# BLOCK HEADS



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

For fabric choices refer to the block diagram


A: 28 squares 2 %" x 2 %"

**B:** 4 squares 5 %" x 5 %", split diagonally in halves

3. Attach a triangle B on both sides of each strip unit to get a 6 1/2" square. Make four units.




Arrange units from step 3 in a 4-patch as shown. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press to complete the block. Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".



### ASSEMBLY

 ${\it 1.}$  Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS half-squaretriangles layer a light and a dark A square. Make a total of 16 half-square-triangle-units. Trim the units to 2" square. Split the remaining 12 A squares diagonally in half to yield in 24 triangles.



4. Arrange half-square-triangles and A triangles as shown. Sew patches together in rows; join rows to build a strip unit. Make four units.
