The Boo Crew

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Fussy cut panel 22-1/2" x 40-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 73" and (2) 8-3/4" x 55" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" pieces

Fabric D Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces and (4) 2-1/2" squares with motifs centered

Fabric E - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (9) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 40-1/2", (4) 1-1/2" x 22-1/2", and (20) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

Fabrics J and L - From each fabric: Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric K - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all **Fabric F** 3-1/2" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



2. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 3-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric H** 3-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Do not trim. Make a total of 8 Unit 1. In the same manner, make 8 Unit 2 with fabrics indicated.











Repeat 4 times for 8 units.

Unit 1 Make 8

Unit 2 Make 8

3. Draw a diagonal line, (perpendicular to the seam line) across the wrong side of each Unit 1. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



4. Arrange a marked Unit 1 right sides together on a Unit 2, nesting seam allowances, with **Fabric F** triangles alternating. Stitch along the two outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Trim each to 2-1/2" square. Make a total of 16 Unit 3.










Repeat 8 times for 16 units.

Unit 3 Make 16


5. Arrange 4 Unit 3, 1 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" square, and 4 **Fabric E** 2-1/2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

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6. Arrange 1 **Fabric D** 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece, 2 Fabric J 4-1/2" squares, and 4 Fabric I 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips as shown. Stitch into a row. Add Fabric I 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" strips to the long edges. Make a total of 2 Block 2 (6-1/2" x 22-1/2" unfinished).




- 7. Referring to **Block 3** diagram below, arrange 1 **Fabric G** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece, 2 Fabric L 4-1/2" squares, 2 Fabric C 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" pieces, and 6 Fabric I 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips in a row as shown. Stitch into a row. Add **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to the long edges. Make a total of 2 Block 3 (6-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished).
- 8. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 9. Stitch a **Block 3** to right and left sides of the Fabric A panel.
- 10. Sew each Block 2 between 2 Block 1 to create top and bottom borders (4-1/2" x 34-1/2" unfinished). Stitch top and bottom borders to top and bottom of panel. Quilt center measures (34-1/2" x 52-1/2" unfinished).


11. Center Fabric B 8-3/4" x 73" borders on right and left sides of guilt center and Fabric B 8-3/4" x 55" borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. 1/4" Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping detail 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press Quilt \rightarrow borders out. Center

> Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

12. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the auilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 13. The quilt measures approximately 51" x 69" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric M) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 14. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric K) and enjoy!!




Block 3 - Make 2
