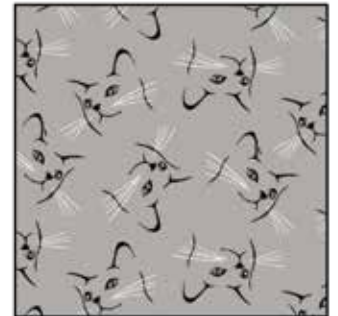

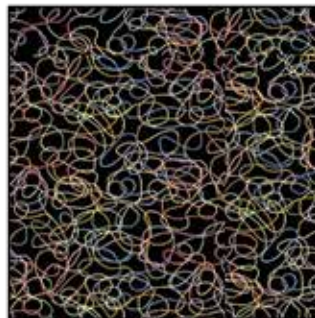

1 panel	36" Cat Panel - Gray (A)	9075P-90
1 1/8 yards	Splash - Violet (B)	3504-Violet
2 yards	Cat Stripe - Brown (C)	9076-30
1/3 yard	Balls of Yarn - Yellow (D)	9082-44
1/3 yard	Cat Face Outlines - Gray (E)	9079-90
1/3 yard	Kittens with Yarn - Gray (F)	9080-90
1/3 yard	Cat Paw Prints - Gray (G)	9083-90
7/8 yard	Yarn Allover - Black (H)	9081-99*
4 yards	Cat Collage - Gray (Backing)	9078-90

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 36" Cat Panel - Gray (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 34 1/2" x 42 1/2" panel.

From the Splash - Violet (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 49 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.

From the Cat Stripe - Brown (C), fussy cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 53" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on the yellow flowers strip.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 45" LOF strips, each centered on the yellow flowers strip.
- (2) 4" x 62 1/2" LOF strips, each centered on the cats with the wood background strip.
- (2) 4" x 54 1/2" LOF strips, each centered on the cats with the wood background strip.

From the Balls of Yarn - Yellow (D), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Cat Face Outlines - Gray (E), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Kittens with Yarn - Gray (F), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Cat Paw Prints - Gray (G), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (13) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Yarn Allover - Black (H), cut:

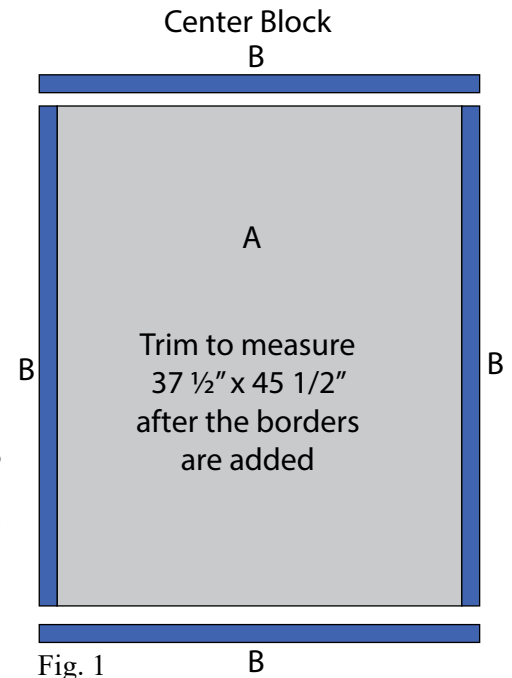
- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4" squares.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Cat Collage - Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 69" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69" x 77" back.

Sewing Instructions

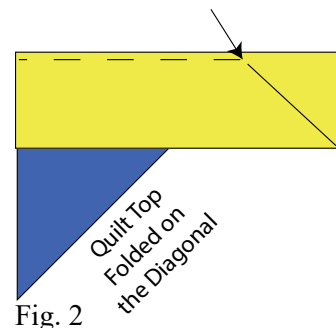
1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 34 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 37 1/2" x 45 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

2. Center (1) 2 1/2" x 53" Fabric C strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
3. Repeat Step 2 to sew (1) 2 1/2" x 45" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 2).



4. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 2), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

5. Sew (1) 2" x 49 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 44 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

6. Sew (13) assorted 4 ½" squares together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

7. Sew (13) assorted 4 ½" squares together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

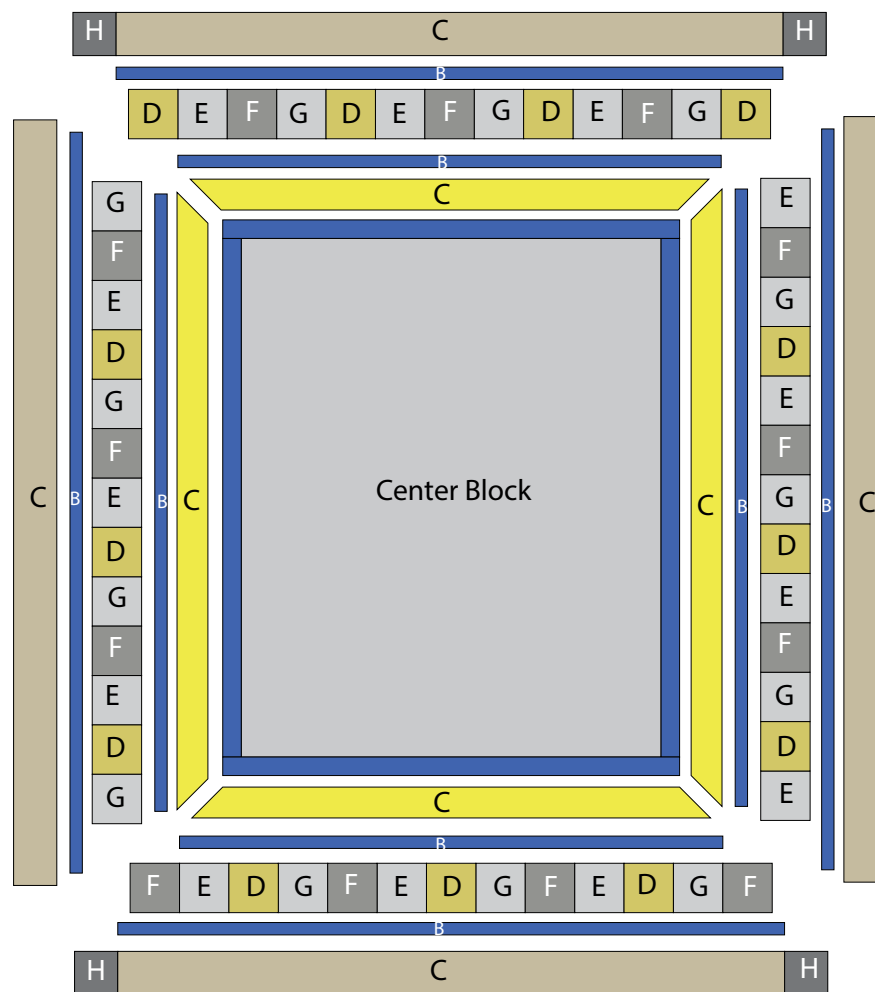
8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 4" x 62 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4" Fabric H square to each end of (1) 4" x 54 ½" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
