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

Runner: 12 1/2" x 41"





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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Throw:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-G used in this design.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the auilt correctly. Fussy cut 1/4" beyond center of panel to approximately 23" x 35"

- Fabric B Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 7-1/4"x 60" and (2) 7-1/4"x 48" multi-stripe borders
- Fabric C Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips. From each strip subcut (2) 4-1/2" squares. Trim each remaining strip to 2-3/4" then subcut a total of (2) 2-3/4" x 28" strips. Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips
- Fabric D Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" borders
- Fabric E Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" and (1) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" flat piping strips Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" flat piping strips

Fabric F - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order for the Throw:

 Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the (4) 4-1/2" Fabric C squares.



Arrange marked Fabric C 4-1/2" squares on corners of the Fabric A panel as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles open.



- Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, flat piping strips, and borders.
- Stitch Fabric C 2-3/4"x width of fabric strips to sides of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-3/4" x 28" Fabric C strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 26-1/2" x 38-1/2" (unfinished).
- Stitch Fabric D 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add Fabric D 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.
- Fold Fabric E 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips in half lengthwise, right side out, forming 3/4" wide flat piping strips.
- 7. Baste 3/4" x 42-1/2" Fabric E flat piping strips on top of sides of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of Fabric D border. Baste 3/4" x 30-1/2" Fabric E flat piping on top of top and bottom of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of Fabric D border.

8. Center Fabric B 7-1/4"x 60" borders on right

and left sides of guilt center and Fabric B 7-1/4"x 48" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with holly stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press Quilt Center borders out , leaving folded



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9. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- The quilt measures approximately 44"x 56" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric G) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for Runner:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-D used in this design.

- Fabric A Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 7"x 35-1/2" floral border Cut (2) 18-1/2" x remaining width of fabric strips. Stitch together along short ends and trim to 18-1/2"x 47" for backing
- Fabric B Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 35-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 9" borders
- Fabric C Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 37-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 13" borders

Fabric D - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips (binding)


4. Piecing Order for the Runner:

- Refer to Runner Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of border strip and borders.
- Sew Fabric B 1-1/2"x 35-1/2" borders to long sides of Fabric A 7"x 35-1/2" floral border strip. Add Fabric B 1-1/2"x 9" borders to short ends.
- Sew Fabric C 2-1/2" x 37-1/2" borders to long sides of runner. Add Fabric C 2-1/2" x 13" borders to short ends of runner.
- The runner measures approximately 13" x 41-1/2" (unfinished).
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing (Fabric A) together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric D) and enjoy!!

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Border measurements are the cut size. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.
