### Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Book Panel - Navy (A):

- Fussy cut (12) 7 1/2" blocks.

#### From the Swirl Print - Teal (B), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 3/4" x 3" strips.
- (16) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips.
- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 3/4" squares.

#### From the Starry Basics - Indigo (C), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Word Print - Cream (D), cut:

- (6) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 4 1/2" squares.
- (12) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### From the Swirl Print - Red (E), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Swirl Print - Eggplant (F), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 1/2" squares.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (G), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Gold (H), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Orange (I), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Starry Basics - Gold (J), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 3/4" squares.

#### From the Rocket Allover - Cream (K), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares.

#### From the Characters Allover - Cream (L), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.

#### From the Rocket Allover - Orange (M), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.

#### From the Word Print - Red (N), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Rocket Allover - Blue (O), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Starry Basics - Green (P), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Characters Allover - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 92" back.

### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 1/2" Fabric A block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure 8 1/2" square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 blocks total.

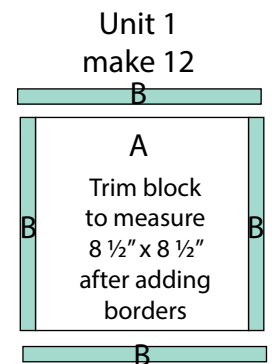

2. Place (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

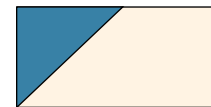

## Quilt 2

3. Place another 4 1/2" Fabric C square on the right side of the 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (12) Unit 2 strips total.

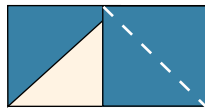

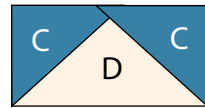

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and use Figures 6-10 for fabric identification, location and seam direction to make (8) Unit 3 strips, (8) Unit 4 strips, (8) Unit 5 strips and (4) Unit 7 strips.

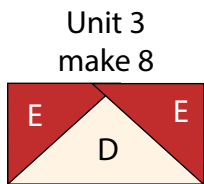

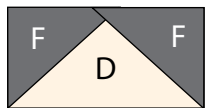

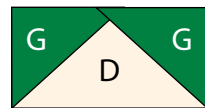

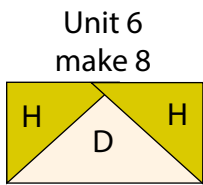

6. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (16) 1 3/4" x 3" Fabric B strips and (32) 1 3/4" Fabric J squares to make (16) Unit 8 strips (Fig. 11).

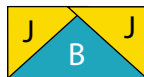

7. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the Top Row. Repeat to make the Bottom Row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block lengthwise to make the Middle Row. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block One square. Repeat to make (3) Block One squares total.

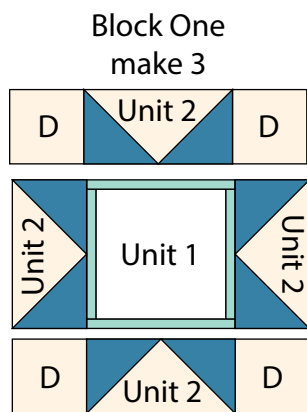

8. Repeat Step 7 and use Figures 13-18 for component identification, location and orientation to make (2) Block Two squares, (2) Block Three squares, (2) Block Four squares, (2) Block Five squares, (1) Block Six square and (4) Block Seven squares.

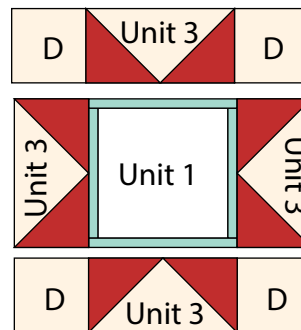

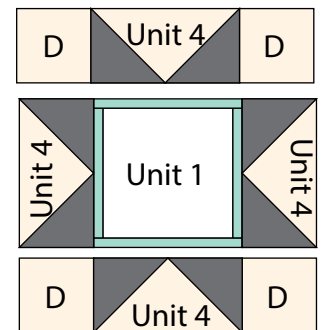

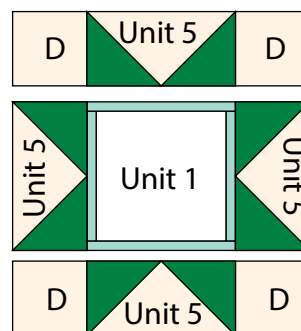

make 2

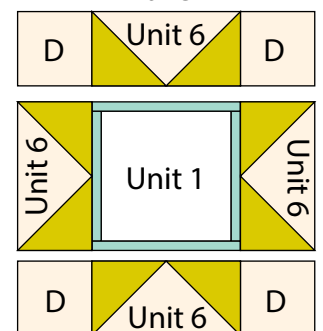

make 1

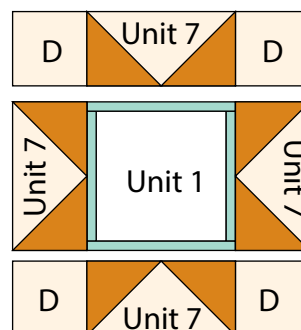

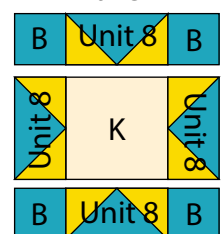

9. Sew (4) 2 1/2" Fabric J squares and (3) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Strip (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (5) Sashing Strips total.

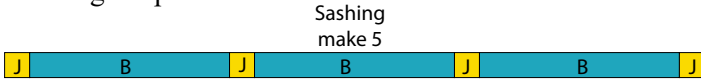

10. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric L strip, (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip, (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric M strip, (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric N strip and (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric O strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) LO strip set (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (4) LO strip sets total.

11. Cut the LO strip sets into (24) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 9 strips (Fig. 21).

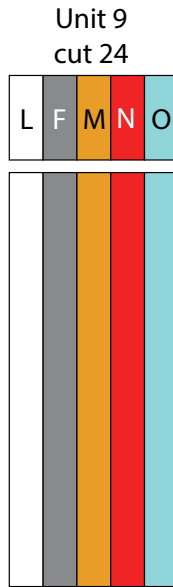

12. Sew (7) Unit 9 strips together end to end. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric L strip to the right end of the sewn strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric F strip to the right end of the new strip to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 22). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

13. Sew (5) Unit 9 strips together end to end. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric L strip to the right end of the sewn strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric F strip to the right end of the new strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric M strip to the right end of the sewn strip. Sew (1) Block Seven square to each end of the new strip to make (1) Top Border (Fig. 23). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

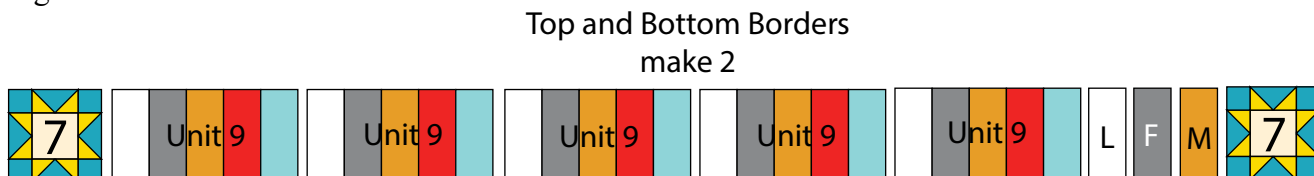

### Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

14. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Three square and (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row One.

15. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Four square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Five square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block One square and (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row Two.

16. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Six square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Two square and (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row Three.

17. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Four square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Five square and (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip together lengthwise and in that order to make Row Four.

18. Sew the (5) Sashing Strips and (4) Block Rows together, alternating them, to make the Center Block.

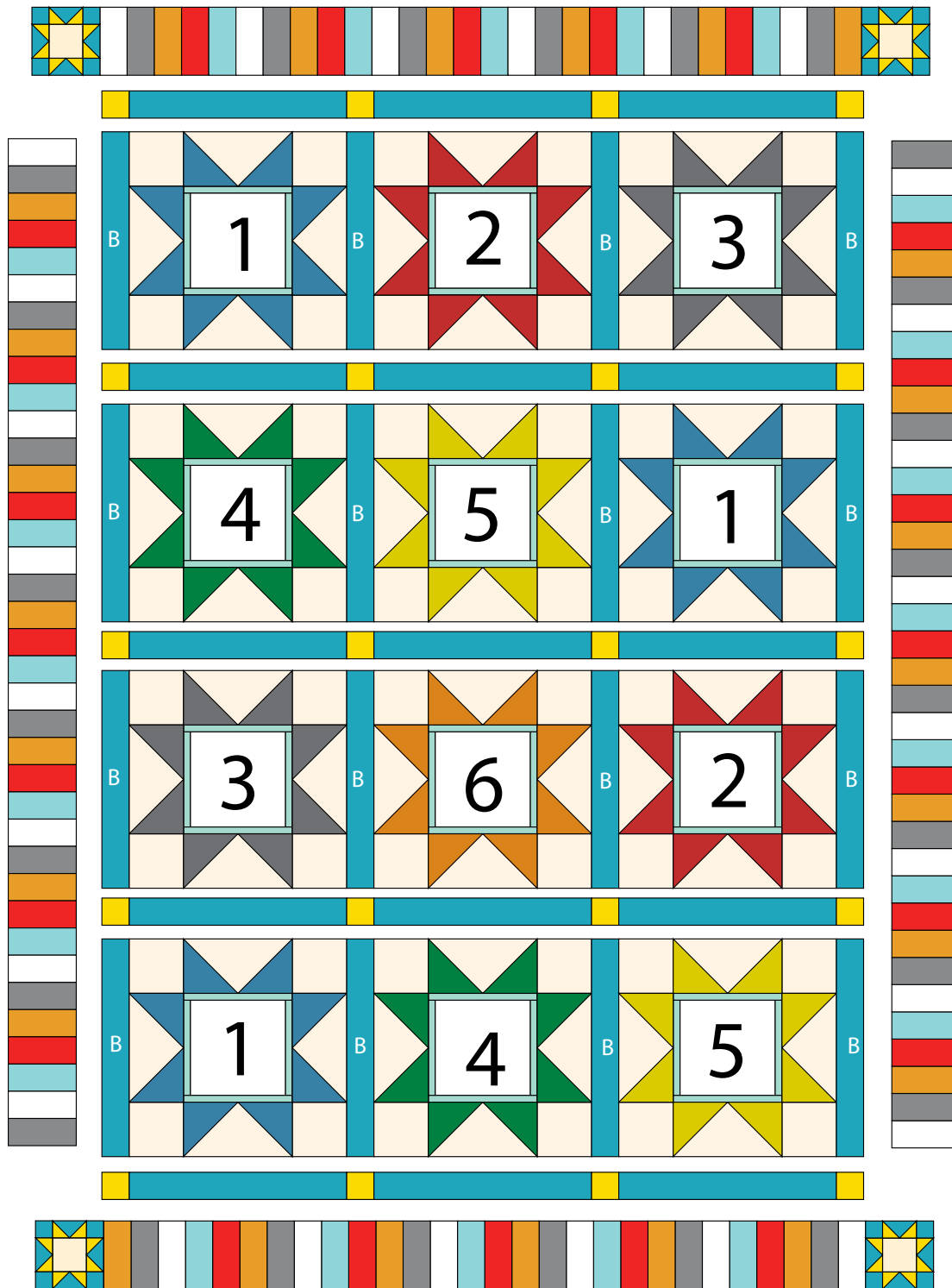
19. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block to make the quilt top.

20. Layer and quilt as desired.

21. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric P strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

22. Bind as desired.
