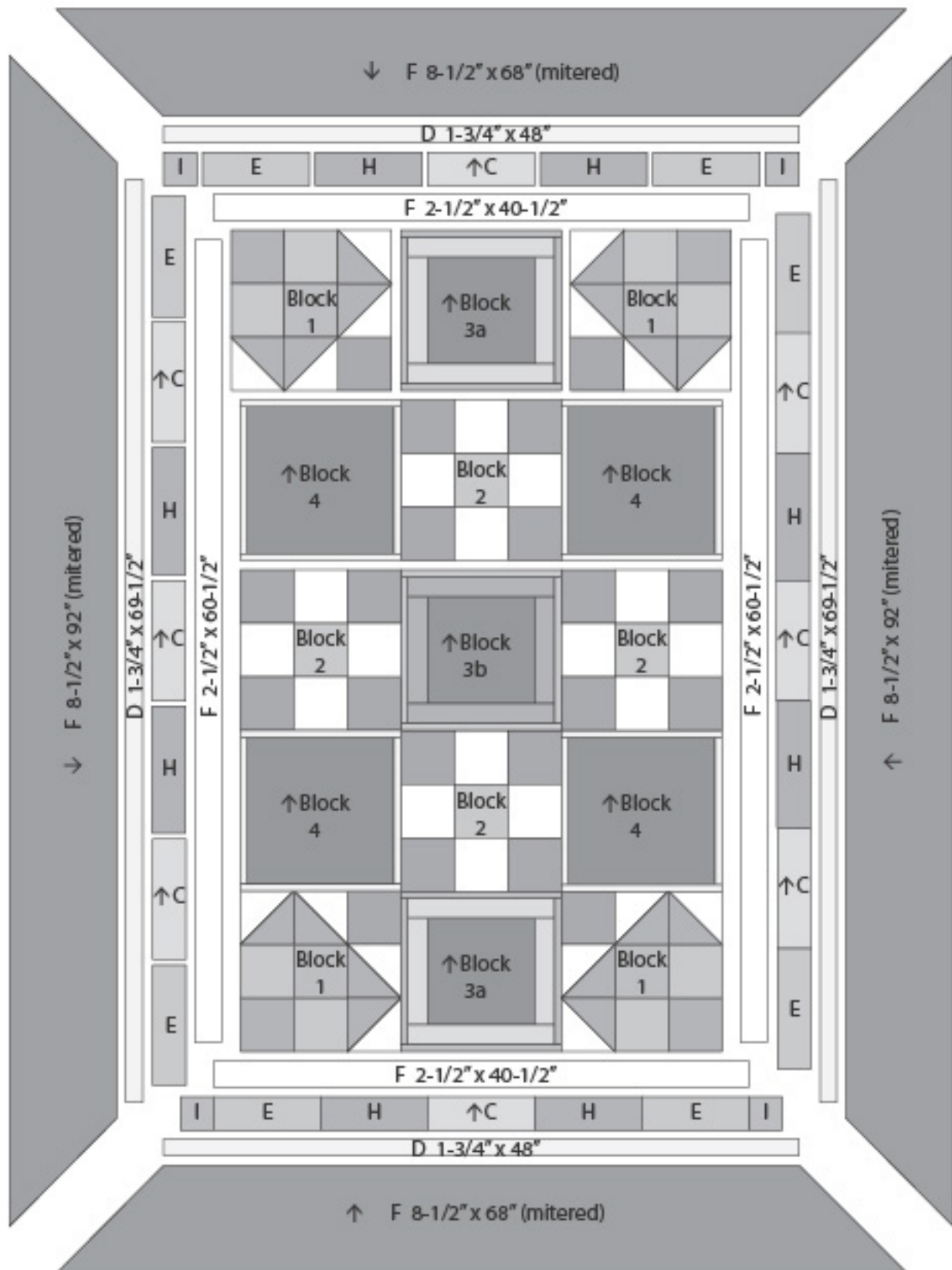

Feather Your Nest

1. Cut the following for Wall/Sofa Quilt:

Fabric A - Fussy cut $1/4"$ beyond outside edges of panel to approximately $23-1/2" \times 42"$

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) $8-1/2" \times 47"$ floral stripe with narrow stripe on top, (1) $8-1/2" \times 47"$ floral stripe with narrow stripe on bottom, and (2) $2" \times 26-1/2"$ narrow border stripes

Fabric J - Cut (6) $2-1/2"$ strips (binding)

Fabric G - Cut (3) $6-1/2"$ strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) $6-1/2" \times 55"$ borders and (1) $3-1/2" \times 10"$ strip

Cut (2) $3-1/2"$ strips, sewn together end to end with the $3-1/2" \times 10"$ strip and cut into (2) $3-1/2" \times 45-1/2"$ borders

Fabric E - Cut (3) $2-1/2"$ strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) $2-1/2" \times 45"$ borders and (1) $1-1/2" \times 10"$ strip

Cut (4) $2"$ strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) $2" \times 49"$ and (2) $2" \times 24"$ borders

Cut (2) $1-1/2"$ strips, sewn together end to end with the $1-1/2" \times 10"$ strip and cut into (2) $1-1/2" \times 42-1/2"$ borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Refer to Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.

2. Stitch $2" \times 24"$ **Fabric E** borders to short sides of the $23-1/2" \times 42"$ **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add the $2-1/2" \times 45"$ **Fabric E** borders to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to $26-1/2" \times 44"$ (unfinished).**

3. Sew **Fabric B** $2" \times 26-1/2"$ narrow stripe borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Stitch **Fabric B** $8-1/2" \times 47"$ floral borders to top and bottom.

4. Stitch $1-1/2" \times 42-1/2"$ **Fabric E** borders to sides of quilt. Add $2" \times 49"$ **Fabric E** borders to top and bottom.

5. Sew $3-1/2" \times 45-1/2"$ **Fabric G** borders to sides of quilt. Add $6-1/2" \times 55"$ **Fabric G** borders to top and bottom.

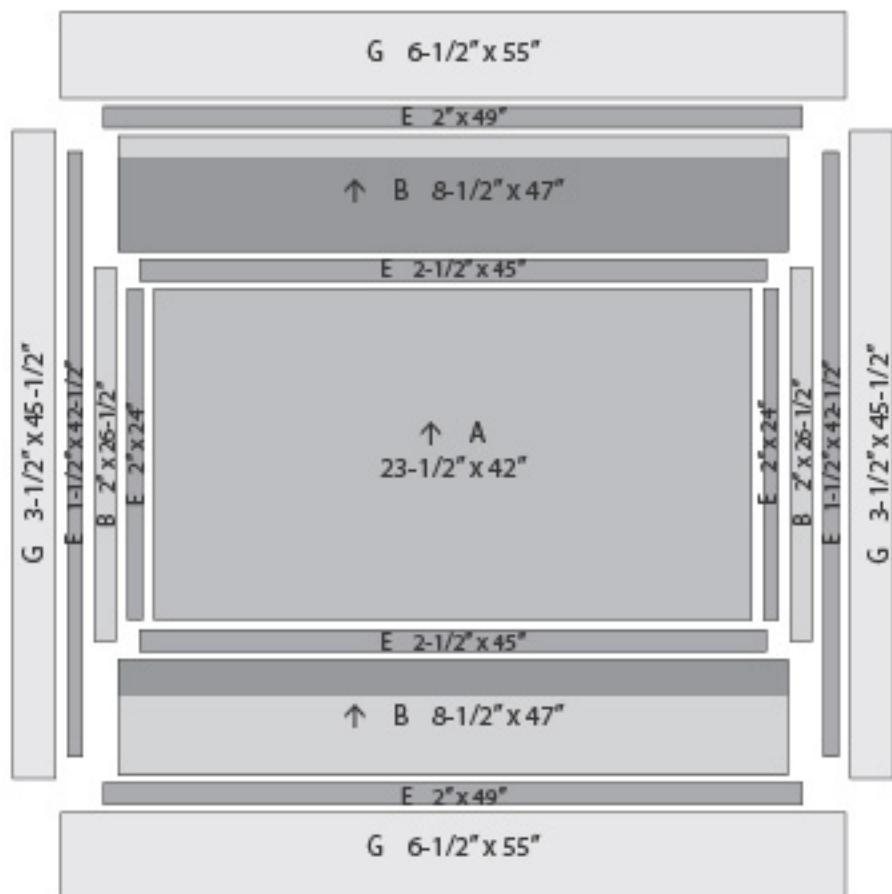
6. The quilt measures approximately $55" \times 57-1/2"$ (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric D**) at least $8"$ larger than the top.

7. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.



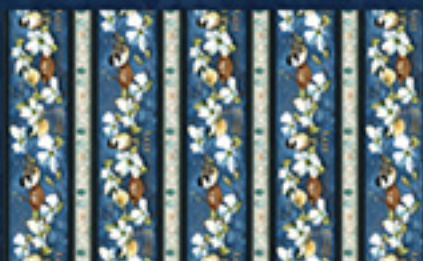

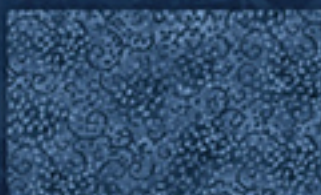

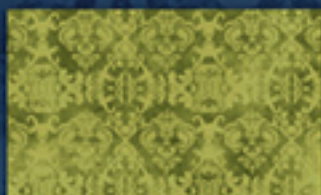
