Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Wall Quilt:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 21-1/4" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-5/8" x 65" multi-stripe borders, (2) 5-5/8" x 44" multi-stripe borders, and (2) 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" word stripe borders [1 with "FALL" centered in border, 1 border with 2 "FALL"s evenly spaced]

Fabric C - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric D - Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 45" and (1) 3-1/2" x 30-1/4" borders
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 3-1/2" x 30-1/4" border

Fabric E - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 27" borders

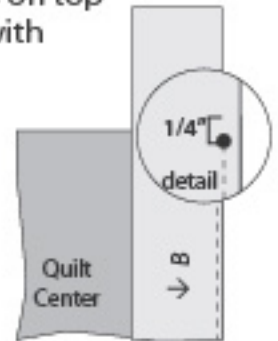
2. Piecing Order for Wall Quilt:

1. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, and borders.

2. Stitch **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/2" x 27" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 24-1/4" x 45" (unfinished).*

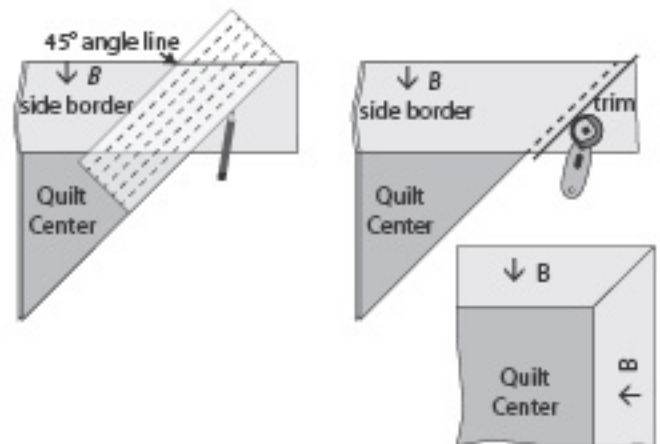
3. Sew **Fabric D** 3-1/2" x 45" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric D** 3-1/2" x 30-1/4" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

4. Center **Fabric B** 5-5/8" x 65" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 5-5/8" x 44" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the dark stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

5. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



6. Sew **Fabric B** 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

7. The wall quilt measures approximately 40-1/2" x 69-1/4" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric O**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

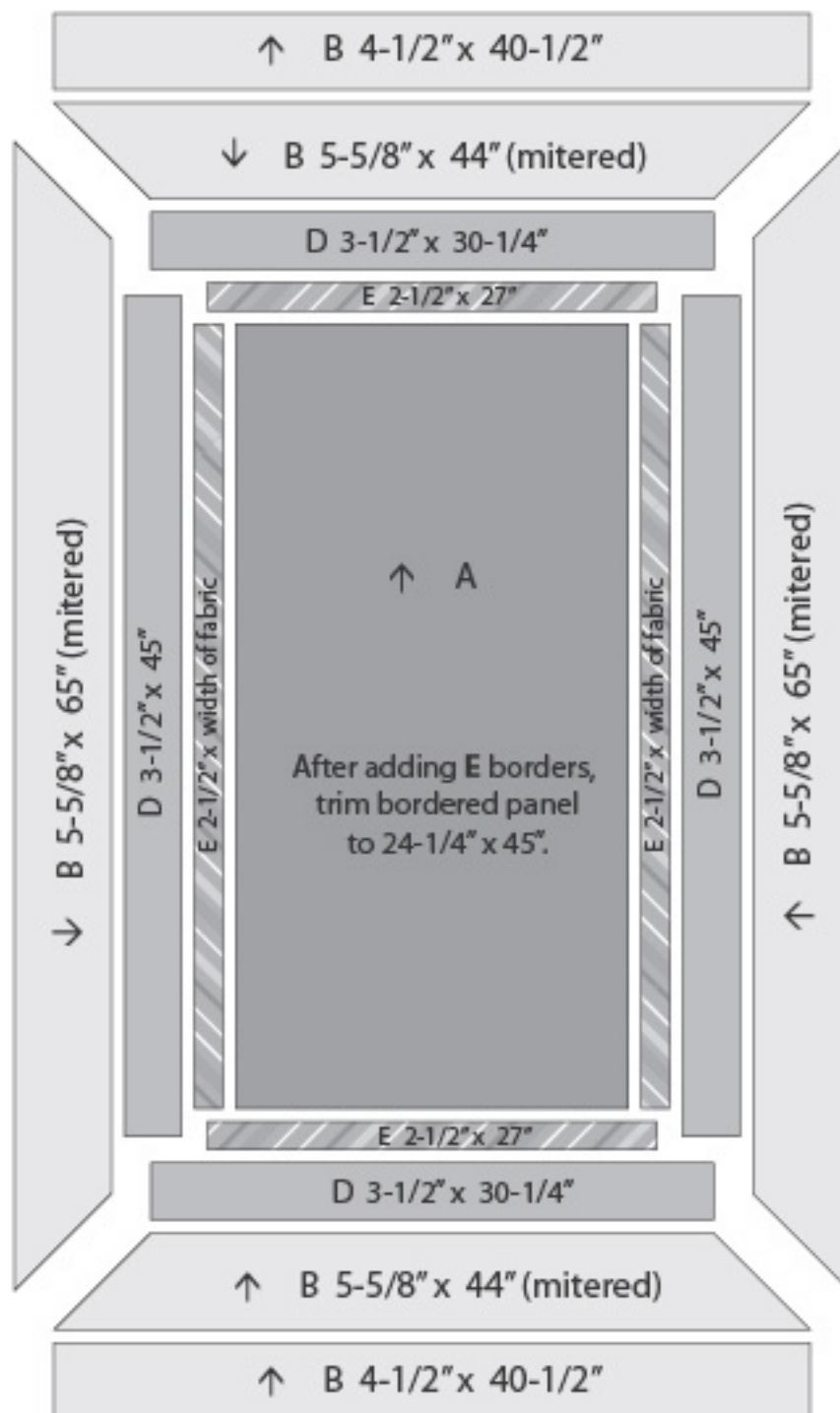
8. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!

Border measurements are the cut size.

Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.




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3. Cut the following for Throw Quilt:


Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 4-1/2" x 58" and (2) 4-1/2" x 46" word borders, each with 2" FALL's evenly spaced in length

Fabric C - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (68) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (4) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (56) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 112 triangles 

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally as shown for 48 triangles 
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric F - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares and (4) 2-7/8" squares
Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (28) 2-7/8" squares then cut all 2-7/8" squares in half diagonally for 64 triangles 
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (36) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (3) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (13) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (22) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric J - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric K - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric L - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (56) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric M - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 58" and (2) 1-1/2" x 46" strips for flat piping

Fabric N - Cut (5) 2-1/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/4" x 54-1/2" and (2) 2-1/4" x 46" borders

4. Piecing Order for Throw Quilt:

1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics D** and **F** 2-7/8" triangles as shown. Make a total of 64 Unit 1a (2-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 48 Unit 1b with **Fabrics D** and **E** 2-7/8" triangles.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 32 **Fabric D** 2", 4 **Fabric E** 2-1/2", and 48 **Fabric K** 2-1/2" squares as shown.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

3. Arrange a marked **Fabric D** 2" square on corner of a **Fabric M** 2-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite corner. Make a total of 16 Unit 2 (2-1/2" square unfinished).

4. Arrange 4 Unit 1a, 1 Unit 2, 1 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" square, and 3 **Fabric F** 2-1/2" squares in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 16 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square unfinished).

5. Arrange 4 Unit 1b, 2 **Fabric E** 2-1/2" squares, and 3 **Fabric G** 2-1/2" squares in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 12 **Block 2** (6-1/2" square unfinished).

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6. Arrange 1 **Fabric I**, 2 **Fabric E**, 2 **Fabric C**, and 4 **Fabric L** 2-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Sew into rows. Sew rows together.

Make a total of 2 **Block 3a** (2-1/2" square unfinished).

7. In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 3b-3d** using 2-1/2" squares indicated.

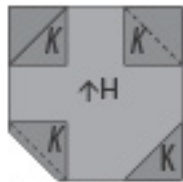

8. Arrange 4 marked **Fabric K** 2-1/2" squares right sides together on a **Fabric H** 6-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 12 **Block 4a** (6-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 **Block 4b** with 4 marked **Fabric E** 2-1/2" squares and 1 **Fabric H** 6-1/2" square.

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

9. Refer to Throw Quilt Layout (Page 5) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, squares, and borders.

10. Arrange blocks in 9 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together into quilt center (42-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished).

11. Stitch **Fabric N** 2-1/4" x 54-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric N** 2-1/4" x 46" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

12. Fold **Fabric M** 1-1/2" x 58" and 1-1/2" x 46" strips in half lengthwise, right side out, forming 3/4" wide flat piping strips.

13. Baste 3/4" x 58" **Fabric M** flat piping strips on top of sides of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of **Fabric N** border. Baste 3/4" x 46" **Fabric M** flat piping on top of top and bottom of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of **Fabric N** border.

14. Stitch **Fabric B** 4-1/2" x 58" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press seams toward **Fabric B** borders so **Fabric M** piping lays on the **Fabric N** borders. Sew **Fabric F** 4-1/2" squares to both ends of each **Fabric B** 4-1/2" x 46" borders then add to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward **Fabric B** borders so **Fabric M** piping lays on the **Fabric N** borders.

15. The quilt measures approximately 54" x 66" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric O**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

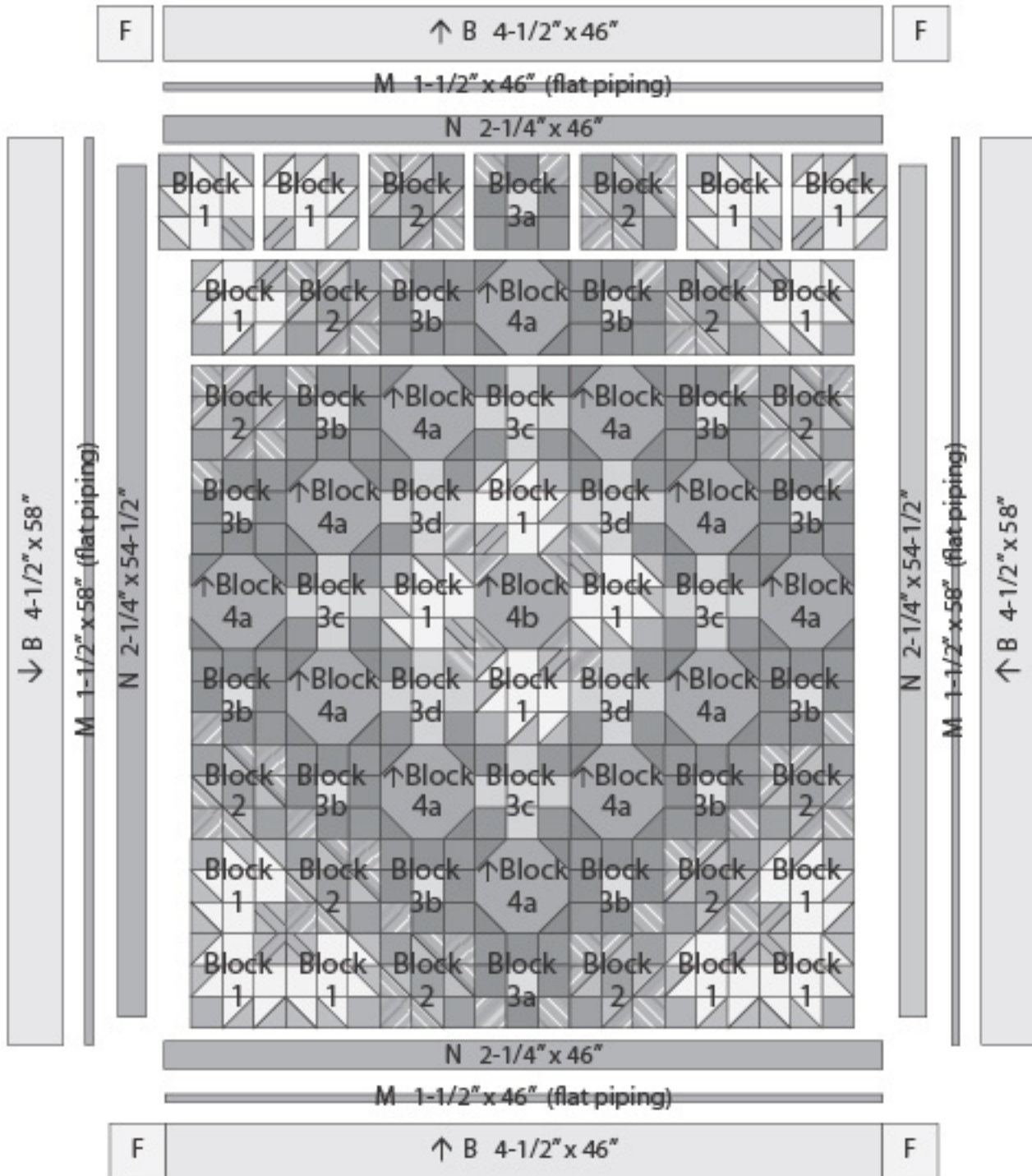
16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!

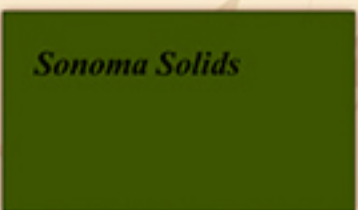
