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Green Fields

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 4-1/2" x 40", (2) 4-1/2" x 36-1/2", and (4) 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" floral stripe strips. Sew (2) 40" long borders together end to end and trim to (1) 4-1/2" x 72-1/2" strip. Make a second 72-1/2" long strip.

Fabric B - Cut (7) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (4) 1-1/2" x 72-1/2" borders
Cut (8) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" and (8) 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" borders

Fabric C - Cut (3) 7" strips, subcut (16) 7" squares
Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (4) 4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (4) 7" strips, subcut (22) 7" squares
Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (14) 4" squares and (4) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (3) 7" strips, subcut (16) 7" squares

Fabric F - Cut (3) 7" strips, subcut (16) 7" squares and (4) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (16) 4" squares
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (20) 4" squares

Fabrics H and I - From each fabric:
Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (10) 4" squares

Fabric J - Cut (1) 7" strip, subcut (6) 7" squares
Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (6) 4" squares

Fabric K - Cut (1) 7" strip, subcut (4) 7" squares

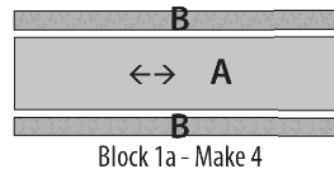
Fabric L - Cut (1) 7" strip, subcut (4) 7" squares.
Cut remaining strip into (2) 3-1/2" x 14" strips, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (8) 4" squares

Fabric M - Cut (12) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (6) 3-1/2" x 36-1/2", (4) 3-1/2" x 18-1/2", (4) 3-1/2" x 15-1/2", and (4) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabric N - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch a **Fabric A** 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" floral stripe strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric B** 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips. Make 4 **Block 1a** (6-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. In the same manner, sew a **Fabric A** 4-1/2" x 36-1/2" floral stripe strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric B** 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips. Make 2 **Block 1b** (6-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished).

3. In the same manner, sew a **Fabric A** 4-1/2" x 72-1/2" floral stripe strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric B** 1-1/2" x 72-1/2" strips. Make 2 **Block 1c** (6-1/2" x 72-1/2" unfinished).

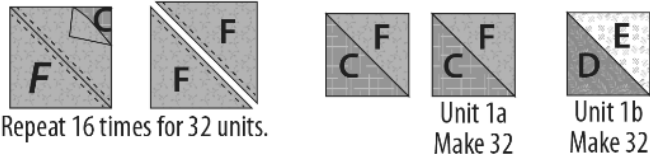
4. On the wrong side of all **Fabrics E, F, and J** 7" squares and all **Fabrics F, G, and L** 4" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



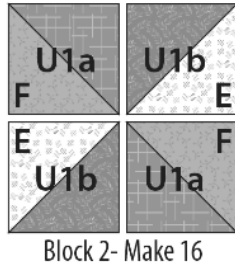
5. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 7" square right sides together with a **Fabric C** 7" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press

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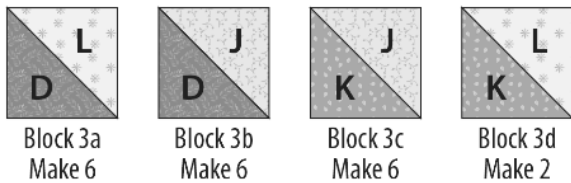
the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 6-1/2" square. Make a total of 32 Unit 1a. In the same manner, make 32 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.



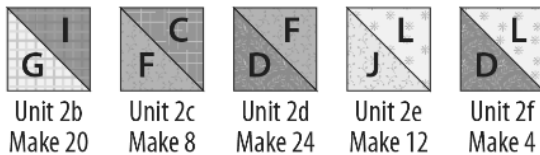
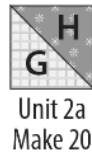
6. Arrange 2 each Units 1a and 1b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 16 **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished)



7. Referring to Step 5, use 7" squares to make 6 each **Blocks 3a-3c** and 2 **Block 3d** with fabrics indicated (6-1/2" square unfinished).



8. Referring to Step 5, use 4" squares to make the number of Units 2a-2f listed with fabrics indicated. Centering seam, trim each unit to 3-1/2" square.



9. Draw a diagonal line across all the **Fabrics D** and **F** 3-1/2" squares.

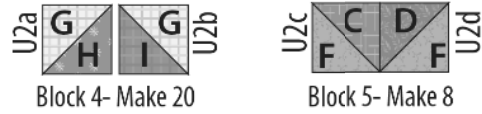


10. Arrange a marked **Fabric D** 3-1/2" square on one end of a **Fabric L** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end with a marked **Fabric F** 3-1/2"



square. Make a total of 16 Unit 3 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

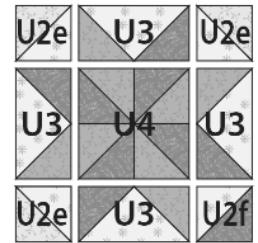
11. Sew 1 each Units 2a and 2b together as shown. Make a total of 20 **Block 4** (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 **Block 5** with units indicated.



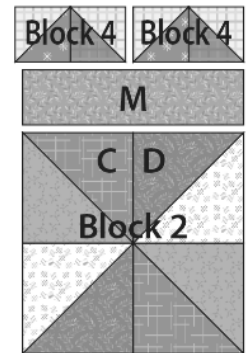
12. Arrange 4 Unit 2d in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



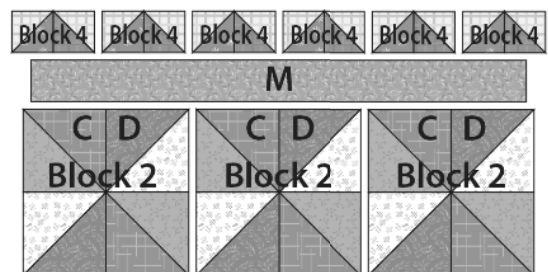
13. Arrange 3 Unit 2e, 1 Unit 2f, 4 Unit 3, and 1 Unit 4 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 6** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



14. Stitch 2 **Block 4** together side by side. Sew a **Fabric M** 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip under the blocks, then a **Block 2** below the **Fabric M** strip. Make a total of 4 Section 1 (12-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

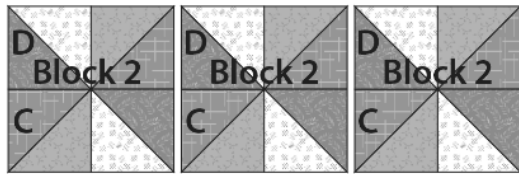


15. Arrange 6 **Block 4**, 1 **Fabric M** 3-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip, and 3 **Block 2** in 3 rows as shown. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew block rows and **Fabric M** strip together. Make a total of 2 Section 2 (18-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished).



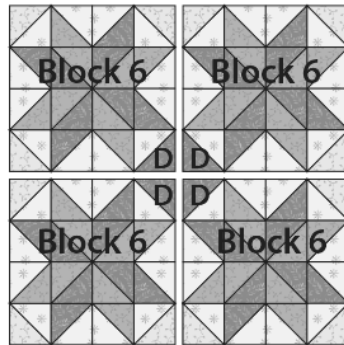
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16. Arrange 3 **Block 2** in a row as shown. Stitch blocks together. Make a total of 2 Section 3 (12-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished).



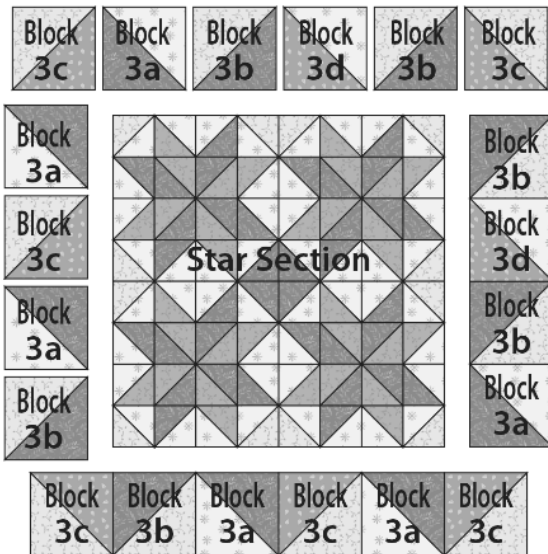
Section 3- Make 2

17. Arrange 4 **Block 6** in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Star Section (24-1/2" square unfinished)



Star Section- Make 1

18. Arrange **Blocks 3a-3d** in vertical rows on right and left sides of Star Section. Stitch blocks into vertical rows (6-1/2" x 24-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to right and left sides of Star Section.



Section 4- Make 1

19. Arrange **Blocks 3a-3d** above and below Star Section. Sew blocks into horizontal rows (6-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished). Add to top and bottom to complete Section 4 (36-1/2" square unfinished).

20. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, sections, and **Fabric M** strips.

21. Arrange blocks, sections, and **Fabric M** strips in 7 rows as shown. Stitch into rows.

22. The quilt measures approximately 78-1/2" x 90-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric O**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

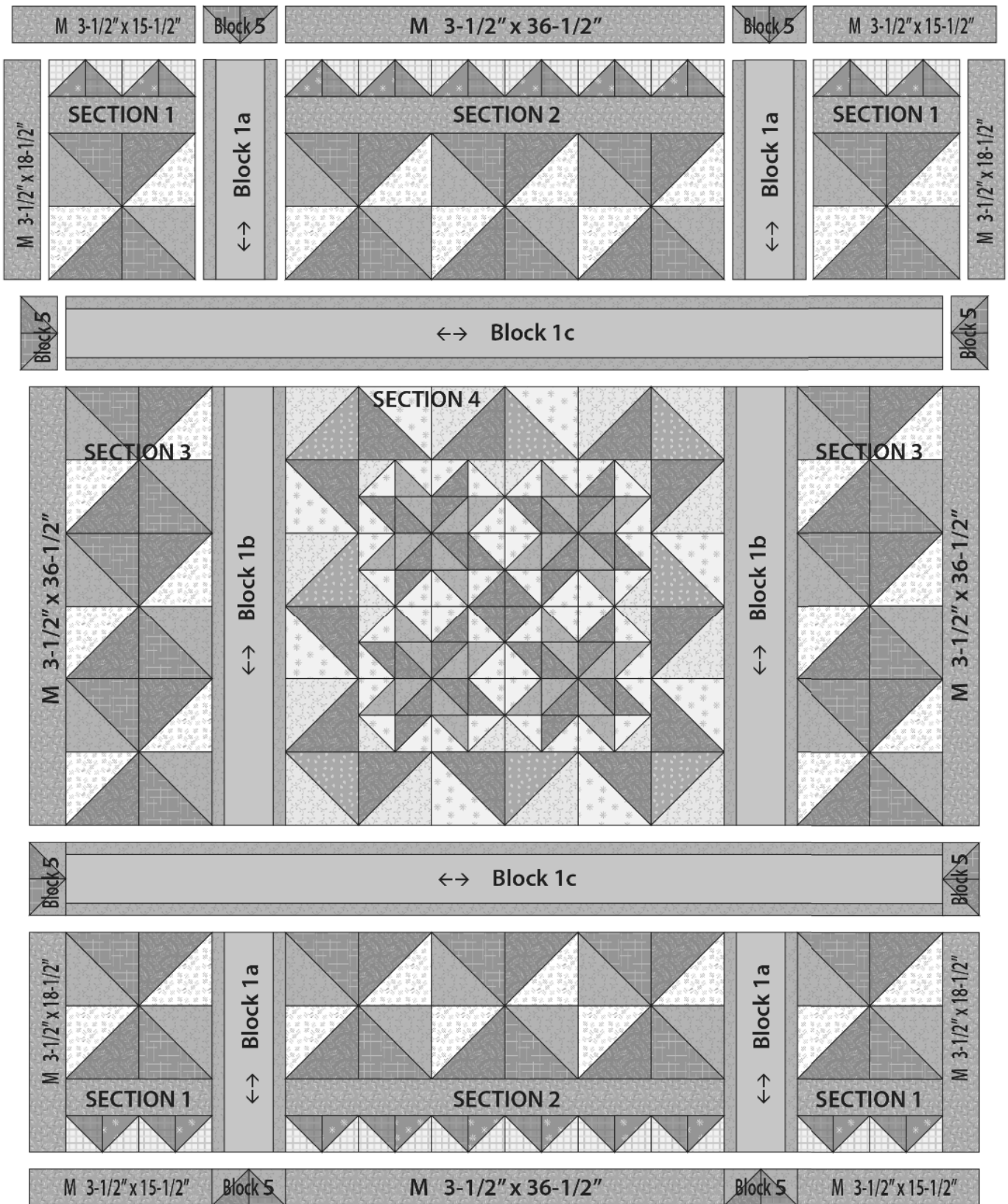
23. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric N**) and enjoy!!
