


VERTICALS

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Prints: 1 Jelly Roll* or (26) 21/2" x WOF strips

Background: 1 Junior Jelly Roll** + 1½ yard,

- or - 2³/₄ yards if all yardage

Binding: 8 strips from Jelly Roll, or 3/3 yard

Backing: 47/8 yards

*Jelly Roll = (40) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x Width of Fabric strips **Junior Jelly Roll = (20) 21/2" x Width of Fabric strips

Cutting:

From the Jelly Roll:

- Choose (26) Jelly Roll strips from the Jelly Roll. Cut each strip into (6) 2½" x 6½" rectangles. You need (154) 2½" x 6½" rectangles total.
- Set aside (8) of the remaining Jelly Roll strips to use for a scrappy binding, if desired.

Background Fabric:

- If using only the 2¾ yards yardage:
 - Cut (23) 21/2" x WOF strips for the vertical sashings.
 - Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, then subcut (14) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " setting rectangles.
 - Cut (7) 41/2" x WOF strips for the outer borders.
- OR -
- If using (1) Junior Jelly Roll (20 strips) + 1½ yards yardage:
 - Cut (3) 21/2" x WOF strips for the vertical sashings (plus the Jr. Jelly Roll)
 - Cut (2) 2½" x WOF strips, then subcut (14) 2½" x 3½" setting rectangles.
 - Cut (7) 41/2" x WOF strips for the outer borders.

Binding fabric:

- Cut (8) 21/2" x WOF strips, if not using strips from the Jelly Roll for a scrappy binding.
- If using scrappy Jelly Roll binding, trim off about 3" from each of the (8) strips so the strips distribute better around your quilt.

Assembly:

Unless specified otherwise, all seams are a scant 1/4".

Pieced Columns

Gather (154) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " from Jelly Roll Prints and (14) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Setting Rectangles from Background.

Randomly sew (11) 2½" x 6½" print strips together end-to-end, then attach (1) 2½" x 3½" Setting Rectangle to the end to make (14) 2½" x 69½" pieced columns. Press seams open, or to the side.

Vertical Sashings

Gather (23) 2½" x WOF Background strips. If you have used a Junior Jelly Roll of background fabric to reduce cutting, you will use all (20) of those strips + (3) cut from yardage.

Trim off selvedges, then join end-to-end to form one long strip. Press seams open.

You can join these strips on the bias if you prefer, but recommended to use straight seams since the pieced columns also have straight seams.

Subcut into (13) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $69\frac{1}{2}$ " Vertical Sashing strips.



Outer Borders

Gather (7) 41/2" x WOF Background strips.

Trim off selvedges, then join end-to-end to form one long strip. Press seams open.

Subcut into (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $69\frac{1}{2}$ " Side Borders, and (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " Top/Bottom Borders.

Binding

Gather (8) 2½" x WOF binding strips. If using scrappy Jelly Roll strips, trim off about 3" from the end of each strip (if you haven't done this already).

This will ensure you get a good distribution of all 8 prints (rather than just a little piece or an awkward seam where it comes together at the end due to quilt dimensions + WOF length).

Join end to end on the bias to form one long strip. Trim seam allowances to ¼" and press open. Press strip in half Wrong Sides Together, so that you have one long folded strip. Set aside until after quilting, and attach and finish in your preferred method.

Finishing:

Unless specified otherwise, all seams are a scant 1/4".

Lay out (14) Pieced Columns, alternating with (13) Vertical Sashings. Every other Pieced Column, switch the direction so the Setting Piece of background fabric changes from top to bottom to top to bottom...etc. (Noted on diagram by s).


Join, and press seams to the sashings to make the quilt center.

Attach (2) 4½" x 69½" Side Borders on either side of the quilt center. Press seams to the borders.

Attach (2) 4½" x 62½" Top/Bottom Borders to top and bottom of quilt center. Press seams to the borders.


Quilt Top measures $62\frac{1}{2}$ " x $77\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Baste, quilt, bind, & enjoy!


