

WELCOME WINTER!

Throw Quilt 48" x 65 1/2"



Welcome Winter!

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/2" x 45-1/2" multi-stripe borders (1 with snowflake stripe on top and 1 with snowflake stripe on bottom)

Fabric C - Fussy cut (4) 5-1/2" wide x 7-1/2" tall, (2) 4-1/2" tall x 5-1/2" wide, and (4) 3-1/2" tall x 5-1/2" wide pieces with snowmen centered

Fabric D - Cut (3) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (8) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (80) 2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric G - Cut (2) 2-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 28" borders
Cut (2) 2" strips
Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 63" and (2) 2" x 48-1/2" borders
Cut (1) 1-3/4" strip, subcut (4) 1-3/4" x 10-1/2" strips

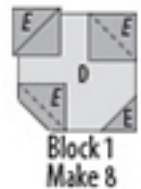
Fabric H - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (2) 5-1/2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the 2" **Fabric E** squares. 

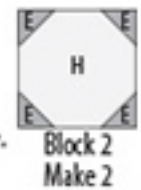
Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange 4 marked 2" **Fabric E** squares on corners of a **Fabric D** 5-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 8 **Block 1** (5-1/2" square unfinished).



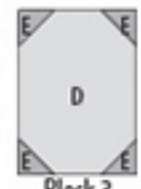
Block 1

3. In the same manner, make 2 **Block 2** with marked 2" **Fabric E** squares and a **Fabric H** 5-1/2" square.



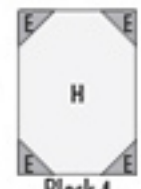
Block 2

4. Using the same sew and flip technique used in Step 2, arrange 4 marked 2" **Fabric E** squares on corners of a **Fabric D** 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 8 **Block 3** (5-1/2" x 7-1/2" unfinished).

5. In the same manner, make 2 **Block 4** with marked 2" **Fabric E** squares and **Fabric H** 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces.

6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, pieces, and borders.

7. Stitch **Fabric G** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/4" x 28" **Fabric G** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 45" (unfinished).*

8. Arrange 2 rows of blocks and **Fabric C** pieces on each side of bordered panel. Sew into vertical rows (5-1/2" x 42-1/2" unfinished).

9. Stitch 2 vertical rows together on each side and sew **Fabric G** 1-3/4" x 10-1/2" strips to top and bottom to complete each side border (10-1/2" x 45" unfinished). Stitch to right and left sides of bordered panel.

10. Sew **Fabric B** borders to top and bottom of quilt.

Welcome Winter!

11. Sew **Fabric G** 2" x 63" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. The quilt measures approximately 48-1/2" x 66" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

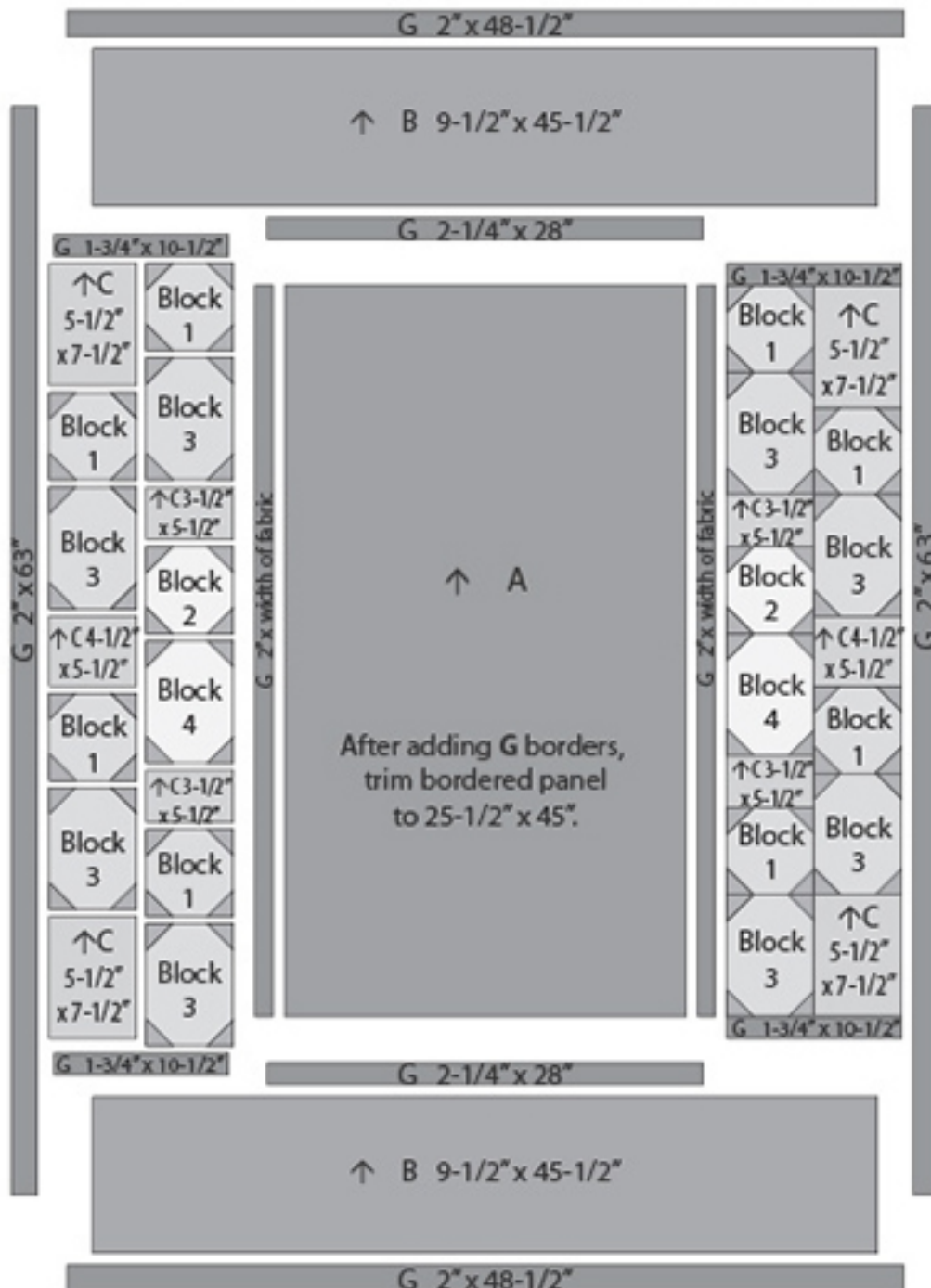
13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**).

14. Embellish **Fabric H** snowmen with ribbon, embroidery, and buttons as desired. Enjoy!!

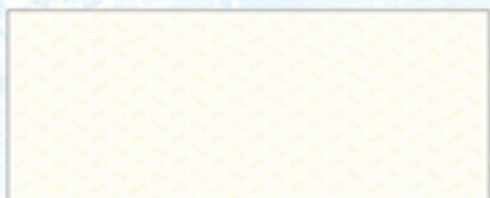
