QUILT 1

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Autumn in Bluebell Wood Collection)

Fabric 1: 3/4yd - 3/4mtr - A246.1 (Autumn in Bluebell Wood: first frost)

Fabric 2: ½yd - ½mtr - A247.2 (Sycamore seeds on green)

Fabric 3: 11/8yd - 1.10m - A248.2 (Woodland mouse on light earth)

Fabric 4: 34yd - 34mtr - A249.2 (Blowing leaves hedgehog on green)

Fabric 5: ³/₄yd - ³/₄mtr - A250.1 (Leaping deer on cream)

Fabric 6: 3/8yd - 40cm - BB113 (Tan)

Fabric 7: %yd - 80cm - BB126 (Red apple)

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

CUTTING

- **1.** From fabric 1 cut: 64 x 31/2" x 31/2"
- 2. From fabric 2 cut: 32 x 2" x 3½" 32 x 2" x 5"
- 3. From fabric 3 cut: 32 x 2" x 31/2" 32 x 2" x 5"
- 2 x 23/4" x 601/2" (join) 2 x 23/4" x 56" (join)
 - 4. From fabric 4 cut: 32 x 2" x 5"
 - 32 x 2" x 6"
 - 5. From fabric 5 cut: 32 x 2" x 5" 32 x 2" x 6"
- **6.** From fabric 6 cut: 6 x 21/2" x 42" for binding 25 x 2" x 2"
 - **7.** From fabric 7 cut: 40 x 2" x 121/2"

MAKING UP THE BLOCK

Lay out your fabric pieces for your block

Sew block 1 together, square and then the strip to the right. Next strip at the bottom of the block Again, to the right side and then the bottom

Sew block 2, square and the strip to the left side next strip to the top, again side and then the top Sew block 3, square and strip to the left side. Now to the bottom of square. Sew the last two strips as before

Sew block 4, square and strip to the left side. Now to the top of square. Stitch the last two strips as before

Join the four squares together to make the block. Make 16 in total

ASSEMBLY

Lay out blocks with sashing in between and on the ends of the blocks on row 2, 4, 6 and 8

On rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 will be sashing and the squares

Stitch in rows and then stitch the rows together

Add the borders sides and then top and bottom the quilt

COMPLETION


Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing. Pin or baste layers $\mbox{Quilt as desired}$ Double bind edges with 2½" fabric 6 strips

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Autumn in Bluebell Wood Collection)

Fabric 1: 3/4yd - 3/4mtr - A246.2 (Autumn in Bluebell Wood: afternoon)

Fabric 2: 1/2 yd - 1/2 mtr - A247.1 (Sycamore seeds on cream)

Fabric 3: 11/8yd - 1.10m - A248.3 (Woodland mouse on dark earth)

Fabric 4: ³/₄yd - ³/₄mtr - A249.1 (Blowing leaves hedgehog on natural)

Fabric 5: 34yd - 34mtr - A250.3 (Leaping deer on sunset)

Fabric 6: 3/8yd - 40cm - BB114 (Milk choc)

Fabric 7: %yd - 80cm - BB115 (Light latte)

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

CUTTING

- **1.** From fabric 1 cut: 64 x 3½" x 3½"
- 2. From fabric 2 cut: 32 x 2" x 3½" 32 x 2" x 5"
- **3.** From fabric 3 cut: 32 x 2" x 3½" 32 x 2" x 5"
- 2 x 2¾" x 60½" (join) 2 x 2¾" x 56" (join)
- **4.** From fabric 4 cut: 32 x 2" x 5"
 - 32 x 2" x 6"
- **5.** From fabric 5 cut: 32 x 2" x 5"
 - 32 x 2" x 6"
- 6. From fabric 6 cut:
- 6 x 2½" x 42" for binding 25 x 2" x 2"
 - **7.** From fabric 7 cut: 40 x 2" x 12½"

MAKING UP THE BLOCK

Lay out your fabric pieces for your block

Sew block 1 together, square and then the strip to the right. Next strip at the bottom of the block Again, to the right side and then the bottom

Sew block 2, square and the strip to the left side next strip to the top, again side and then the top Sew block 3, square and strip to the left side. Now to the bottom of square. Sew the last two strips as before

Sew block 4, square and strip to the left side. Now to the top of square. Stitch the last two strips as before

Join the four squares together to make the block. Make 16 in total

ASSEMBLY

Lay out blocks with sashing in between and on the ends of the blocks on row 2, 4, 6 and 8

On rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 will be sashing and the squares

Stitch in rows and then stitch the rows together

Add the borders sides and then top and bottom the quilt

COMPLETION

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing. Pin or baste layers $\mbox{Quilt as desired}$ Double bind edges with 2½" fabric 6 strips

Fabric 1: ³/₄yd - ³/₄mtr - A246.3 (Autumn in Bluebell Wood: dusk)

Fabric 2: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - A247.3 (Sycamore seeds on light earth)

Fabric 3: 11/8 yd - 1.10m - A248.1 (Woodland mouse on cream)

Fabric 4: 3/4yd - 3/4mtr - A249.3 (Blowing leaves hedgehog on warm grey)

Fabric 5: ³/₄yd - ³/₄mtr - A250.1 (Leaping deer on cream)

Fabric 6: 3/8yd - 40cm - BB126 (Red apple)

Fabric 7: 7/8 yd - 80cm - BB113 (Tan)

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

CUTTING

- **1.** From fabric 1 cut: 64 x 31/2" x 31/2"
- 2. From fabric 2 cut: 32 x 2" x 3½" 32 x 2" x 5"
- 3. From fabric 3 cut: 32 x 2" x 31/2" 32 x 2" x 5"
- 2 x 23/4" x 601/2" (join) 2 x 23/4" x 56" (join)
 - 4. From fabric 4 cut: 32 x 2" x 5"
 - 32 x 2" x 6"
 - 5. From fabric 5 cut: 32 x 2" x 5"
 - 32 x 2" x 6"
- **6.** From fabric 6 cut: 6 x 21/2" x 42" for binding
 - 25 x 2" x 2"
 - **7.** From fabric 7 cut: 40 x 2" x 121/2"

MAKING UP THE BLOCK

Lay out your fabric pieces for your block

Sew block 1 together, square and then the strip to the right. Next strip at the bottom of the block Again, to the right side and then the bottom

Sew block 2, square and the strip to the left side next strip to the top, again side and then the top Sew block 3, square and strip to the left side. Now to the bottom of square. Sew the last two strips as before

Sew block 4, square and strip to the left side. Now to the top of square. Stitch the last two strips as before

Join the four squares together to make the block. Make 16 in total
