Queen Quilt: 94" Square

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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.



1. Cut the following:


PLEASE NOTE:


Cut all 9-1/4" and 5-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice  for the number of triangles indicated in [].




Cut all 4-7/8" and 2-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in []. 


Fabric A - Cut (2) 98" strips. Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 17-1/2" x 98" multi-stripe borders


Fabric B - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/4" squares  [8], (4) 4-7/8" squares  [8], and (8) 2-1/2" squares



Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares and (2) 2-7/8" squares  [4]


Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (14) 2-7/8" squares  [28]

Fabric C - Cut (1) 9-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 9-1/4" square  [4], (2) 5-1/4" squares  [8], (2) 2-7/8" squares  [4], and (8) 2-1/2" squares




Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-7/8" squares  [8]

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (14) 2-7/8" squares  [28]

Fabric D - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 6-1/4" square, (2) 5-1/4" squares  [8], (4) 3-3/8" squares, and (2) 2-7/8" squares  [4]

Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (14) 2-7/8" squares  [28]


Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares


Fabric E - Cut (1) 9-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 9-1/4" square  [4], (2) 4-7/8" squares  [4], and (6) 2-7/8" squares  [12]




Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips

Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 55" and (2) 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/4" squares  [8] and (4) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (22) 2-7/8" squares  [44]


Fabric G - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/4" squares  [8], (2) 2-7/8" squares  [4], and (8) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (14) 2-7/8" squares  [28]


Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 27-1/2" and (2) 2" x 24-1/2" strips


Fabric H - Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (2) 3" x 32-1/2" and (2) 3" x 27-1/2" strips

Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (6) 3-1/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/4" x 60-1/2" and (2) 3-1/4" x 55" borders

Fabric I - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (10) 5-1/4" squares  [40] and (4) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares  [16]

Cut (6) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (84) 2-7/8" squares  [168]

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (36) 2-1/2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 4 **Fabric E** 4-7/8" triangles to sides of a 6-1/4" **Fabric D** square to make Unit 1 (8-1/2" square unfinished).

2. Sew 2 **Fabric C** 4-7/8" triangles to short edges of a 9-1/4" **Fabric E**

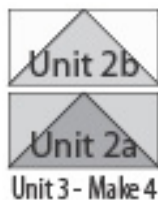

triangle. Make a total of 4 Unit 2a (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 2b with fabrics indicated.

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

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3. Sew 1 each Units 2a and 2b together as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (8-1/2" square unfinished).

4. Sew 1 each **Fabrics B** and **I** 4-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 4 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



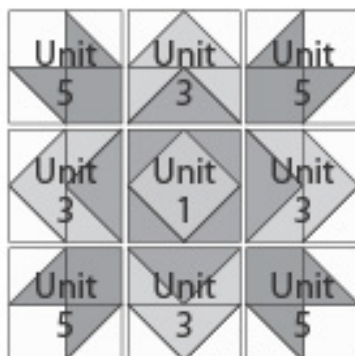

5. Arrange 2 Unit 4 and 1 each **Fabrics B** and **I** 4-1/2" squares in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Make 4 Unit 5 (8-1/2" square unfinished).

6. Units 1, 3, and 5 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Center Star** (24-1/2" square unfinished).

7. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **I** 2-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 16 Unit 6a (2-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 6b-6e listed with fabrics indicated.

8. Arrange 2 Unit 6a (U6a) and 1 each **Fabrics C** and **I** 2-1/2" squares as shown. Stitch into rows. Make 8 **Block 1a** (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 1b-1e** listed with fabrics indicated.

9. Stitch 2 Unit 6e (U6e) together as shown to make 4 each **Blocks 2a** and **2b** (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).

10. Sew 2 **Fabric C** 2-7/8" triangles to short edges of a 5-1/4" **Fabric I** triangle. Make a total of 8 Unit 7a (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 each Units 7b-7j with fabrics indicated.

11. Sew 1 each Units 7a and 7b as shown. Make a total of 8 **Block 3a** (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 each **Blocks 3b-3e** with units listed.

12. Stitch 3 **Fabric E** and 1 **Fabric F** 2-7/8" triangles to edges of a **Fabric D** 3-3/8" square. Make a total of 4 **Block 4** (4-1/2" square unfinished).

13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of **Center Star**, strips, blocks, and borders.

14. Sew **Fabric G** 2" x 24-1/2" strips to right and left sides of the **Center Star**. Add **Fabric G** 2" x 27-1/2" strips to top and bottom.

15. Sew **Fabric H** 3" x 27-1/2" strips to right and left sides of the **Center Star**. Add **Fabric H** 3" x 32-1/2" strips to top and bottom.

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

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16. Arrange 2 each **Blocks 1a-1d** on right and left sides of quilt. Sew into borders (4-1/2" x 32-1/2" unfinished). Add to right and left sides of quilt.

17. Arrange 2 each **Blocks 1a-1e** on top and bottom of quilt. Sew into borders (4-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Add to top and bottom of quilt.

18. Sew **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to right and left sides of the quilt. Add **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips to top and bottom.

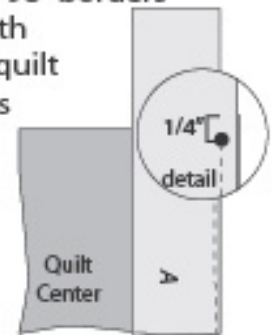
19. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 2a** and **2b** and 2 each **Blocks 3a-3e** on right and left sides of quilt. Sew into borders (4-1/2" x 44-1/2" unfinished). Add to right and left sides of quilt.

20. Arrange 1 each **2a** and **2b**, 2 each **Blocks 3a-3e**, and 2 **Block 4** on top and bottom of quilt. Sew into borders (4-1/2" x 52-1/2" unfinished). Add to top and bottom of quilt.

21. Sew **Fabric E** 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" borders to right and left sides of the quilt. Add **Fabric E** 1-3/4" x 55" borders to top and bottom.

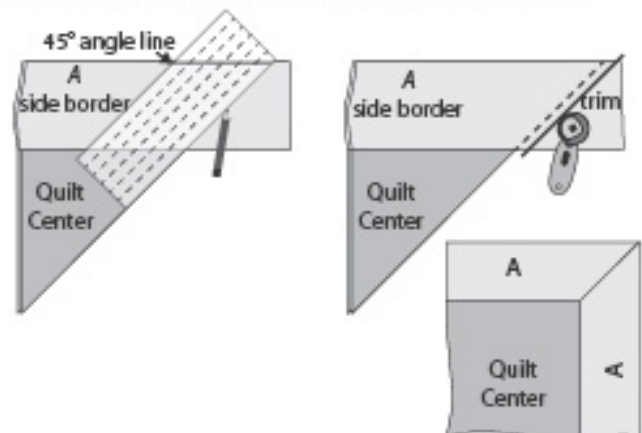
22. Sew **Fabric H** 3-1/4" x 55" strips to right and left sides of the quilt. Add **Fabric H** 3-1/4" x 60-1/2" strips to top and bottom.

23. Center **Fabric A** 17-1/2" x 98" borders on all sides of quilt center with narrow floral border next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

24. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



25. The quilt measures approximately 94-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

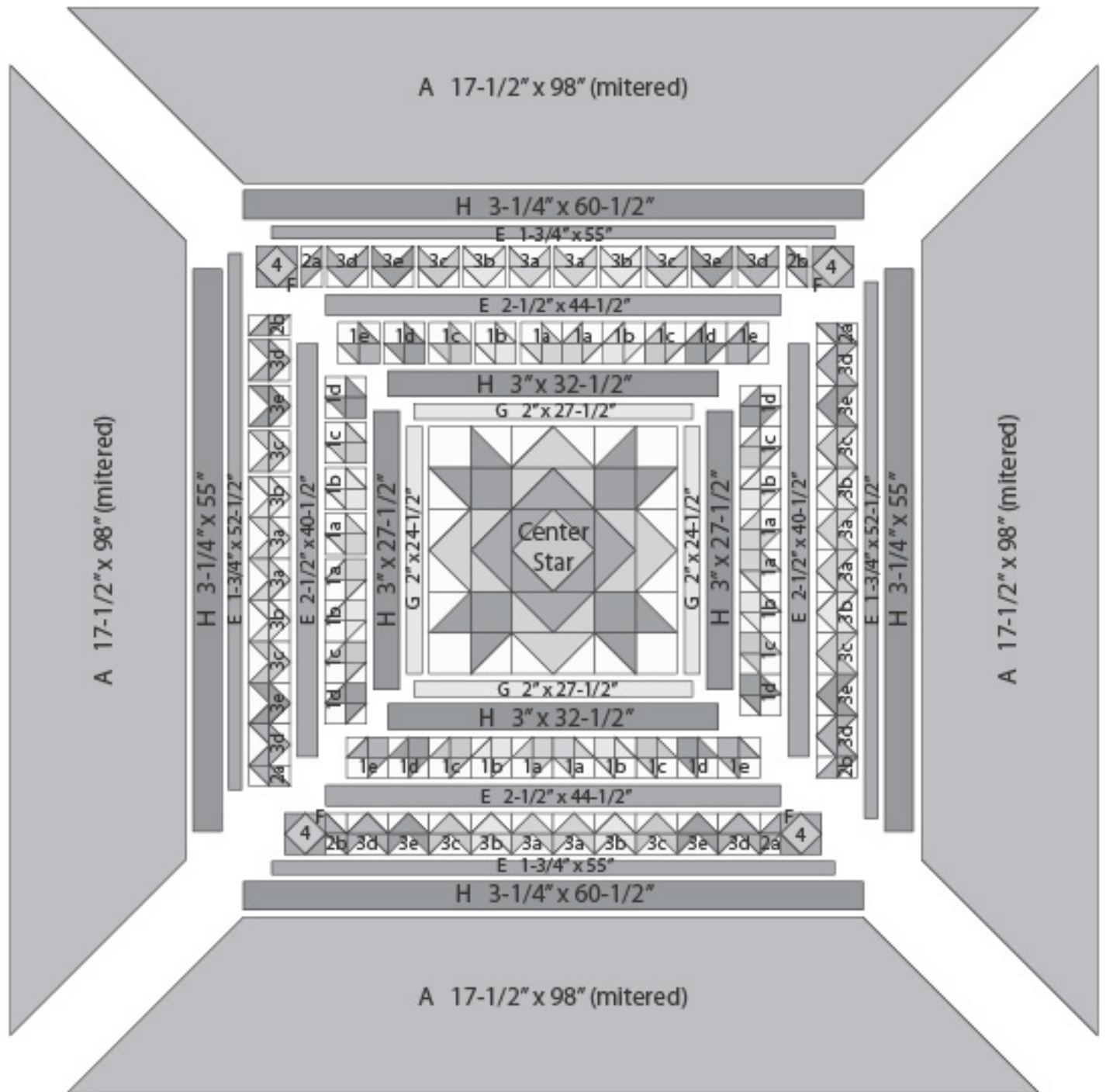
26. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!
