Size: $14^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$


FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Grandma's Garden Collection)
Fabric 1: Fat¼-A198.3 (Bird houses on lilac)
Fabric 2: Fat114 - A199.1 (Garden gnomes on white)
Backing $1 / 2 y d-1 / 2 m t r$
Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

## CUTTING

1. From fabric 1 cut:
$2 \times 71_{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice
$2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ " (border)
$2 \times 1 \frac{112 " 1}{} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (border)
2. From fabric 2 cut:
$8 \times 3788^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8$ " cut in half diagonally once

## MAKING UP THE CUSHION

Lay out your fabric pieces for your block


Stitch a small triangle to the large triangle on one side. Then take the other triangle and stitch into place. Make 8 in total

Now sew two of the blocks together to make a square, do this to all the blocks to make four squares

Sew your four squares together for the centre of the cushion
Add the border sides and then top and bottom
If you would like to quilt your cushion now is the time
To complete the cushion, you can make an Envelope back
