TULIP BLOCK 1

1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/4" square. Place A square, right sides together (RST), at the top left corner of (1) B 1-1/2" x 3" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat placing (1) A 1-1/2" square at the top right corner of the same B rectangle. Repeat steps to make a mirror-imaged unit, sewing A squares at opposite corners.





Draw diagonal line on wrong side.



Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line.



Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat at opposite corner with **A** 1-1/2" square.





2. Repeat Step 1 using (2) A 1-1/2" squares and (1) B 1-1/2" x 3" rectangle.



3. Row Unit: Noting placement of units, sew Step 1 units to the opposite short sides of Step 2's unit. Then add (1) A 1-1/2" x 8" rectangle to the top of row unit.








MIRROR-IMAGED





4. Corner Triangle: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2-1/2" square. Place square, RST, at the bottom left corner of (1) **B** 7-1/2" vertical x 8" horizontal rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another **A** square at the bottom right corner of the same **B** rectangle.









Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat at the opposite corner.



5. Repeat Step 4 using (1) E 3-1/2" square and (1) A 3-1/2" vertical x 3-3/4" horizontal rectangle, aligning lower right corners. Then draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 1-1/2" and place at the bottom left corner of the same sewn **E** triangle, as shown. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat steps to make a mirror-imaged unit.



Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line.



Open and press to reveal E corner triangle. Repeat using A square.

6. Sew both Step 5 units to the opposite long sides of (1) \mathbf{E} 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle, as shown.









7. Sew together units from Steps 3, 4 and 6 to complete (1) Tulip Block 1. Make (3) of **B/E**. Block measures 8" x 12-1/2" unfinished.







8. Repeat Steps 1-7 to make a total number of Tulip Block 1 for the following fabric combinations:













SASHING BLOCK

9. Vertical: Sew (2) **A** 1-1/2" \times WOF strips to the opposite long sides of (1) **L** 1-1/2" \times WOF strip. Make (8) strip sets. Cut strip set at 12-1/2" intervals. Make (24) vertical sashing blocks.




10. Horizontal: Repeat Step 9 to make (5) strip sets. Cut strip set at 8" intervals. Make (25) horizontal sashing blocks.



CORNERSTONES

- 11. Sew (2) A 1-1/2" x WOF strips to the opposite long sides of (1) L 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Make (3) strip sets. Cut strip set at 1-1/2" intervals. Make a total of (60) units.
- **12.** Noting placement, sew (2) **Step 11** units to the opposite long sides of (1) **L** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to make (1) **Cornerstone**. Make (30), measuring 3-1/2" square.







TULIP MOTIFS

Shoofly Motif - Note rotation and placement of units.

- 13. Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2-1/4" square. Place A square, RST, on (1) K 2-1/4" square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Unit measures 1-3/4" square unfinished. Make (4).
- **14.** Sew (2) **Step 13** units to the opposite long sides of (1) **K** 1" x 1-3/4" rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2).
- **15.** Sew (2) **K** 1" x 1-3/4" rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) **A** 1" square to make a row unit.



16. Sew together **Steps 14** and **15** to complete **Shoofly Motif Unit**, measuring 3-1/2" square unfinished.








- 17. Repeat Step 13 using (2) marked **A** and (2) **K** 2" squares to make (4) HST units. Square up to measure 1-1/2".
- **18.** Sew together (1) $\bf A$ and (1) $\bf K$ 1" x 1-1/2" rectangles. Make (4).
- 19. Sew (2) Step 17 units to the opposite sides of (1) Step 18 unit. Make (2) row units.
- 20. Sew (2) Step 18 units to the opposite sides of (1) K 1-1/2" square to make a row unit.





21. Sew together Step 19 and 20 row units to complete Churn Dash Motif, measuring 3-1/2" square unfinished.


Cross Motif

Note rotation and placement of units.

- 22. Corner Triangle: Repeat Step 4 using (2) marked K 1" squares and (1) A 1-1/2" square. Make (4).
- 23. Sew (2) K 1-1/2" squares to the opposite sides of (1) Step 22 unit. Make (2) row units.
- 24. Noting rotation, sew (2) Step 22 units to the opposite sides of (1) K 1-1/2" square to make a row unit.



25. Sew together Steps 23 and 24 row units to complete Cross Motif, measuring 3-1/2" square unfinished.







- 26. Sew together (1) A and (1) K QSTs, followed by (1) A HST. Square up to 1-1/2" unfinished. Make (4).
- 27. Sew (2) K 1-1/2" squares to the opposite sides of (1) Step 26 unit. Make (2) row units.
- 28. Sew (2) Step 26 units to the opposite sides of (1) K 1-1/2" square to make a row unit.




29. Sew together Step 26 and 27 row units to complete Star Motif unit, measuring 3-1/2" square unfinished.




TULIP BLOCK 2 (WITH MOTIFS)

30. Repeat Steps 1-3 to construct the top pieced parts of the Tulip. Use marked **A** and **K** pieces.





31. Add (1) **K** 2" x 8" rectangle to the bottom of **Step 30** unit.



- **32.** Sew (1) **K** 3-1/2" vertical x 4" horizontal rectangle to the left of (1) **Churn Dash Motif**, and (1) **K** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to make a row unit.
- 33. Repeat Step 1 using (2) marked A 2-1/2" square and (1) K 3" x 8" rectangle.



- **34.** Repeat Step 5 using (1) marked **J** 3-1/2" square, (1) **A** 3-1/2" x 3-3/4" rectangle, and (1) marked **A** 1-1/2" square to make the leaves. Make a mirror-imaged unit, too.
- **35.** Sew Step 34 units to the opposite long sides of (1) \mathbf{J} 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.



36. Sew together units made in **Steps 31**, **32**, **33**, and **35** to complete (1) **Tulip Block 2 (Motif)**. Block measures 8" x 12-1/2" unfinished.

37. Repeat Steps 30-36 to make (1) each of the other (3) Tulip Block (Motifs).









38. Arrange and sew together (4) Tulip Block 1 and (1) Tulip Block 2 (Motif), alternating with (6) Vertical Sashing Blocks, to make a pieced row. Make (4). Row 1 is shown below.



39. Arrange and sew together (6) Cornerstones, alternating with (5) Horizontal Sashing Blocks, to make a pieced sashing row. Make (5).




40. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.

BORDERS

- **41.** Inner Border: Sew (2) A 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by A 2-1/2" x 60" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- **42.** Outer Border: Sew (2) **C** 3" x 67-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **C** 3" x 65" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



QUILT ASSEMBLY



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **K** 2-1/4" strips.
