

CHURN DASH BLOCKS

Note: Follow quilt image for direction of print.

- **1.** Block Center: Sew (2) A 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the left/right sides of (1) B 4-1/2" square, followed by (2) A 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the top/bottom sides to make block center. Block center measures 6-1/2" square, raw edge to raw edge.
- 2. Sew together (1) A 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle and (1) B 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to make a framing unit measuring 2-1/2" x 6-1/2", raw edge to raw edge. Make (4) framing units.
- 3. Sew (2) framing units to the left and right sides of Block Center.
- **4. HST Units**: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" **B** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3" **A** square. Sew 1/4" away from both right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure 2-1/2" square, raw edge to raw edge. Make (4) HST units.
- **5.** Sew (2) HST units to the opposite short sides of (1) framing unit to make a row unit. Make (2) row units, and sew row units to the top and bottom of block center to complete (1) Churn Dash Block. Finished block measures 10-1/2" square, raw edge to raw edge.
- 6. Make the following fabric combination blocks: (7) G/G, (6) B/B, D/D, I/I, (4) B/E, K/K.







CAT BLOCKS

- 7. Block Center: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a bottom corner of (1) H 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" as indicated by the solid line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Sew another A 1-1/2" square to the remaining bottom corner of the H rectangle in the same manner to make the face.
- **8.** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **H** 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal print corner triangle. Repeat with another (1) 1-1/2" square at the opposite side of the same **A** rectangle.
- **9.** Sew together sewn units, as shown below, to make (1) Cat Unit. Square to 4-1/2", raw edge to raw edge.
- **10.** Sew (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the left/right sides of cat unit, followed by (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the top/bottom sides of cat unit to make block center. Square to 6-1/2", raw edge to raw edge.
- 11. Follow Steps 2 to 5 to make the framing units to complete (1) Cat Block.
- 12. Make the following fabric combination cat blocks: (3) H/H, (2) C/C, J/J, F/F.




Make a total of (3) **H/H** blocks. Finished Block Size: 10"





QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

13. Referring to quilt image, arrange and sew together (6) blocks to make (7) pieced rows. Press the seams in rows 1, 3, 5 and 7 to the right. Press the seams in rows 2, 4 and 6 to the left. Sew the rows together matching the seams.



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **J** 2-1/4" strips.
