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# Fabrics in the Collection 



## Materials

1 panel Panel - Multi (A)
$1 / 2$ yard $\quad$ Fluffy Red (B)
$1 / 4$ yard Packed Snowmen - Multi (C)
$3 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Nordic Stripe - Red (D)
$3 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Snowflake - White/Gray (E)
1/4 yard Snowflake - Gray (F)
$1 / 2$ yard Holly - White/Gray (G)
$11 / 8$ yards Mittens - Gray (H)
$31 / 2$ yards Mittens - White/Red (Backing)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Multi (A), fussy cut:
-(6) $101 / 2$ " blocks.
From the Fluffy Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2 "x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 2 " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 2 " x 13 1/2" strips.


## From the Packed Snowmen - Multi (C), cut:

-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (6) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Nordic Stripe - Red (D), cut:
-(4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 2 " x $61 / 2 "$ strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

## From the Snowflake - White/Gray (E), cut:

-(4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 2 " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

## From the Snowflake - Gray (F), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) $31 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Holly - White/Gray (G), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.


## From the Mittens - Gray (H), cut:

-(6) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.

## From the Mittens - White/Red (Backing), cut:

-(2) $60 " x$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60 " x 72 " back.

## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 " x $101 / 2 "$

Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $121 / 2 "$ square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block Ones total.

2. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ " Fabric D strip and (1) $2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 1 (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (24) Unit 1's.

3. Sew (1) Unit 1 to each side of (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric C square. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 1. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Block Twos total.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)
4. Sew (1) Block Two to each side of (1) Block One to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
5. Sew (1) Block One to each side of (1) Block Two to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
6. Sew the (4) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 401 / 2$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 521 / 2$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

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## Quilt 1

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9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
