$5 / 8$ yard Stripe - Black/White (B)
$5 / 8$ yard Small Patch of Scenes - Multi (C) 6846-9*
$3 / 4$ yard Bicycles - Blue (D)

$3 / 8$ yard
$1 / 8$ yard
2/3 yard Modern Melody Basics - Turquoise (G) 1063-17
$1 / 4$ yard Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (H)

3 yards Flower Baskets - Blue (Backing) 6848-11

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Words - White (A), cut:

- (1) $221 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ rectangle.

From the Stripe - Black/White (B), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2$ "X $341 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(5) $21 / 2 \prime \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Small Patch of Scenes - Multi (C), cut:
- (2) $81 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Bicycles - Blue (D), fussy cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips, each centered on a row bikes. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 52 "$ strips.
- (3) $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 46$ " WOF strips, each centered on a row of bikes. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 46 "$ strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (E), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (1) bicycle seat, (1) bicycle basket and (2) bicycle pedals.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) bicycle handle grips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Turquoise (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (1) bicycle handlebar, (1) bicycle frame and (2) bicycle fenders.


## From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (H),

 cut:- See instructions to cut (3) daisies.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Lemon (I), cut:

- See instructions to cut (3) daisy centers, (2) inner wheels and (1) pedal center.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (J), cut:

- See instructions to cut (2) bicycle tires, (2) bicycle pedal bars and (1) bicycle pedal ring.

From the Flower Baskets - Blue (Backing), cut:
-(2) 50 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $50 " \times 56 "$ back.

## Sewing Instructions

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to Figure 1 on Page 2 to arrange and press the bicycle components, basket and flowers onto the $221 / 2 "$ x $341 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the Center Block.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)
5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 341 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) $81 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 36 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Center $31 / 2 " \times 52 "$ Fabric D strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4 "$ from the bottom edge.
DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.

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## Center Block

9. Repeat Step 8 to sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 46 "$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 2).
10. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 2), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
