

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Pumpkin Farm Panel - Cream (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 34 ½" x 40 ½" panel.

From the Cotton Yarn Dyes - Charcoal (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 34 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Checkerboard Foulards - Pumpkin (C), cut:

• (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4" squares and (4) 3 ½" squares.

From the Cotton Yarn Dyes - Pumpkin/Brown (D), cut:

• (2) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/4" squares.

From the Oak Leaf Stripe - Teal (E), cut:

• (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4" squares.

From the Whirlygigs - Purple (F), cut:

• (2) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/4" squares.

From the Oak Leaf Toss - Forest (G), cut:

• (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4" squares.

From the Cotton Yarn Dyes - Olive (H), cut:

• (2) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/4" squares.

From the Whirlygigs - Squash (I), cut:

• (3) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/4" x 4" strips.

From the Mini Check - Green (J), cut:

- (3) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/4" x 4" strips.
- (3) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 1/4" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Oak Leaf Stripe - Red (K), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (L), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 52 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips each centered on fences/pumpkins.
- (2) 6 ½" x 44 ½" LOF strips each centered on banners/barns.

From the Calico Flowers - Red (M), cut:

• (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Tossed Characters - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 64" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 72" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 34 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 40 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 43 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 42 ½" x 36 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

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2. Place (1) 2 ¼" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 ¼" x 4" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.


- 3. Place another 2 ½" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ½" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (8) Unit 1 strips total.
- 5. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (8) 2 1/4" x 4" Fabric I strips and (16) 2 1/4" Fabric D squares to make (8) Unit 2 strips (Fig. 6).









6. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 4" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 2 1/4" Fabric J square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C strip to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



7. Repeat Steps 2-6 and use Figures 8-13 for fabric identification, location, seam direction and orientation to make (4) Block Two squares and (4) Block Three squares.



- 8. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (16) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric J strips and (32) 2" Fabric M squares to make (16) Unit 7 strips (Fig. 14).
- 9. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 2" Fabric J square to each end of (1) Unit 7 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C strip to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Block Four squares total.



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
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Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 10. Sew (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block One square together in that order. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block.

- 13. Sew (1) Block Four square to each end of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 ½" Fabric L strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 15. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.



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
