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# Sing Your Song

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.


## 1. Cut the following:


*If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.*



**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 3 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square and 4 panels to approximately 8-1/2" square


**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 87-1/2" multi-stripe borders

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 7-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally  twice for 8 triangles] and (4) 6-1/2" squares  
Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 6-1/2" squares  
Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (64) 3-1/2" squares

**Fabric D** - Cut (10) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (94) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 188 triangles  
Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)



**Fabric E** - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 7-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 16 triangles  
Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (16) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half *only as shown*  diagonally for 32 triangles  
Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 84-1/2" and (2) 2" x 63-1/2" borders

**Fabric F** - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 6-1/2" squares

**Fabric G** - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 7-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 16 triangles  
Cut (9) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 87-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 86" borders  
Cut (8) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (6) 1-1/4" x 13", (6) 1-1/4" x 11-3/4", (8) 1-1/4" x 10", and (8) 1-1/4" x 8-3/4" strips

**Fabric H** - Fussy cut (4) 6-1/2" squares with flowers centered

**Fabric I** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares

**Fabric J** - Cut (4) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (20) 7-1/4" squares then cut in half  diagonally twice for 80 triangles  
Cut (7) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (70) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 140 triangles

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric G** 1-1/4" x 11-3/4" strips to sides of an 11-1/2" square

**Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13"

**Fabric G** strips to top and

bottom of panel.

*Trim bordered panel*

*to 12-1/2" square (unfinished).*

Make a total of 3 **Block 1**.

2. Stitch **Fabric G** 1-1/4" x 8-3/4" strips to sides of an

8-1/2" square **Fabric A**

panel. Trim strip ends even.

Add 1-1/4" x 10" **Fabric G**

strips to top and bottom of

panel. *Trim bordered panel*

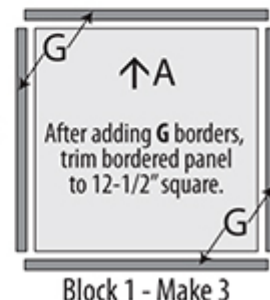
*to 9-1/2" square (unfinished).*

Make a total of 4 **Unit 1**.

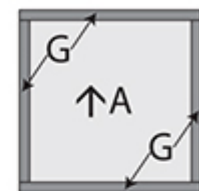
3. Sew 2 **Fabric D** 3-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric J** 7-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 64 **Unit 2** (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

*Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

*Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.*

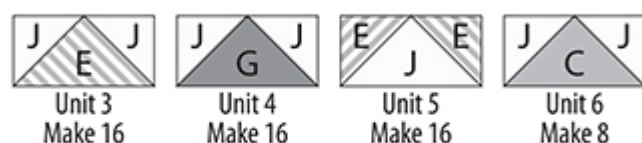

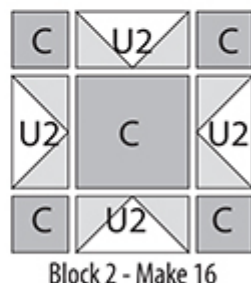
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4. In the same manner, make the number of units listed with the fabrics indicated.



Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.

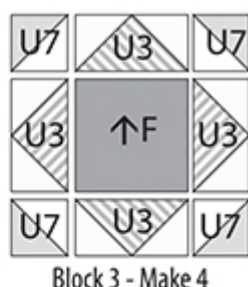
5. Arrange 1 **Fabric C** 6-1/2" square, 4 **Fabric C** 3-1/2" squares, and 4 Unit 2 (U2) in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 16 **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



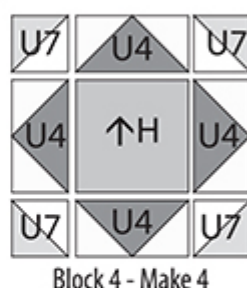
6. Sew 1 each **Fabrics D** and **Fabric J** 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 60 Unit 7 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Arrange 1 **Fabric F** 6-1/2" square, 4 Unit 3 (U3), and 4 Unit 7 (U7) in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 3** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



8. Arrange 1 **Fabric H** 6-1/2" square, 4 Unit 4 (U4), and 4 Unit 7 (U7) in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 4** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

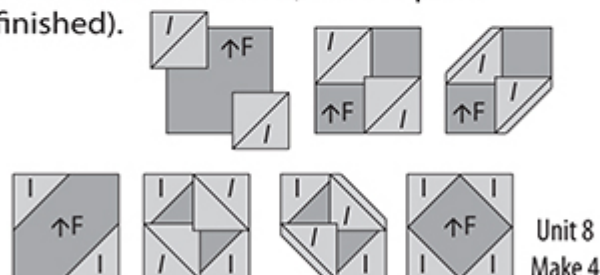


9. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each **Fabric I** 3-1/2" square.

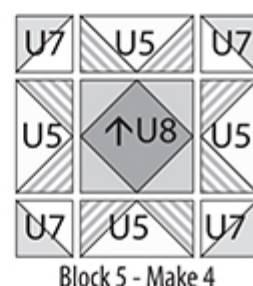


Letters in *italics> indicate wrong side of fabric.*

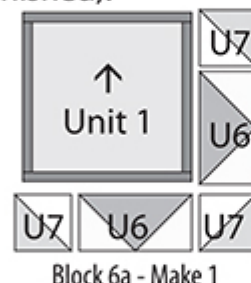
10. Place 2 marked **Fabric I** 3-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric F** 6-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Repeat on remaining corners of the **Fabric F** square. Make a total of 4 Unit 8 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



11. Arrange 1 Unit 8 (U8), 4 Unit 5 (U5), and 4 Unit 7 (U7) in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 5** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



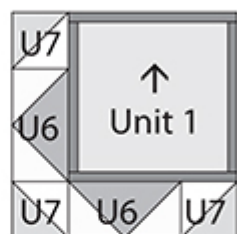
12. Arrange 1 Unit 1 (U1), 2 Unit 6 (U6), and 3 Unit 7 (U7) as shown. Sew Units 6 and 7 on side of block together. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 6a** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



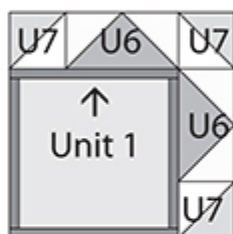

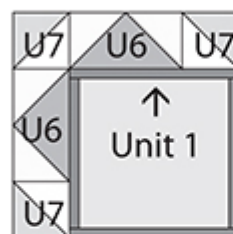
13. In the same manner, make 1 each **Blocks 6b-6d**.

14. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

15. Arrange blocks in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (60-1/2" x 84-1/2" unfinished).

16. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 84-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric E** 2" x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

17. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 87-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt.

18. Sew **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 87-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 86" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

19. The quilt measures approximately 86" x 93-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!



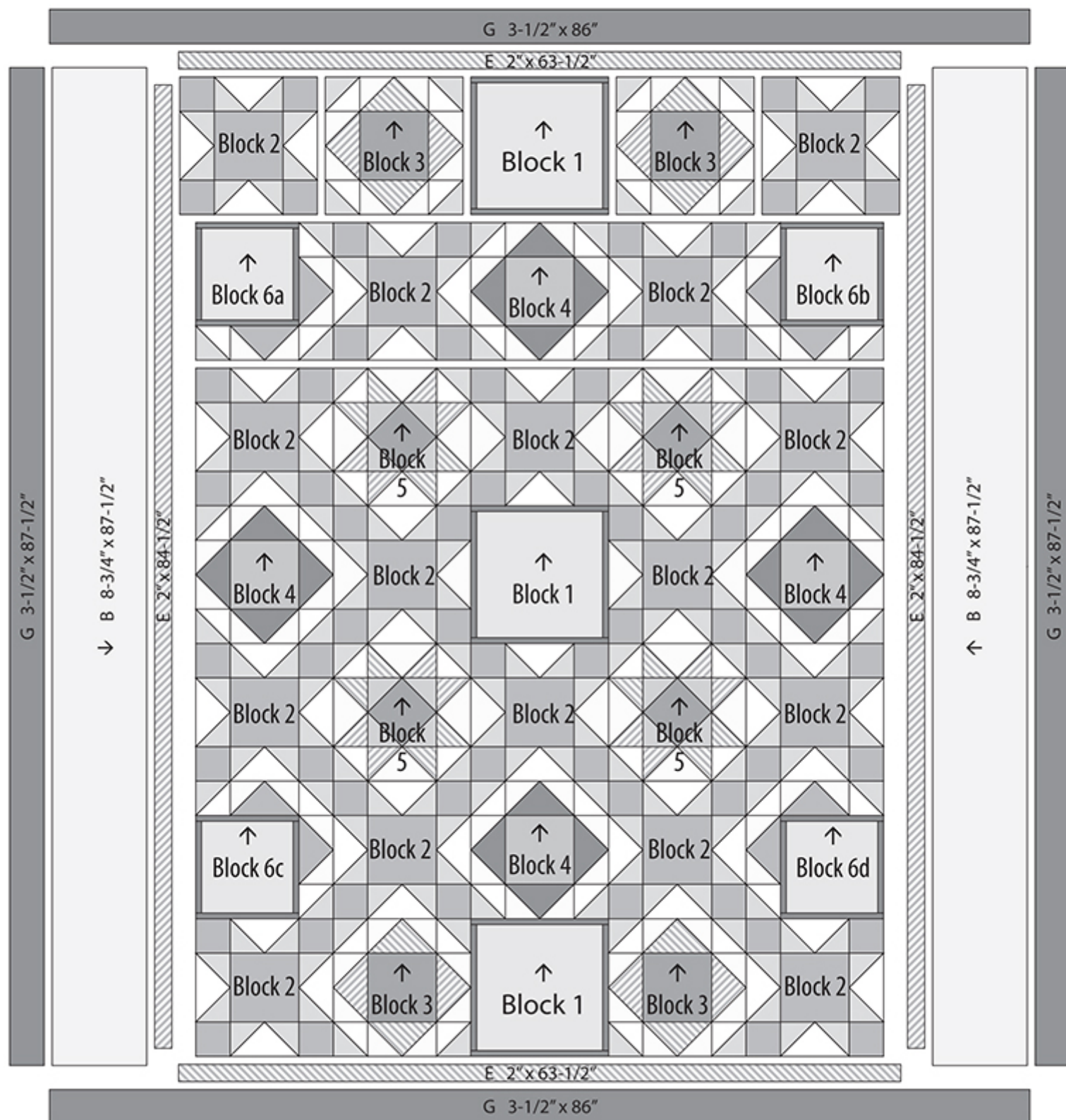
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## QUILT LAYOUT
