Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Table Topper:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" x 16-1/2"

Fabrics C and D - From each fabric:


Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 13" and (2) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabrics E and F - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 5" and (2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (4) 1-3/4" x 12" strips

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 19" strips

Fabric G - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/2" square, (1) 4-1/4" square [then cut in half  twice diagonally for 4 triangles], and (8) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together then cut into (4) 2" x 28" strips, (4) 2" x 22" strips, and (4) 2" squares

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips

Fabric I - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (4) 2" strips, from each strip cut (1) 2" x 21-1/2" strip and (1) 2" x 18-1/2" strip for 4 strips each length

Cut (3) 2" strips, subcut (8) 2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabrics J and K - From each fabric:

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 9" and (2) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

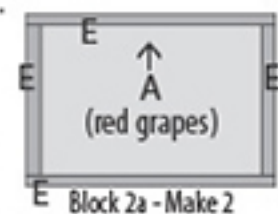
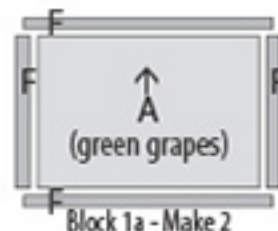
2. Piecing Order for Table Topper:

1. Stitch **Fabric F**

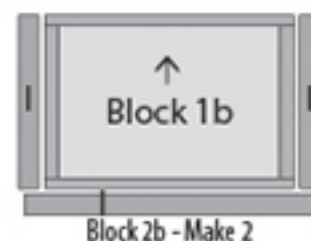
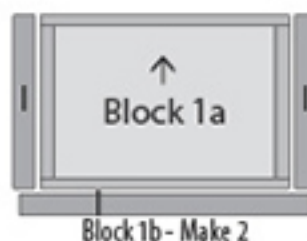
1-3/4" x 12" strips to short sides of a **Fabric A** panel with green grapes. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 19" **Fabric F** strips to top and bottom of panel.

Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" x 18-1/2" (unfinished). Repeat to make a total of 2 **Block 1a** with green grapes in the panel and **Fabric F** borders.

Make 2 **Block 2a** with red grapes in the panel and **Fabric E** borders. *Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" x 18-1/2" (unfinished).*



2. Sew **Fabric I** 2" x 12-1/2" strips to short sides of **Blocks 1a** and **2a**. Add **Fabric I** 2" x 21-1/2" strips to bottom of blocks to complete **Blocks 1b** and **2b** (14" x 21-1/2" unfinished).



3. Arrange 4 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares, the **Fabric G** 4-1/2" square, and 2 each **Fabrics E** and **F** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to make **Unit 1** (8-1/2" square unfinished).

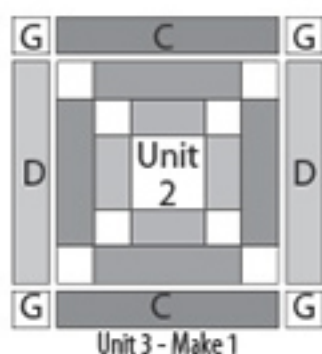


4. Arrange **Unit 1**, 4 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares, 2 each **Fabrics J** and **K** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to make **Unit 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

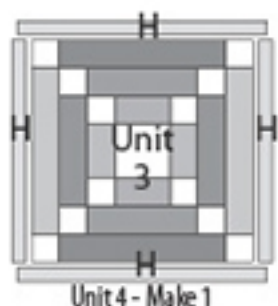


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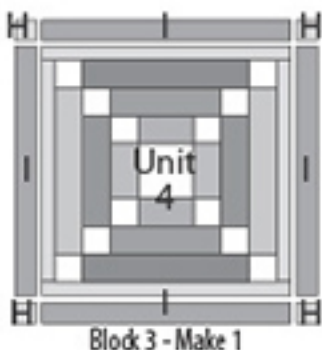
5. Arrange Unit 2, 4 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares, 2 each **Fabrics C and D** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to make Unit 3 (16-1/2" square unfinished).



6. Stitch **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips to sides of Unit 3. Add **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips to top and bottom to make Unit 4 (18-1/2" square unfinished).



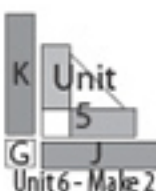
7. Arrange Unit 4, 4 **Fabric H** 2" squares, and 4 **Fabric I** 2" x 18-1/2" strips in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to make **Block 3** (21-1/2" square unfinished).



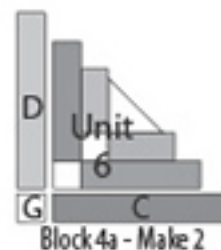
8. Arrange a **Fabric G** 2-1/2" square, 1 **Fabric G** 4-1/4" triangle, and 1 each **Fabrics E and F** 2-1/2" x 5" piece in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make 2 Unit 5 (7" x 7" unfinished).



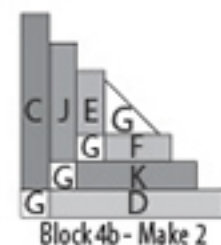
9. Arrange 1 Unit 5, 1 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" square, and 1 each **Fabrics J and K** 2-1/2" x 9" piece in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make 2 Unit 6 (11" x 11" unfinished).



10. Arrange 1 Unit 6, 1 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" square, and 1 each **Fabrics D and C** 2-1/2" x 13" piece in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make 2 Unit 4a (15" x 15" unfinished).



11. Referring to Steps 8-10, make 2 **Block 4b** with fabrics shown.



12. Refer to Table Topper Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

13. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Trim long edges of **Blocks 4a and 4b** even with corners of **Blocks 1b and 2b**. Topper center measures approximately 48-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished.

14. Sew **Fabric H** 2" x 22" to sides of topper center with **Blocks 1b and 2b**. Trim ends even with long edges of **Blocks 4a and 4b**. Add **Fabric H** 2" x 28" to sides of topper center with **Blocks 4a and 4b**. Trim ends even.

15. The table topper measures approximately 51-1/2" x 51-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!

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3. Cut the following for Table Runner:

Fabric B - Referring to the runner image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 12-1/2" x 70" multi-stripe border for backing, (2) 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" light stripe borders, and (2) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" light stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (4) 7-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 7-1/2" x 70" and (10) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

Fabric E - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips and (41) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric J - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

Fabric K - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

4. Piecing Order for Table Runner:

1. Stitch **Fabric G** 2-1/2" square between 2 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. Make a total of 5 Unit 1 (2-1/2" x 14-1/2" unfinished).



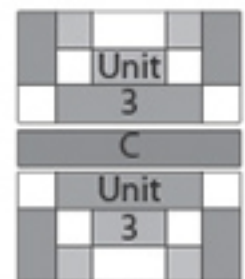
2. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics F** and **G** 2-1/2" squares and 1 each **Fabric E** and **G** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip into 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 2 (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).



3. Arrange 2 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares, 2 **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips, 1 **Fabric J** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip, and 1 Unit 1 in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 3 (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



4. Stitch a **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip between 2 Unit 3. Make a total of 4 Blocks (12-1/2" x 14-1/2" unfinished).



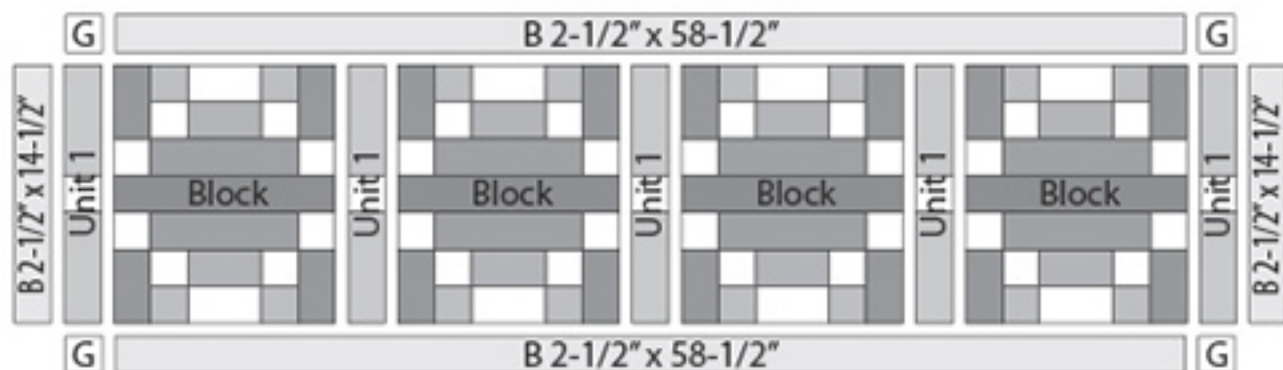
5. Refer to Table Runner Layout for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

6. Arrange blocks and Unit 1 in a horizontal row. Stitch together into runner center (14-1/2" x 58-1/2" unfinished).

7. Sew **Fabric B** 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" borders to short ends of runner center. Sew **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares to ends of both **Fabric B** 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" borders then add to long sides of runner center.

TABLE RUNNER LAYOUT

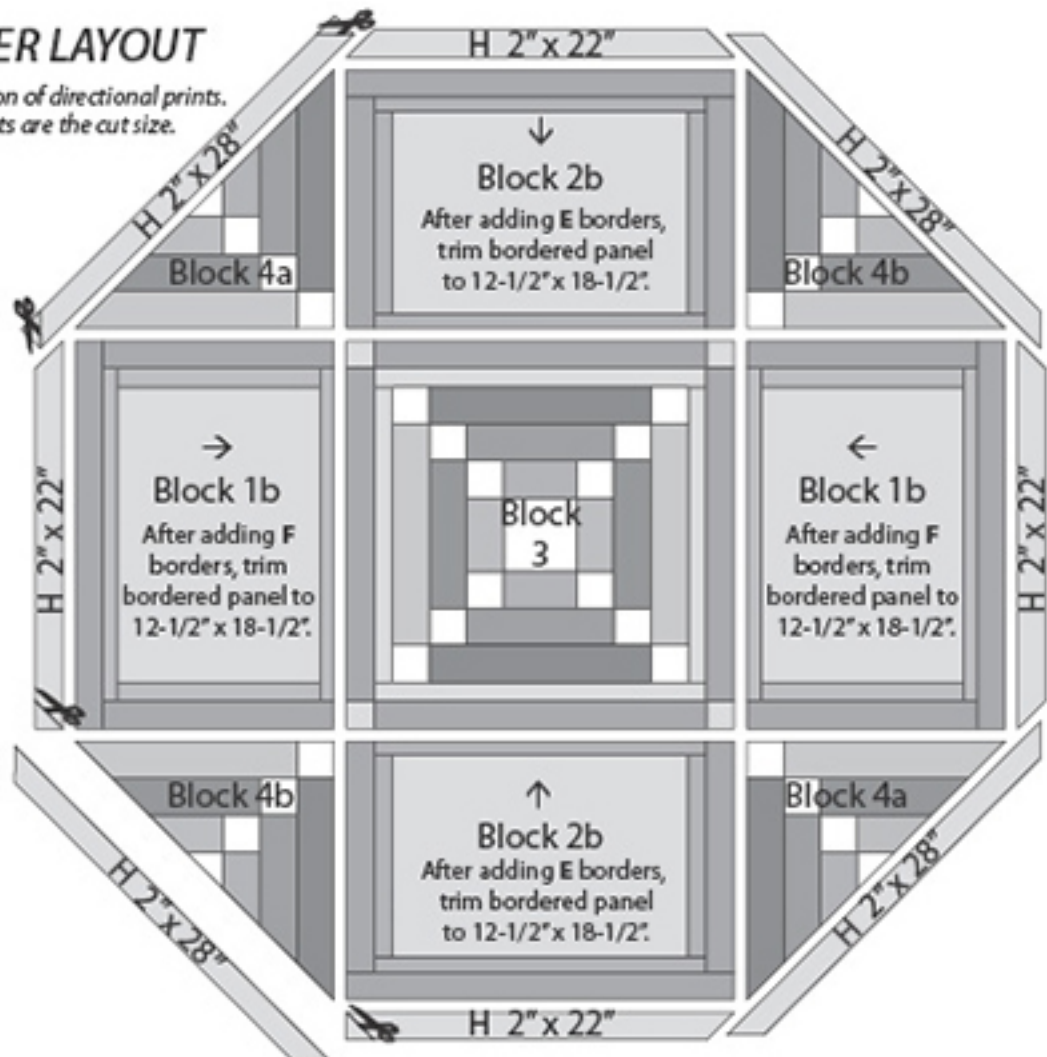

Border measurements are the cut size.

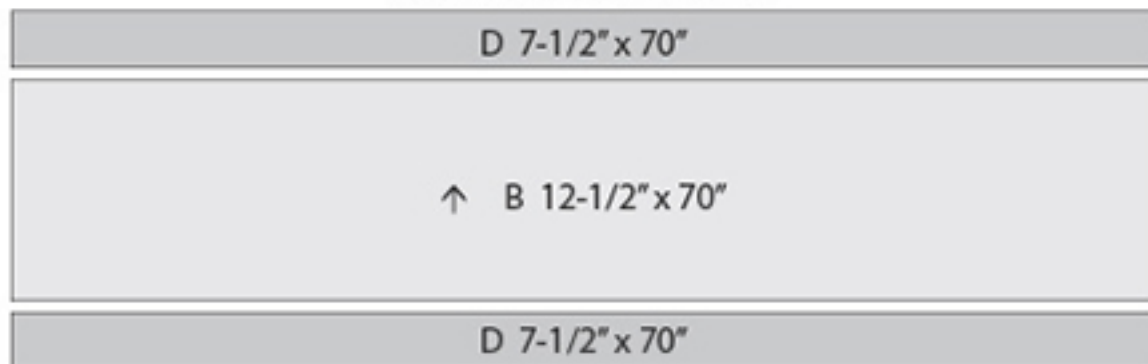


8. The table runner measures approximately 18-1/2" x 62-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing by sewing **Fabric B** 12-1/2" x 70" border strip between **Fabric D** 7-1/2" x 70" strips.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

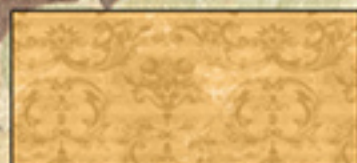

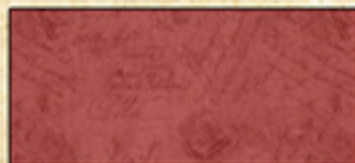

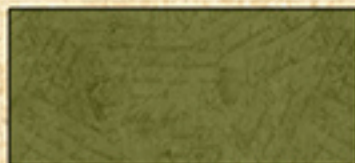
