Block size: $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$


## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Enchanted Forest Collection)

Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout. Press seams as you go
Fabric 1: $5 / 8 \mathrm{syd}-60 \mathrm{~cm}-$ A185.3 (Enchanted forest on midnight blue)
Fabric 2 : $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A187.3 (Fairy houses on midnight blue)
Fabric 3: 3/8yd - 40cm - BB41 (Light linen)
Wadding: 34" x 34"
Backing: $34 " \times 34 "$

## CUTTING

Cut across width of fabric. Note some strips are cut along length of fabric, parallel to selvedge.

1. From fabric 1 cut:

- $12 \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

2. From fabric 2 cut:

- $13 \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

3. From fabric 3 cut:

- $26 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
- $26 \times 11 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## MAKING UP BLOCK



Lay out your fabric pieces for block
Sew the strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{"}$ to the top and bottom. Next sew the sides onto the block, make 13 in total

Lay out as in main diagram sewing in rows and then sew the rows together

## COMPLETION

1. Sandwich quilts top, wadding and backing. Pin or baste layers
2. Quilt as desired
3. Double bind edges with $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ from fabric 1
