Oh Deer!

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 7-1/4" x 38-1/2" deer stripe borders

Fabrics C, E, and H - From each fabric:
Cut (1) 11-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 7" x 11-1/2" pieces

Fabric D - Cut (1) 11-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 7" x 11-1/2" pieces
Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 58" borders
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 41" borders
Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric F - Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 47" borders

Fabric G - Cut (4) 2-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 27" borders

2. Piecing Order:

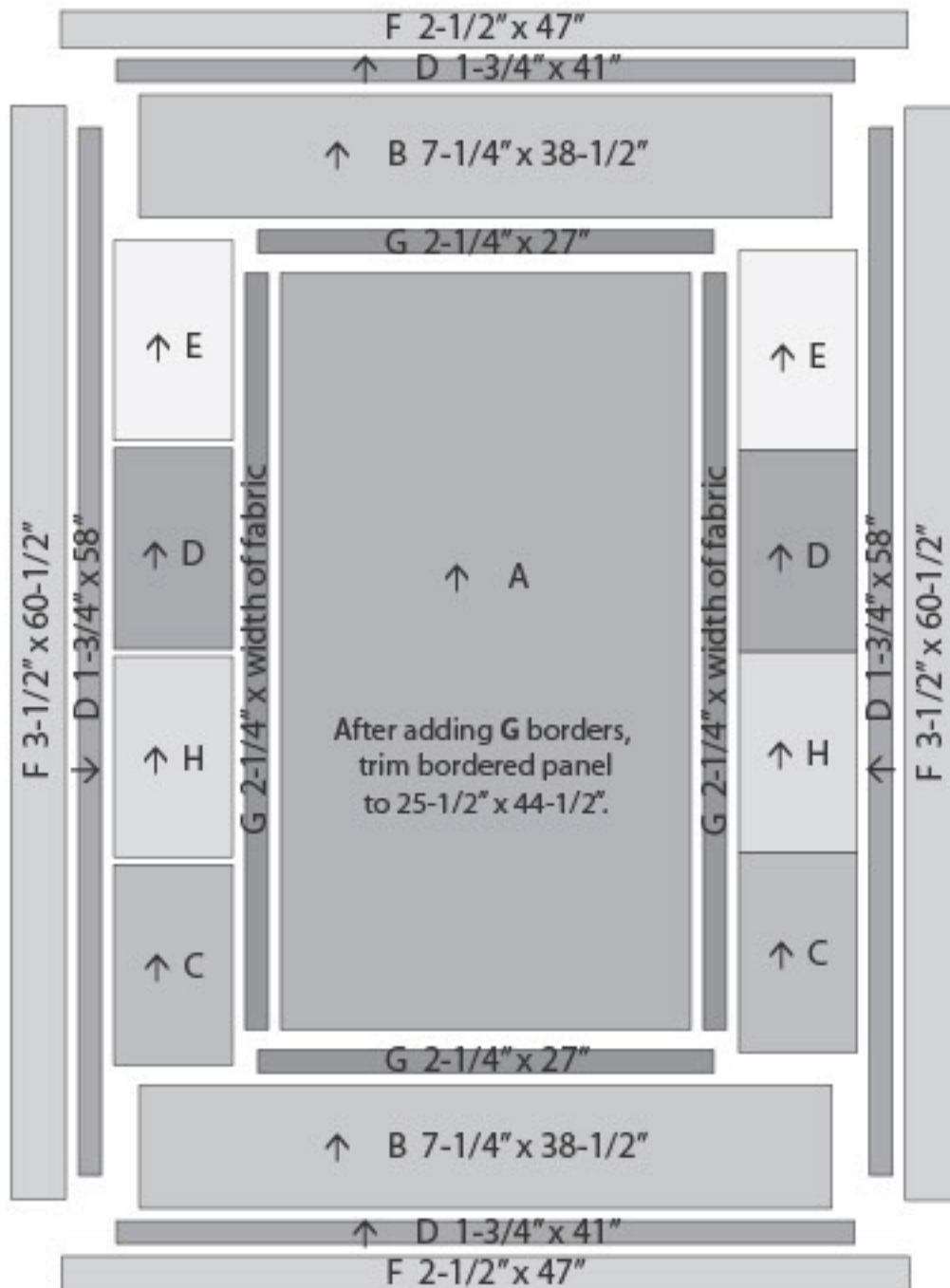
1. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.
2. Stitch **Fabric G** 2-1/4" strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/4" x 27" **Fabric G** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 44-1/2" (unfinished).*
3. Arrange **Fabrics C, D, E,** and **H** 7" x 11-1/2" pieces in vertical rows on both long sides of the bordered panel. Stitch into vertical rows (7" x 44-1/2" unfinished). Sew rows to sides of bordered panel.
4. Sew **Fabric B** 7-1/4" x 38-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel with pieced side borders.
5. Stitch **Fabric D** 1-3/4" x 58" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 1-3/4" x 41" borders to top and bottom.
6. Stitch **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 47" borders to top and bottom.
7. The quilt measures approximately 47" x 64-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
8. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!

Border measurements are the cut size.

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.



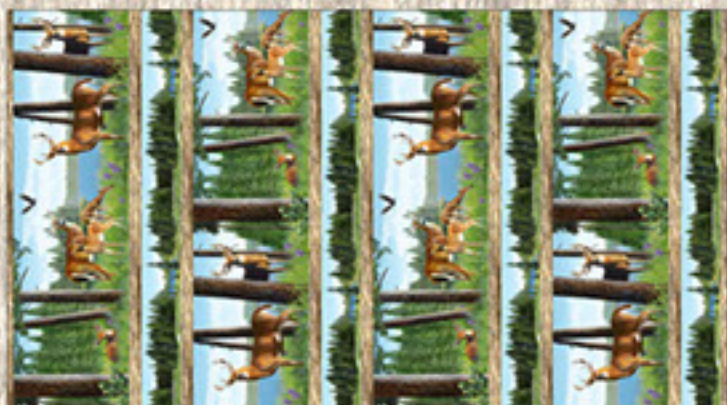
