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# Garden Hideaway

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of  
4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square,  
2 panels approximately 9" square, and  
2 panels approximately 7-3/4" square

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-1/2" x 91" and  
(2) 8-1/2" x 82" multi-stripe borders

**Fabric C** - Cut (3) 6-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 6-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips

Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares

**Fabric D** - Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips, subcut  
(4) 4-1/2" x 16-1/2" and (4) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips  
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" and (4) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips

Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 20-1/2" strips

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 14" strips

Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (4) 2" x 14" strips

**Fabric E** - Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut  
(2) 3" x 10-1/4" and (2) 3" x 8" strips  
Cut (1) 1-3/4" strip, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 10-1/4" and (2) 1-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" and (4) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 13" and (8) 1-1/4" x 12" strips

**Fabric F** - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut  
(2) 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" and (4) 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips

**Fabric G** - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabric H** - Cut (7) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 68-1/2" and  
(2) 2" x 62-1/2" borders

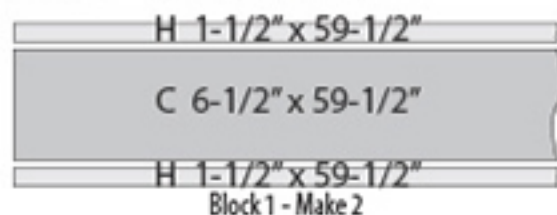
Cut (6) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (4) 1-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips

Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/4" x 20-1/2" and (8) 1-1/4" x 16-1/2" strips

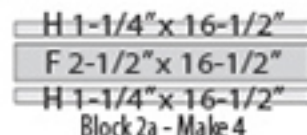
**Fabric I** - Cut (2) 3-3/4" strips, subcut  
(4) 3-3/4" x 12-1/2" strips  
Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 12-1/2" and  
(4) 3" x 10" strips  
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" and (4) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips  
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (4) 2" x 17" strips  
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut  
(4) 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" strips

## 2. Piecing Order:

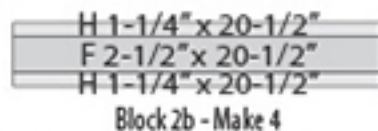
1. Sew a **Fabric C** 6-1/2" x 59-1/2" strip between two **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips lengthwise. Make a total of 2 **Block 1** (8-1/2" x 59-1/2" unfinished).



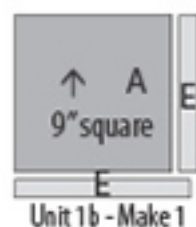
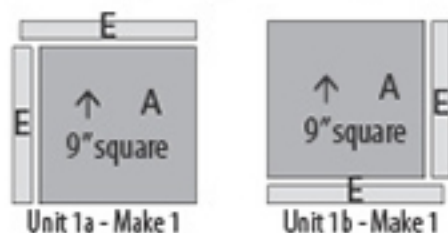
2. Sew a **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip between two **Fabric H** 1-1/4" x 16-1/2" strips lengthwise. Make a total of 4 **Block 2a** (4" x 16-1/2" unfinished). In the



same manner, make (2) 20-1/2" long **Block 2b**.

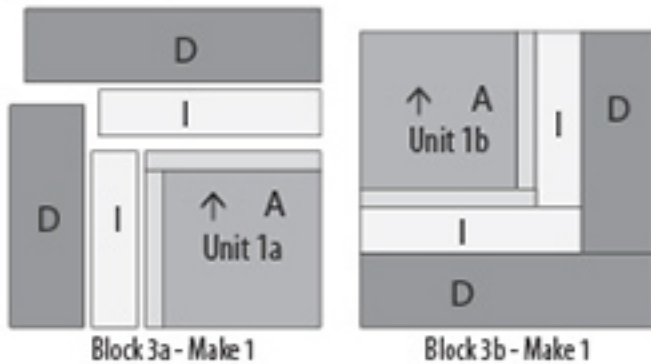


3. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips to **Fabric A** 9" squares as shown. Trim strip ends even. Add **Fabric E** 1-3/4" x 10-1/4" strips as shown. *Trim Fabric E sides of Units 1a and 1b so they are 10" square (unfinished).*

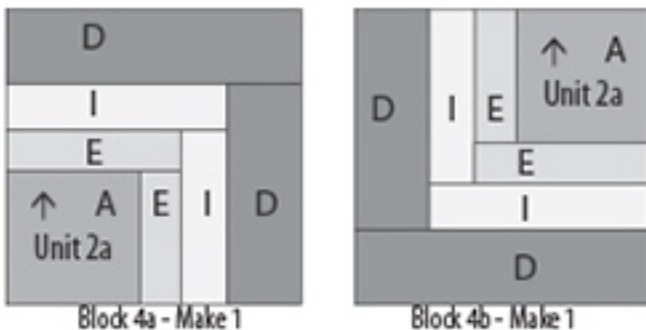


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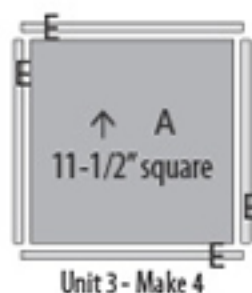
4. Sew **Fabric I** 3" x 10" strips to Units 1a and 1b. Add **Fabric I** 3" x 12-1/2" strips as shown. Stitch **Fabric D** 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to units. Add **Fabric D** 4-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips as shown. **Blocks 3a** and **3b** measure 16-1/2" square (unfinished).



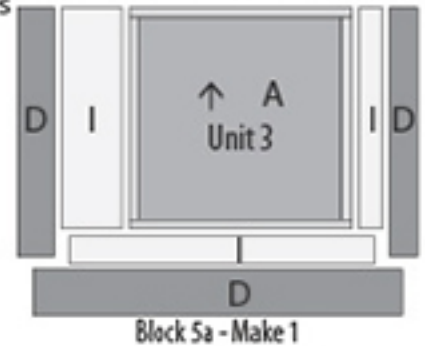
5. Stitch **Fabric E** 3" x 8" strips to **Fabric A** 7-3/4" squares as shown. Trim strip ends even. Add **Fabric E** 3" x 10-1/4" strips as shown. *Trim Fabric E sides of Units 2a and 2b so they are 10" square (unfinished).* Add **Fabrics I** and **D** strips referring to Step 4 and **Blocks 4a** and **4b** block diagrams.



6. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of a 11-1/2" **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished).* Make a total of 4 Unit 3.



7. Sew **Fabric I** 3-3/4" x 12-1/2" and 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" strips to sides of a Unit 3 as shown. Add **Fabric I** 2" x 17" strip to bottom. Stitch **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 14" and 2" x 14" strips to sides of block as shown. Add **Fabric D** 3" x 20-1/2" strip to bottom to complete **Block 5a** (16-1/2" x 20-1/2" unfinished).



8. In the same manner as Step 7, add **Fabrics I** and **D** strips to remaining Units 3 referring to **Blocks 5b, 5c, and 5d** in the Quilt Layout (Page 4) for positioning of strips.

9. Sew a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the bottom of a **Fabric C** 4-1/2" square. Add a 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" **Fabric E** strip to side as shown. Sew a 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" **Fabric I** strip to the bottom of block. Add a 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" **Fabric I** strip to side as shown. Sew a 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" **Fabric D** strip to the bottom of block. Add a 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" **Fabric D** strip to side as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (10-1/2" square unfinished).



10. Arrange 4 Unit 4 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 6** (20-1/2" square unfinished).



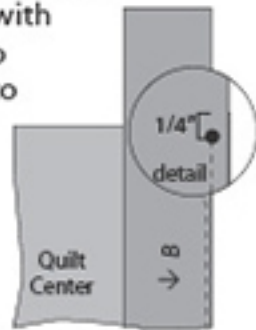
11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

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12. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Sew blocks into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (59-1/2" x 68-1/2" unfinished).

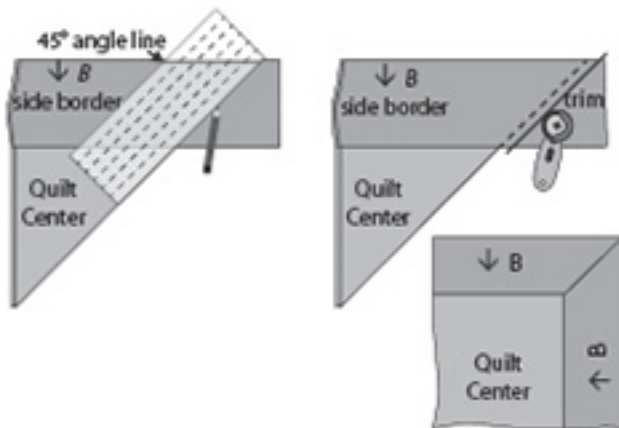
13. Sew **Fabric H** 2" x 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 2" x 62-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

14. Center **Fabric B** 8-1/2" x 91" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 8-1/2" x 82" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the wide floral stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.*

15. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



16. The quilt measures approximately 78-1/2" x 87-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

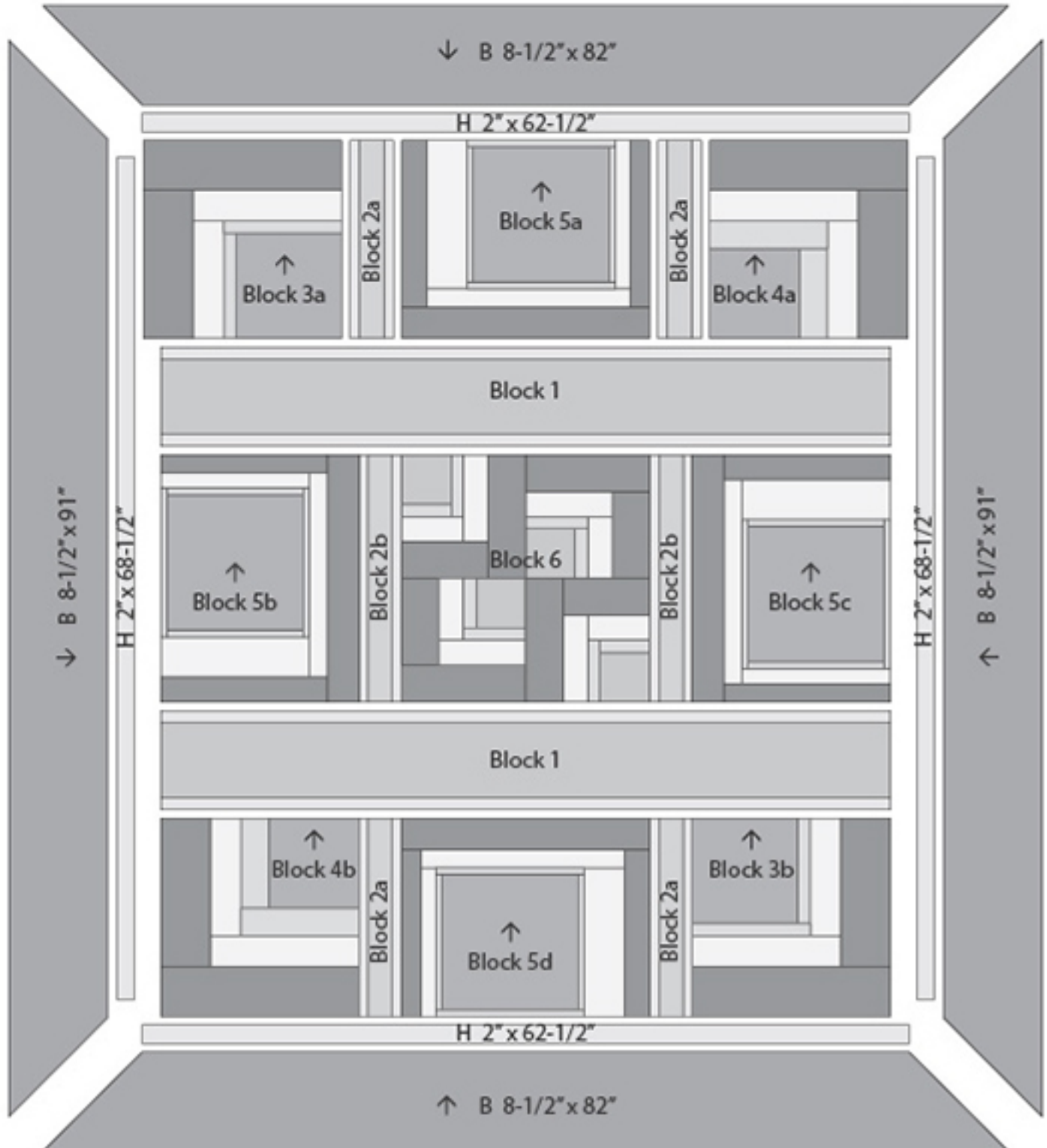
17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

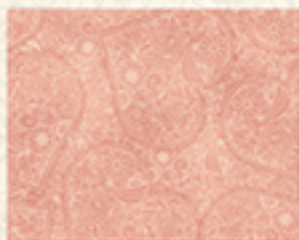

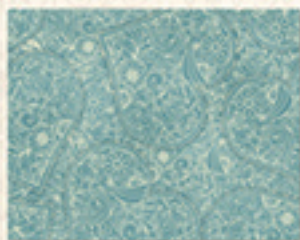

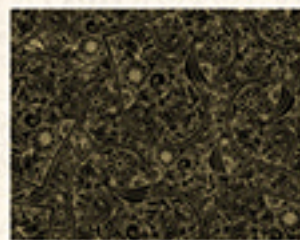

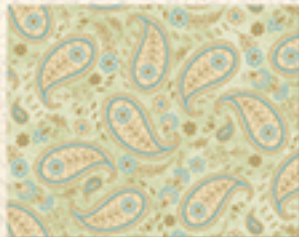
