Also needed:
4" of 1/2" wide Hook & Loop Tape
Fusible Fleece - see directions

Basic Tablet Cover

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 9" x 21" strip

Fabric B - Cut (1) 9" x 21" strip and
(1) 9" x 10-1/2" piece

Misc. Supplies - Cut (1) 9" x 20-1/2" fusible fleece. Cut (1) 4" strip of 1/2" hook and loop tape.

2. Piecing Order:

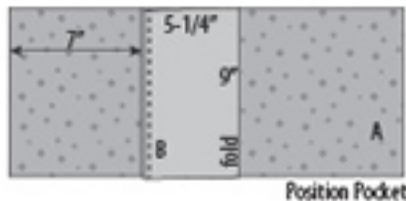
1. Fold Fabric B

9" x 10-1/2" piece in half right side out so it measures 5-1/4" x 9" for the pocket.



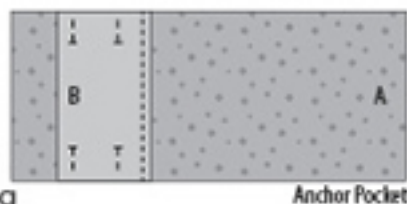
2. Arrange the

Fabric B pocket on the 9" x 21" **Fabric A** strip, right sides together, with the open edge of pocket 7" from a short edge of **Fabric A** strip. Stitch the raw edge of pocket to **Fabric A** strip with 1/4" seam.

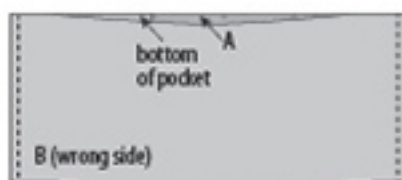


3. Press pocket

over the seam. Pin pocket in place. Stitch 3/8" from bottom of pocket encasing the seam allowance.



4. Arrange **Fabric B** 9" x 21" strip, right sides together, on the **Fabric A** strip with pocket. Align all raw edges. Stitch short ends together with 1/4" seam creating a fabric tube. Press seams open.

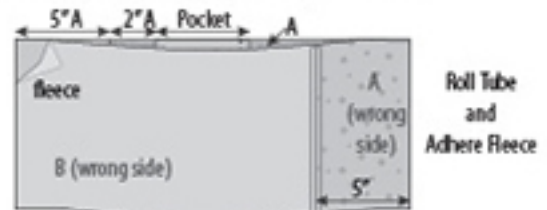


Shading of diagrams

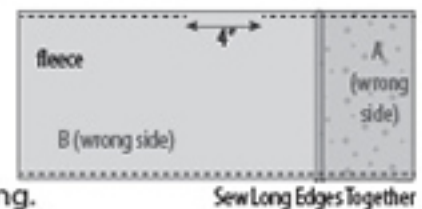

Stitch Halves Together

5. Roll the fabric tube so the seams are offset by 5" as shown. Peek between the layers, there will be 2" of **Fabric A** and 5" of **Fabric B** above the top of pocket. Press flat. Adhere the fusible fleece to the side without the pocket.



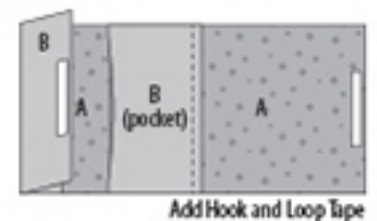
6. Stitch long edges through all layers with 1/4" seam, leaving a 4" opening for turning.



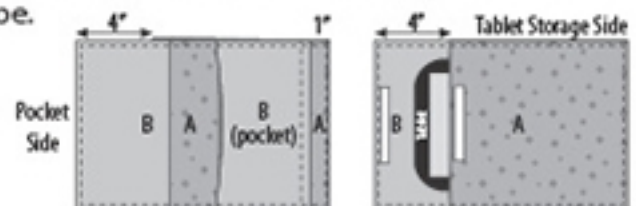
Trim corners to reduce bulk.

7. Turn cover right side out. Remove pins. Poke corners out. Press flat. Stitch opening closed.

8. Separate the 2 strips of hook and loop tape. Pin tape strips, right sides up, to opposite ends of cover as shown, centered 1/4" from ends. Stitch in place.



9. Fold cover, pocket side out, so there is only 1" of **Fabric A** showing under pocket. On the other side, there will be a 4" **Fabric B** flap. Topstitch around cover through all layers. Fold flap over tablet and secure with hook and loop tape.



10. Tablet cover (8-1/2" x 10-1/2" when closed) fits most small to mid-sized tablets (up to 7" x 9" x 1/2"). Adjust measurements if a smaller tablet cover is desired.
