Le Bouquet

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-3/4" x 70-1/2" multi-stripe borders (1 with large floral stripe on top and 1 with large floral stripe on bottom)

Fabric C - Cut (3) 10-1/2" strips, subcut (10) 10-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 11-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 11-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice for 8 triangles] and (1) 7-5/8" square

Cut (1) 7-5/8" strip, subcut (5) 7-5/8" squares

Fabric E - Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 45-1/2" and (1) 3" x 30-1/2" borders

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (1) 3" x 30-1/2" border

Fabric F - Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 78" borders

Cut (4) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 79" borders

Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 27" borders

Cut (2) 2-1/4" strips

Fabric G - Cut (6) 3" strips, subcut (80) 3" squares

Fabric H - Cut (3) 5-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 5-7/8" squares

Fabric I - Cut (4) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 70-1/2" borders

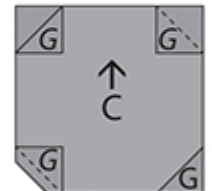
Fabric J - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (11) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 76-1/2", (2) 1-3/4" x 73", and (2) 1-3/4" x 70-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all 3" **Fabric G** squares. Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.



2. Arrange 4 marked 3" **Fabric G** squares on corners of a **Fabric C** 10-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 10 **Block 1** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



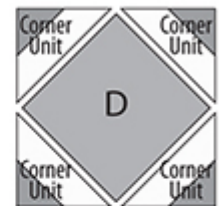
Block 1 - Make 10

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

3. Arrange 2 marked 3" **Fabric G** squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric H** 5-7/8" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Cut the **Fabric H** square in half diagonally as shown to make 2 Corner Units. Make a total of 40 Corner Units (5-7/8" x 5-7/8" x 8-3/8" unfinished).

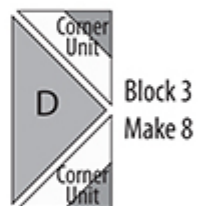


4. Stitch 4 Corner Units to sides of a **Fabric D** 7-5/8" square. Make a total of 6 **Block 2** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 6

5. Sew 2 Corner Units to short edges of a **Fabric D** 11-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 8 **Block 3** (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

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7. Stitch **Fabric F** 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-3/4" x 27" **Fabric F** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 45-1/2" (unfinished).*

8. Sew **Fabric E** 3" x 45-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric E** 3" x 30-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

9. Arrange 5 **Block 1**, 3 **Block 2**, and 4 **Block 3** in 5 rows on each side of bordered panel. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing block sections (20-1/2" x 50-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right and left sides of bordered panel to complete quilt center (50-1/2" x 70-1/2" unfinished).

10. Sew **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 70-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

11. Sew **Fabric I** 3" x 70-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Sew **Fabric B** 9-3/4" x 70-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

13. Sew **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 76-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 73" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

14. Sew **Fabric F** 3" x 79" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric F** 4-1/2" x 78" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

15. The quilt measures approximately 78" x 87" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

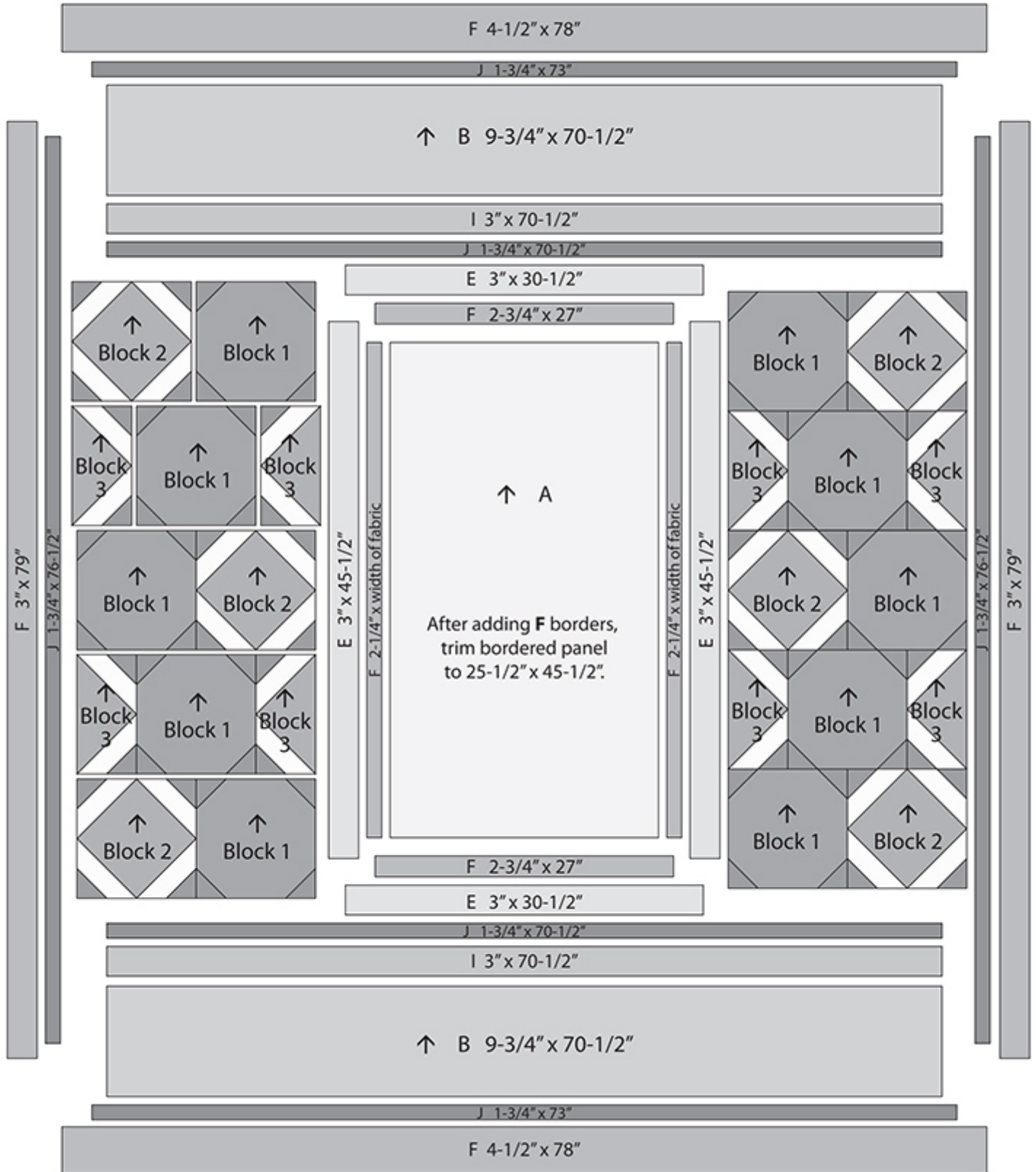
16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

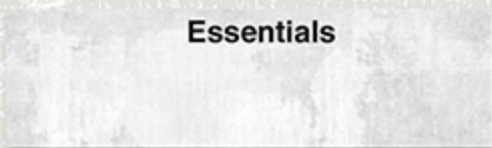

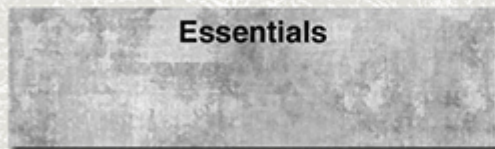
