Twin Quilt: 62 3/4" x 67 3/4"

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Bricolage

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.


Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 8 (4 floral and 4 nine-patch) panels to approximately 8" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/2" x 72" and (2) 9-1/2" x 67" multi-stripe borders


Fabric C - Cut (1) 10-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 10-1/4" square, (1) 4 1/2" x 10" strip, and (1) 2-1/2" x 10" strip
Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 4-1/2" x 10" strip and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 45-1/4" borders
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 2-1/2" x 10" strip and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 42-1/4" borders

Fabric D - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/2" x 10" strips, and (8) 1-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips, and (40) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (8) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/2" x 10" strips, and (8) 1-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips, and (100) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (10) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 20 triangles

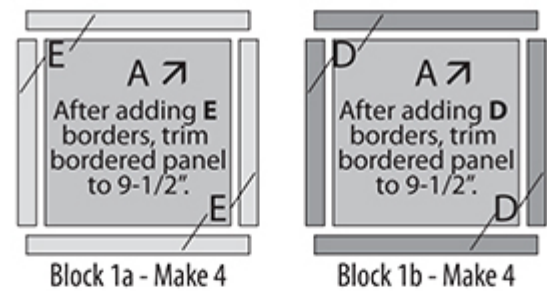
Cut (2) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 3-7/8" squares and (8) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-7/8" squares
Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (5) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 20 triangles] and (12) 1-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (28) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (5) 4-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 20 triangles] and (17) 1-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 2-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 41-1/4" borders
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 38-3/4" borders
Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (28) 1-1/2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips to sides of a nine-patch **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 10" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 9-1/2" square (unfinished)**. Make a total of 4 **Block 1a**. In the same manner, make 4 **Block 1b** with floral **Fabric A** panels and **Fabric D** strips.

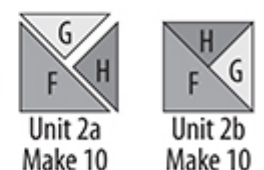


Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Arrange **Fabrics D, E, G,** and **H** 1-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 20 Unit 1a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 5 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.



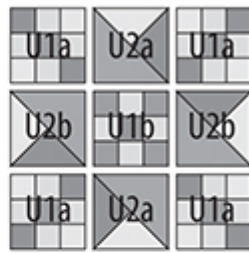
3. Sew 1 each **Fabrics G** and **H** 4-1/4" triangles as shown. Add a **Fabric F** 3-7/8" triangle. Make a total of 10 Unit 2a (3-1/2" square unfinished).



In the same manner, make 10 Unit 2b with placement of **G** and **H** triangles reversed.

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4. Arrange 4 Unit 1a (U1a), 1 Unit 1b (U1b), 2 Unit 2a (U2a), and 2 Unit 2b (U2b) in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 **Block 2** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



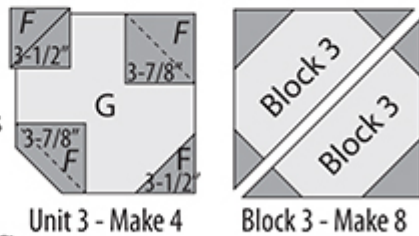
Block 2 - Make 5

5. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each **Fabric F** 3-7/8" and 3-1/2" square.

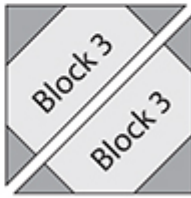


Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

6. Arrange 2 each marked **Fabric F** 3-1/2" and 3-7/8" squares on corners of a **Fabric G** 9-7/8" square as shown. Stitch along



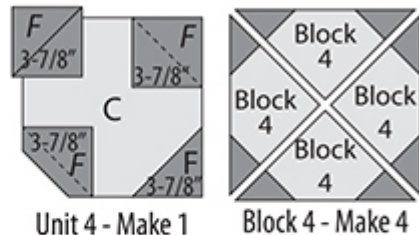
Unit 3 - Make 4



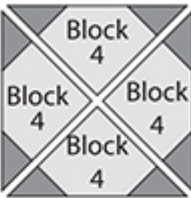
Block 3 - Make 8

marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (9-7/8" square unfinished). Cut each Unit 3 diagonally through the 3-7/8" **Fabric F** corners to make a total of 8 **Block 3** (9-7/8" x 9-7/8" x 14" unfinished). Baste 1/8" from long bias edge of each **Block 3**.

7. Arrange 4 marked **Fabric F** 3-7/8" squares on corners of a **Fabric C** 10-1/4" square as

shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out to complete Unit 4 (10-1/4" square unfinished). Cut Unit 4 diagonally twice to make a total of 4 **Block 4** (7-1/4" x 7-1/4" x 10-1/4" unfinished). Baste 1/8" from bias cut edges of each **Block 4**.

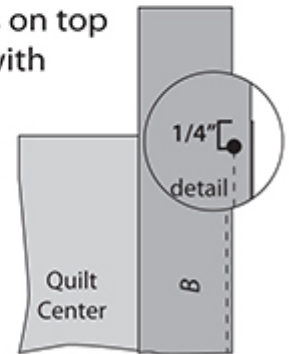
8. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks.

9. Arrange blocks in 7 diagonal rows. Stitch into diagonal rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (38-3/4" square unfinished).

10. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 38-3/4" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 2-1/4" x 41-1/4" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

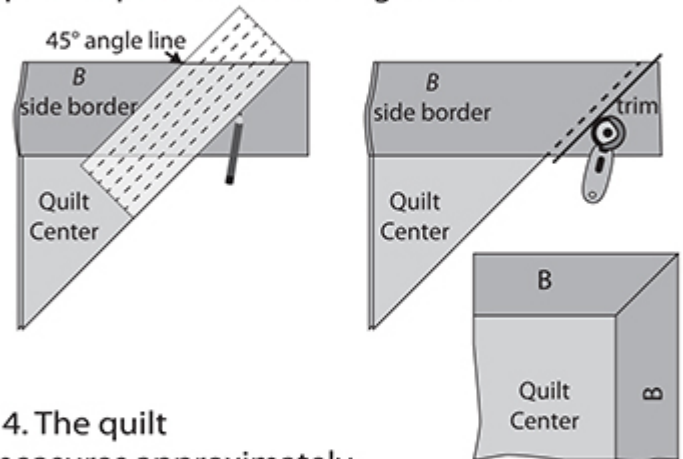
11. Sew **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x 42-1/4" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric C** 4-1/2" x 45-1/4" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Center **Fabric B** 9-1/2" x 72" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 9-1/2" x 67" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the light stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

13. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



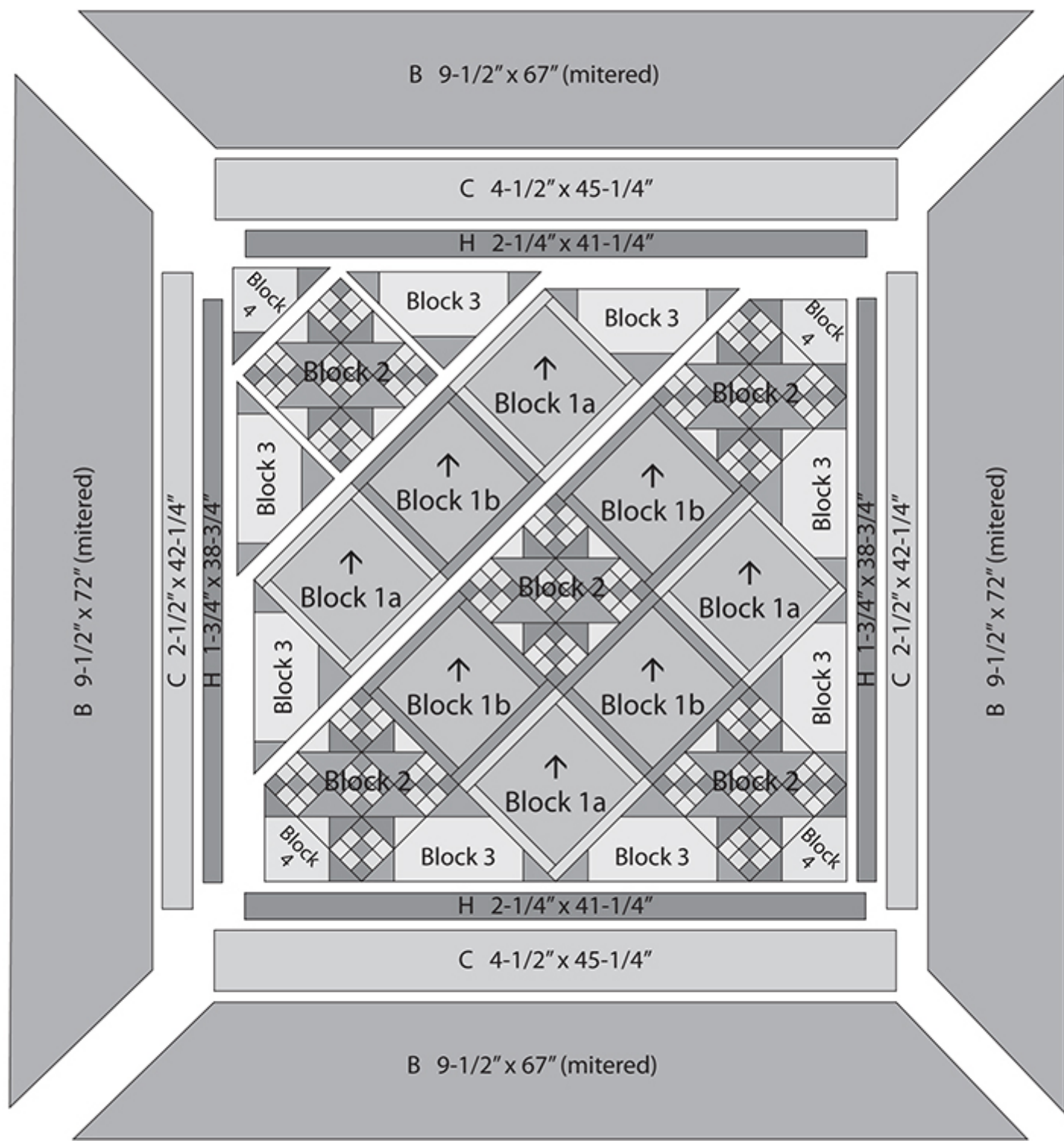
14. The quilt measures approximately 63-1/4" x 68-1/4" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!

Arrows indicate orientation of directional print.

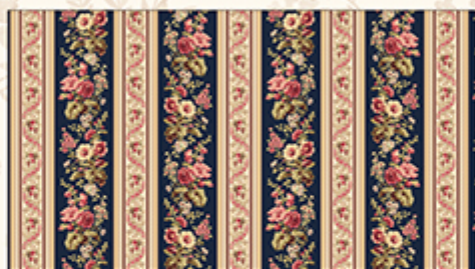


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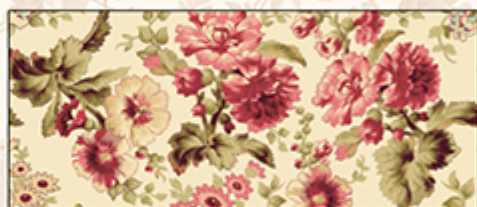

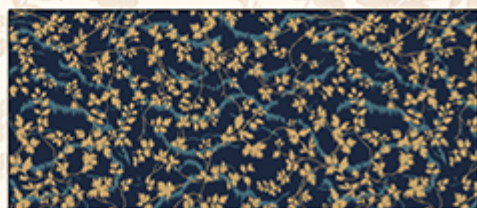

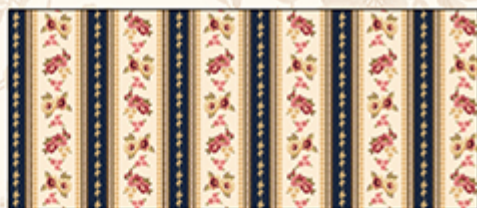
