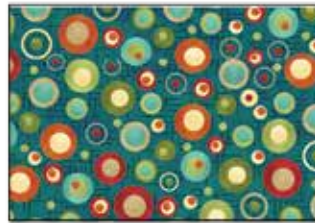

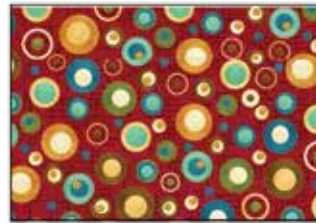

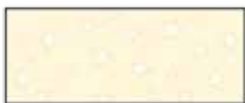

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Calendar Panel - Green (A):

- Fussy cut (12) small panels, each approximately 7" x 9 1/2" for the small mini-quilts.

From the Multi Dot - Brown (B), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip, (1) 2 7/8" square, (6) 2 3/8" squares and (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip.
- Cut (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7 1/2" strip.
- Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.

From the Words - Green (C), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 1" x 10" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 1" x 7 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (3) 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" strips and (1) 1 1/4" x 8 3/4" strip.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip

From the Character Toss - Teal (D), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 3 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 3 1/4" square, (1) 1" x 3" strip and (2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips. Cut the 3 1/4"

square across both diagonals to make (4) triangles.

- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 1/4" x 11 1/4" strip, (1) 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" strip, (1) 1 1/4" x 9 1/2" strip and (1) 1 1/4" x 8 3/4" strip.

From the Houndstooth - Orange (E), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip, (1) 3 7/8" square, (1) 2 3/8" square and (1) 1" x 4" strip.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7 1/2" strip.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 1/4" x 11 1/4" strip, (1) 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" strip, (1) 1 1/4" x 9 1/2" strip and (1) 1 1/4" x 8 3/4" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Black (F), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1" x 10" and (1) 1" x 7 1/2" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Cream (G), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- See instructions to cut (81) assorted letters from (6) 3" x WOF strips.
- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 2 7/8" squares and (8) 2 3/8" squares. Cut the (2) 2 7/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) large triangles. Cut (6) 2 3/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) small triangles.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 2" squares and (4) 2" x 3 1/2" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (H), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 6 1/2" x 24 1/2" strip and (1) 5" x 16" strip.
- (1) 2 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (3) 2 3/4" squares and (6) 2 3/8" squares. Cut the 2 3/4" squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (33) 1" squares, (1) 1" x 3" strip, (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7 1/2" strip.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (1) 1 1/4" x 11 1/4" strip, (1) 1 1/4" x 9 1/2" strip, (2) 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/4" x 16 1/2" strips.

From the Multi Dot - Red (I), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 5" x 16" strips.
- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 2 7/8" square, (3) 2 3/4" squares and (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip. Cut the 2 3/4" squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles.
- (2) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 1/4" x 11 1/4" strip, (1) 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" strip, (3) 1 1/4" x 9 1/2" strips and (1) 1 1/4" x 8 3/4" strip.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7 1/2" strip.

Quilt Cutting Instructions - Continued

From the Words - Cherry Red (J), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip, (3) 2 ⅜" squares and (2) 1 ¾" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 ½" x 2" strip, (2) 1 ¼" x 9 ½" strips and (1) 1" x 3" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Brown (K), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 14 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 12" x 14 ½" strip, (1) 3 ⅞" square, (1) 2 ⅜" square, (4) 1 ½" x 1 ¾" strips, (1) 1" x 4" strip and (2) 1 ¼" x 9 ½" strips.

From the Words - Tan (L), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 6 ½" x 18" strip.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (66) 1" squares, (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 ¼" x 10 ½" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 11 ¼" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 9 ½" strip and (1) 1 ¼" x 8 ¾" strip.

From the Houndstooth - Green (M), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into 5" x 16" strip.

From the Houndstooth - Teal (N), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip, (1) 2 ⅞" square and (3) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (2) 1 ½" x 26" strips and (2) 1 ½" x 1 ¼" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (33) 1" squares.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 ¼" x 10 ½" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 11 ¼" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 9 ½" strip and (1) 1 ¼" x 8 ¾" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Green (O), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip and (1) 4 ½" x 22" strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips and (2) 1 ¼" x 10 ½" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 1" x 10" strips, (2) 1" x 7 ½" strips and (1) 1" x 3" strip.

From the Houndstooth - Rose (P), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip, (1) 3 ¼" square, (3) 2 ⅜" squares and (1) 2" x 3 ½" strip. Cut the 3 ¼" square across both diagonals to make (4) triangles.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 1 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 ¼" x 11 ¼" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 9 ½" strip, (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7 ½" strip.

- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (66) 1" squares and (1) 1" x 2" strip.

From the Multi Dot - Teal (Q), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip, (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strip, (1) 1" x 2" strip and (2) 1 ¼" x 9 ½" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Red (R), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (2) 2 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 30" WOF strips.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 5" x 16" strip, (2) 1 ¾" x 4 ½" strips, (1) 1 ½" x 2" strip and (1) 1 ½" square.
- (1) 2 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 2 ⅜" squares.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (3) 1 ¼" x 10 ½" strips and (1) 1 ¼" x 8 ¾" strip.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7" strip.

From the Character Toss - Tan (S), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding designated mini-quilts.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 1 ¼" x 11 ¼" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 10 ½" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 9 ½" strip and (1) 1 ¼" x 8 ¾" strip.
- (1) 1" x 4" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Orange (T), cut:

- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (33) 1" squares and (1) 1" x 4" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Blue (U), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 2 ⅞" square and (3) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 1 ¼" x 1 ½" strips, (1) 1" x 2" strip, (1) 1" x 10" strip and (1) 1" x 7 ½" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Tan (V), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3 ⅞" squares, (6) 2 ⅜" squares, (1) 2" x 3 ½" strip and (1) 1" x 2" strip.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (1) 1" x 10" strip, (1) 1" x 7 ½" strip and (33) 1" squares.

From the Starry Basics - Gold (W), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 2 ⅜" squares.

From the Mice Toss - Aqua (Main Quilt Backing), cut:

- (1) 38" x 50" strip.

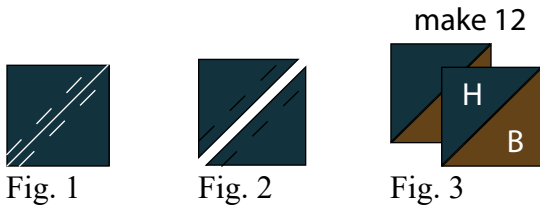
From the Character Toss - Tan (Mini Quilts Backing), cut:

- (1) 8" x 26" strip.
- (4) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 13" x 16" strips.
- (6) 9" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 6" x 20" strips.

Sewing Instructions

Block One

1. Place (1) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric B square on top of (1) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) HB units (Fig. 3). Trim the HB units to measure 2" square. Repeat too make (12) HB units total.



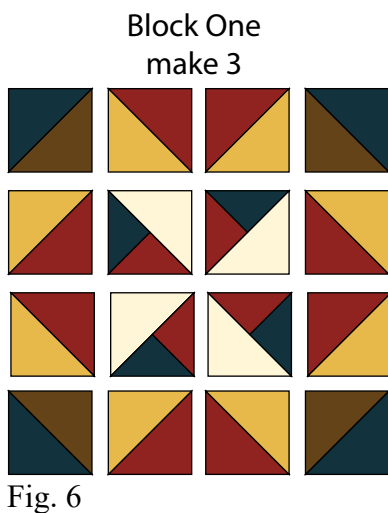
2. Repeat Step 1 using (12) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric W squares and (12) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric R squares to make (24) 2" WR units (Fig. 4).



3. Sew (1) Fabric G small triangle, (1) Fabric I triangle and (1) Fabric H triangle together to make (1) GHI unit (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (12) GHI units total.



4. Sew (4) HB units, (8) WR units and (4) GHI units together to make (1) Block One (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (3) Block Ones total.

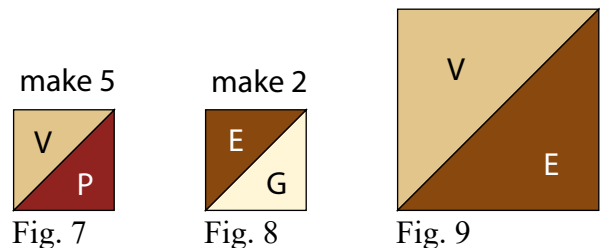


Block Two

5. Repeat Step 1 using (3) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric P squares and (3) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric V squares to make (6) 2" VP units (Fig. 7). *Note: Only (5) VP units will be used.*

6. Repeat Step 1 using $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric E square and (1) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric G square to make (2) 2" EG units (Fig. 8).

7. Repeat Step 1 using (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric V square and (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square to make (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " VE units (Fig. 9). *Note: Only (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " VE unit will be used.*



8. Follow Figure 10 and sew (5) VP units, (1) VE unit, (2) EG units, (1) 2" Fabric G square and (2) 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strips together to make (1) Block Two.

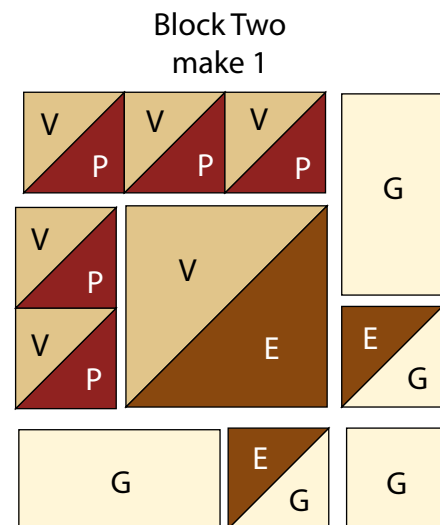
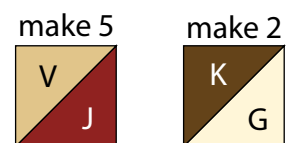

Block Three

9. Repeat Step 1 using (3) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric V squares and (3) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric J squares to make (6) 2" VJ units (Fig. 11). *Note: Only (5) VJ units will be used.*



10. Repeat Step 1 using $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric K square and (1) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric G square to make (2) 2" KG units (Fig. 12).



11. Repeat Step 1 using (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric V square and (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric K square to make (2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " VK units (Fig. 13). *Note: Only (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " VK unit will be used.*

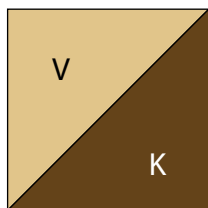

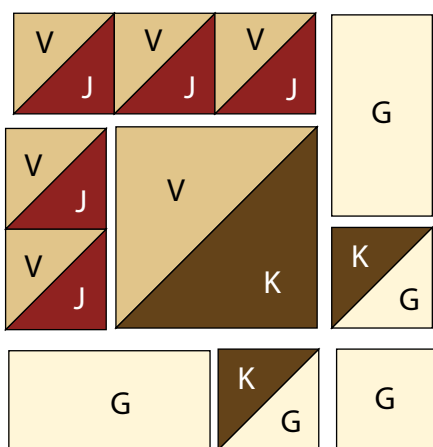

Sew (3) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N squares and (2) NK strips together, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 1 (Fig. 15).

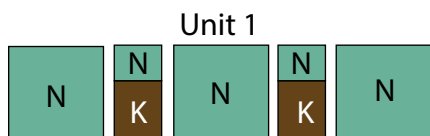

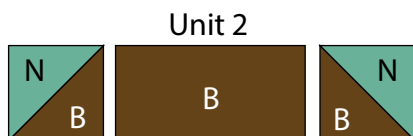

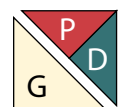

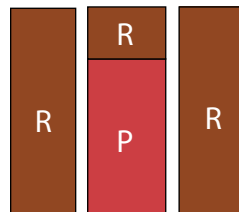

Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P strip and (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip together lengthwise to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip set. Sew (1) strip set to each side of the Block Four/Block Five strip to make (1) Block Six (Fig. 34).

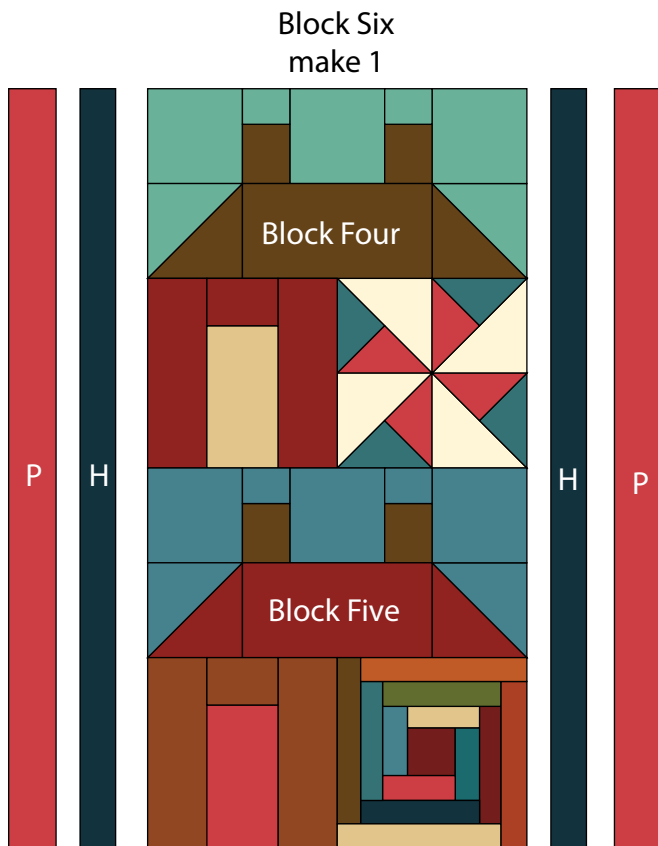

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 35 while assembling the large quilt top.)

33. Sew Block One, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip, (1) Block Two, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, (1) Block Three, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip and (1) Block One together to make (1) Column One.

34. Sew (1) 12 " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top of Block Six. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top of (1) Block One. Sew this strip to the right side of the Block Six/Fabric H strip. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 " Fabric L strip to the top of this strip to make (1) Column Two.

35. Sew the (2) columns together to make the large quilt top.

36. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip to each side of the large quilt top. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 " Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the large quilt top.

37. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric R strip to each side of the large quilt top. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 " Fabric R strip to the top and to the bottom of the large quilt top.

38. Layer and quilt as desired.

39. Sew the (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric Q strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

40. Bind as desired.

41. Add buttons to the Fabric L, Fabric K and Fabric H strips for hanging the month sign, monthly scene and the "Welcome" sign.

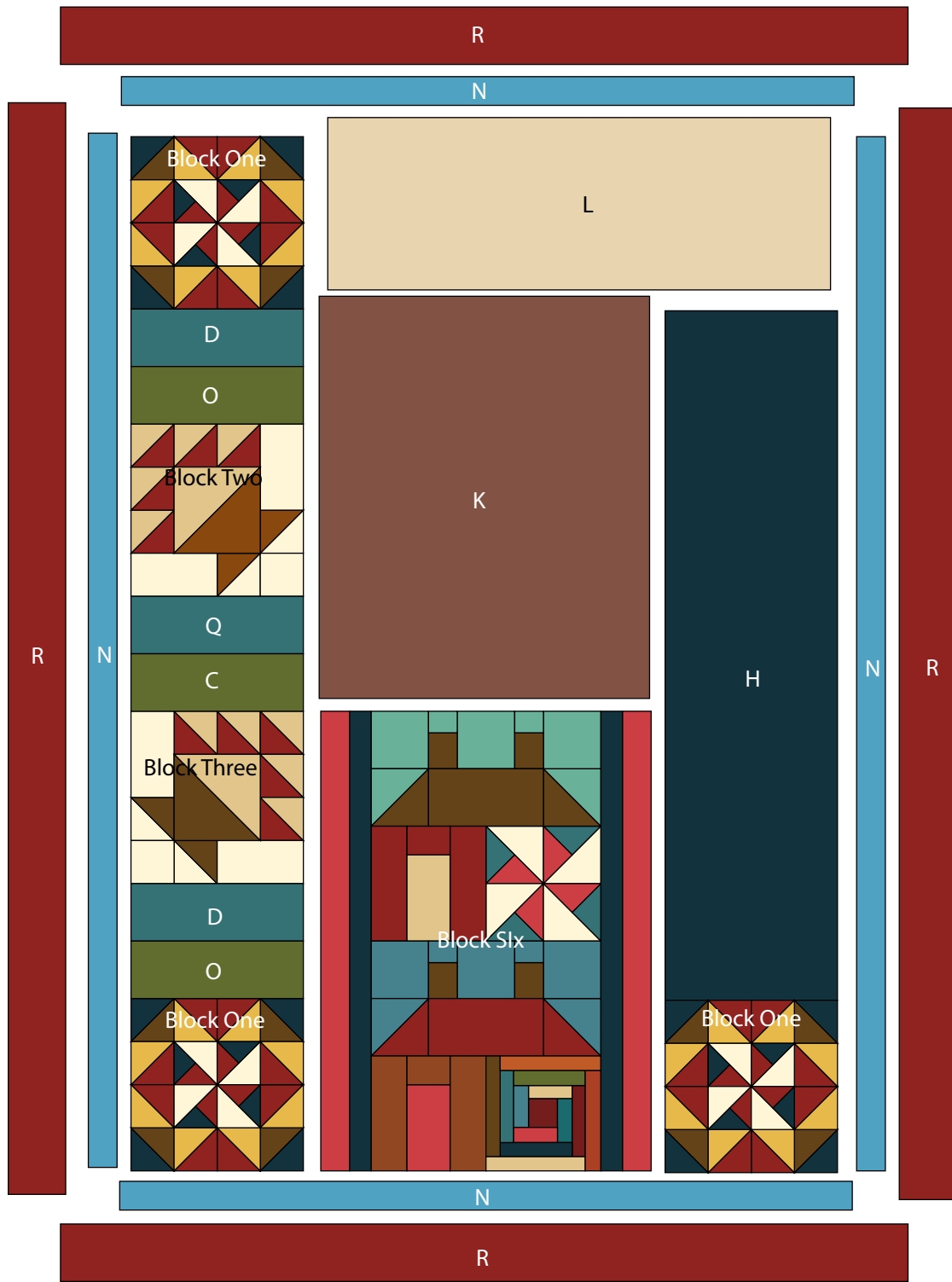

42. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the required number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

43. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

44. Refer to Figure 36 to arrange and press the letters to spell "Welcome" onto the 4 1/2" x 22" Fabric O strip.

45. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

46. Layer and quilt as desired.

47. Sew the (2) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

48. Bind as desired.

49. Use Pearl Cotton or ribbon to make (2) loops that will fit over the buttons on the main quilt. Sew each loop to the top of the Welcome Mini Quilt for hangers.

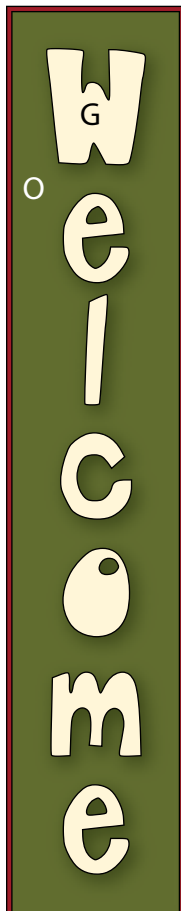

52. Sew the (2) 2 1/2" x WOF assorted fabric strips (as listed in Figure 37) together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

53. Bind as desired.

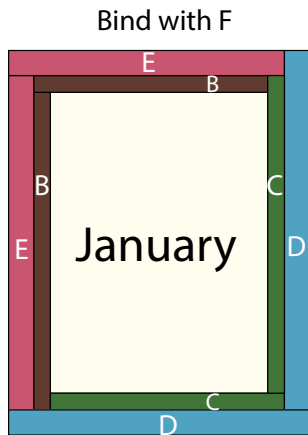

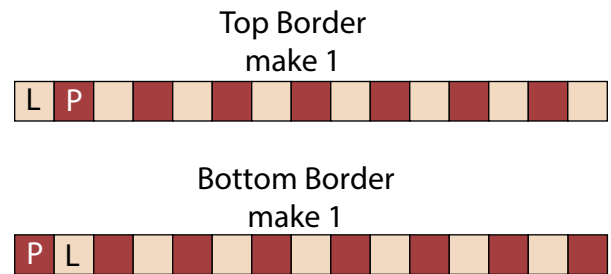

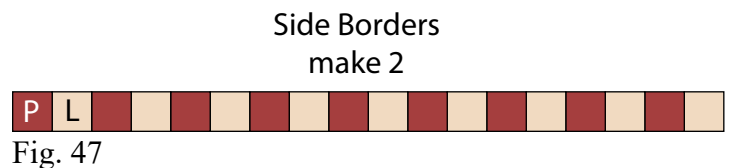
