## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Grandma's Garden Collection)

## DESIGN 1

Fabric 1: $3 / 8 y \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A195.1 (Grandma's garden on light blue)
Fabric 2: $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A196.2 (Blue Buddleia)
Fabric 3: $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A197.2 (Red Poppy on natural)
Fabric 4: $3 / 8 y \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A198.1 (Bird houses on light cream)
Fabric 5: 3/8yd - 40cm - A199.3 (Garden gnomes on natural)
Fabric 6: $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yds $-1 \frac{1}{2}$ mtrs - BB40 (Off white)
Fabric 7: 5/8yd - $60 \mathrm{~cm}-$ BB104 (Bluebell)
Wadding and backing $53^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{\prime \prime}$

## DESIGN 2

Fabric 1: $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A195.2 (Grandma's garden on natural)
Fabric 2: $3 / \mathrm{syd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A196.1 (Pink Buddleia)
Fabric 3: $3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A197.1 (Pink Poppy)
Fabric 4: $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}-$ A198.3 (Bird houses on lilac)
Fabric 5: $3 / 8 y \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A199.1 (Garden gnomes on white)
Fabric 6: $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yds $-1 \frac{1}{2}$ mtrs - BB40 (Off white)
Fabric 7: $5 / 8 y d-60 \mathrm{~cm}-$ BB103 (Lavender)
Wadding and backing 53" x 62"

## DESIGN 3

Fabric 1: $3 / 8 y \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A195.3 (Grandma's garden on dark grey)
Fabric 2: 3/8yd - 40cm - A196.3 (Lilac Buddleia)
Fabric 3: 3/8yd - 40cm - A197.3 (Red Poppy on dark grey)
Fabric 4: 3/8yd - 40cm - A198.2 (Bird houses on pink)
Fabric 5: $3 / 8 y \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$ - A199.2 (Garden gnomes on pale blue)
Fabric 6: $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yds $-1 \frac{1}{2}$ mtrs - BB104 (Bluebell)
Fabric 7: 5/8yd - 60 cm - BB102 (Light coral)
Wadding and backing $53^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{\prime \prime}$

## CUTTING

Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted.

1. From fabric 1 cut:
$19 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
2. From each of the fabrics $2,3,4$ and 5 cut:
$20 \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
3. From fabric 6 cut:
$12 \times 1 \frac{1}{2 "} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (you will need to join to get the length)
$110 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
4. From fabric 7 cut:
$2 \times 2$ " $\times 56 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (you will need to join to get the length)
$2 \times 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ (you will need to join to get the length)

## MAKING UP THE QUILT

Lay out squares as in the main diagram with the sashing in between each of the squares and at the end of each row

You will have 11 in total
Sew in rows and then sew the rows together with the sashing strip in between each of the join squares and a strip at the top and bottom

Next add the border strips, sides and then the top and bottom
Your quilt top is complete

## COMPLETION

1. Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing. Pin or baste layers
2. Quilt as desired
3. Double bind edges with $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " of fabric 7
