#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fussy Cutting Instructions: Some spectacular effects can be obtained by fussy cutting specific parts of a fabric design or motif. This is best achieved by tracing the chosen part of the design onto the template used to cut the fabric. The traced image can be exactly aligned with the same part of the design on the fabric prior to cutting. This technique is particularly effective when used in a block where the pieces rotate around a central axis (ie. a 6 or 8-pointed star). For best results all patches in each set of 8 pieces must be exactly the same. Enough vardage has been allowed for fussy cutting.

#### From the Diamond - Mint/Teal (A):

• Fussy cut (4) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Twisted Ribbon - Red (B):

• Fussy cut (4) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Main Floral - Teal (C):

• Fussy cut (3) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Tiny Spray - Pink (D):

• Fussy cut (3) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Stripey Bouquet - Linden Green (E):

• Fussy cut (4) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

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#### From the Main Floral - Red (F):

• Fussy cut (4) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Stripey Bouquet - Blue (G):

• Fussy cut (4) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Main Floral - Cream (H), cut:

- (4) 6 ½" x 60 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- Fussy cut (1) Set of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Twisted Ribbon - Olive (I), fussy cut:

- (4) 2" x 48 ½" strips, each centered on a Ribbon Section.
- (24) Template 5 shapes, each centered on the same Ribbon
- (4) Template 7 shapes, each centered on the same Ribbon
- (2) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Twisted Ribbon - Teal (J):

• Fussy cut (3) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Diamond - Rose/Plum (K):

• Fussy cut (4) Sets of (8) Template 1 diamonds, each set centered on exactly the same motif.

#### From the Shirting Foulard - Red (L), cut:

• (144) Template 2 squares.

#### From the Shirting Foulard - Green/Teal (M), cut:

• (144) Template 2 squares.

#### From the Tiny Spray - Cream (N), cut:

- (25) Template 4 octagons.
- (20) Template 6 shapes.

#### From the Tiny Vines - Red (O), cut:

- (66) Template 3 diamonds.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Floral Toile Tonal - Cream/Red (Back), cut:


• (2) 66" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 66" back.


#### **READ FIRST:**

For this quilt start and stop all seams a 1/4" in from the raw edges. The majority of the seams throughout this quilt are Y-seams, meaning three or more seams meet at one point. Starting and stopping seams 1/4" from the raw edges enable adjacent patches to be set neatly so the seams lay flat.


#### **Block Assembly**

- 1. To make (1) block, select (1) set of matching Fabric A-Template 1 pieces. Sew (2) Fabric A-Template 1 diamonds together to make (1) Unit 1 piece (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) matching Unit 1 pieces total.
- 2. Sew (2) matching Unit 1 pieces together to make (1) Unit 2 piece (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (2) Unit 2 pieces total.







- 4. Using a Y-seam set in (4) Fabric M-Template 2 squares as shown to make (1) Unit 4 piece (Fig. 4).
- 5. Using a Y-seam set in (4) Fabric L-Template 2 squares as shown to make (1) Block One Star (Fig. 5).
- 6. Repeat Steps 1-5 to make (4) Block One Stars total.



7. Repeat Steps 1-5 and refer to Figures 6-15 for fabric identification and placement to make the listed number of each block star for Block Two through Block Eleven. Note: *Make sure to use (1) matching set of* (8) Template 1 pieces for each block.



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- 8. Using Y seams, sew (1) Fabric O-Template 3 diamond to the bottom of (1) Block One star, (1) Block Two star, (1) Block Three star, (1) Block Four star, (1) Block Five star and (1) Block Six star. Sew together the (6) Stars blocks with (5) Fabric O-Template 3 diamonds, alternating them from left to right, to make Row 1 (Fig. 16).
- 9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 17-21 for component identification and placement to make Row 2 through Row 6.
- 10. Follow Figure 22 on Page 4 to sew together the (6) Rows and (25) Fabric N-Template 4 octagons to make Unit 5 piece.
- 11. Follow Figure 23 on Page 5 to sew (24) Fabric I-Template 5 pieces, (20) Fabric N-Template 6 pieces and (4) Fabric I-Template 7 pieces around the edges of the Unit 5 piece to make the Center Block.






#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 12. Center (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric I strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.


13. Repeat Step 12 to sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 24).

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
14. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 24), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.




- 15. Repeat Steps 12-14 to add (4) 6 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric H strips to the center block.
- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric O strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and
- 18. Bind as desired.
