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## Constructing Pieced Block A

1. Corner Unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " white tonal square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} "$ fabric 1 square. Sew on drawn line. Trim $1 / 4$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal white tonal corner triangle. Repeat with another $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ white tonal square on at the opposite diagonal corner of the same $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ fabric 1 square.


Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " white tonal rectangle to the left of previously sewn unit.


Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " fabric 1 square to the left of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " white tonal rectangle and add to the top of previously sewn unit.


Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white tonal rectangle to the left of previously sewn unit.


Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " fabric 1 square to the left of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white tonal rectangle and add to the top of previously sewn unit.


Make a total of (4) corner units.
2. Middle units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ white tonal square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric 2 rectangles. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal white tonal corner triangle. Repeat with another $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " white tonal square at the adjacent corner, along the short side, of the same $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric 2 rectangle.


Make a total of (4) middle units.
3. Sew (2) middle units to the opposite sides of (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " 31813 col i square to make a row unit.


Sew (2) corner units to the opposite long sides of (1) middle unit to make a row units. Make a total of (2) row units.

4. Sew together row units to complete (1) block.

5. Make a total number of blocks in the following fabric $\mathbf{1}$ /fabric $\mathbf{2}$ combinations.

5 blocks: 31814 20/31813 111, 31810 20/31814 90, 31814 11/31812 70
4 blocks: $3181291 / 31813$ 20, 31814 91/31813 10
NOTE: for $3181491 / 3181310$ combination, the 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" centre square used is 3181310 instead of 31813110
2 blocks: 31812 90/31812 110

## Constructing Pieced Block B

1. Corner units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 3 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white tonal square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degrees on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " raw edge to raw edge.


Make a total of (4) HST units.
2. Middle units. Sew together (1) $13 / 4 " \times 3$ " print rectangle and (1) $13 / 4 " \times 3$ " white tonal rectangle.


Make a total of (4) middle units.
3. Sew (2) HST units to the opposite sides of (1) middle unit to make a row unit, as shown. Make a total of (2) row units.


Sew (2) middle units to the opposite sides of (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime} 31813110$ square to make a row unit.

4. Sew row units together.


Sew (2) $13 / 4$ " x 8 " white tonal rectangles to the left and right sides of block centre, followed by (2) 1 $3 / 4$ " x $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white tonal rectangles to the top and bottom of block centre to complete (1) block.

5. Make a total of (4) blocks using the follow prints: 31810 10, 3181090,31811 110, 31811 111, 31811 90, 3181371

## Quilt Centre Assembly

1. Arrange and sew together (7) pieced blocks to make a pieced row.

2. Sew pieced rows to complete quilt center.


## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border \#1. Sew (2) $21 / 2^{" 1} \times 701 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white tonal strips to the opposite sides of quilt centre, followed by (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 741 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white tonal strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt centre.
2. Inner border \#2. Sew (2) $31 / 2 " \times 741 / 2 " 31813111$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt centre, followed by (2) $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 801 / 2^{\prime \prime} 31813111$ strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt centre.
3. Outer border. Sew (2) $31 / 2$ " $\times 801 / 2 " 3181371$ strips to the opposite sides of quilt centre, followed by (2) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 861 / 2^{\prime \prime} 3181371$ strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt centre to complete quilt top.


## Quilting Instructions:

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to finish quilt.
